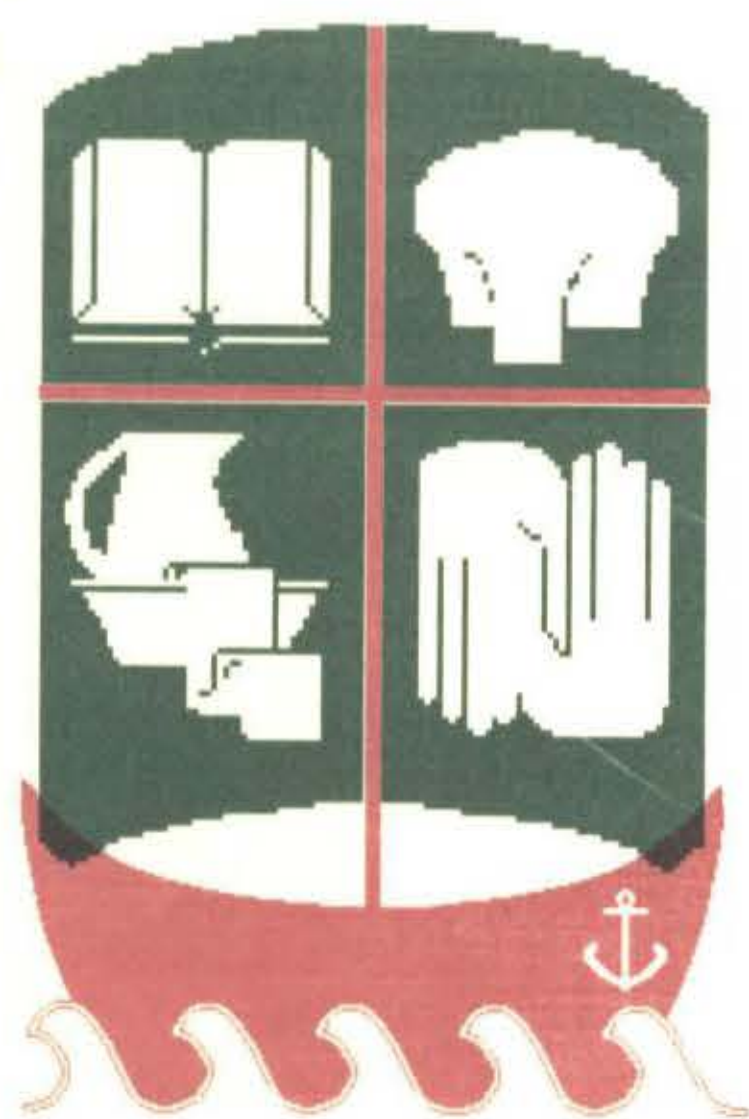

PROCEEDINGS

THE NINETIETH SESSION of the ALABAMA STATE ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTISTS WEDNESDAY NIGHT, NOVEMBER 4, 2009-

The Alabama State Association of Free Will Baptists convened at Madison Free Will Baptist Church in Madison, Alabama on Wednesday evening, November 4, 2009.

The service was opened with the Madison choir singing "It's A Great Occasion in Heaven." Bro. Rodney Yerby then led the congregation in singing a medley of "We Bring A Sacrifice of Praise", "He Has Made Me Glad" and "Heaven Came Down."

Dr. Richard Hendrix, pastor of the host church, welcomed the State Association to The Madison church.

After prayer led by Rev. Lamar Cox, Rev. Danny Williams, State Clerk, called the association to order, and introduced the officers, moderator Wayne McDaniel, assistant moderator Jerry Smith and assistant clerk Rodney Yerby.

A live video report was given by Jaimie Lancaster, missionary to Uruguay. Bro. Lancaster reported on Free Will Baptist churches and missionary activity in Uruguay. He thanked the State Association for faithful support of missions through the Acts 1:8 program.

Bro. Rodney Yerby led an offertory prayer, and an offering of \$228.48 was received. During the offering, the Madison choir sang "Jesus, What A Mighty Name." Bro. Yerby then led the congregation in singing a medley of "No Other Name", "All Hail the Power of Jesus' Name" and "Crown Him King of Kings."

The moderator, Rev. Wayne McDaniel, introduced the evening speaker, Rev. Dann Patrick. Prior to the message, Rachel Dominion and Phyllis Detherage, from Madison Free Will Baptist Church, sang "Holy, Holy, Holy."

Bro. Patrick preached from Nehemiah 9:38, "I'll Sign My Name to That." He closed the sermon in prayer. An altar call was extended while the congregation sang "I Surrender All."

After the sermon, Moderator McDaniel announced that the General Board is to meet Thursday morning at 8:00 AM, and then appointed the following committees:

Executive Director of State Ministries Rev. Rick Cash and Dr. Richard Hendrix provided an update on Alabama missions efforts and ministries in Mexico. Bro. Cash explained a plan to provide 200 hymn books for use among indigenous groups in Mexico, to be funded through the sale of decorative tortilla wraps produced by Mexican believers.

After various announcements by Bro. McDaniel and Bro. Yerby, Bro. McDaniel called on Rev. Mike Cox to lead the closing prayer.

GENERAL BOARD MEETING THURSDAY MORNING, NOVEMBER 5, 2009

The General Board met on Thursday morning, November 5, 2009. The Moderator, Rev. Wayne McDaniel, called the meeting to order and opened the meeting with prayer.

The clerk, Bro. Rodney Yerby, called the roll of the General Board members. There were 10 members of the General Board present, representing 8 of the 13 District Associations and 2 of the 4 standing boards. Bro. Yerby presented the Executive Committee report to the General Board. The Executive Committee recommended the following items:

1. The Executive Committee recommends renewing the partnership with Russian Baptists
2. The Executive Committee recommends forming a partnership with Mexican Free Will Baptists
3. The Executive Committee recommends approving new Acts 1:8 Guidelines
4. The Executive Committee recommends no longer printing minutes in booklet form; that the constitution be printed in a booklet; that the remaining content that would otherwise be printed in the minutes be printed in the Digest of Reports
5. The Executive Committee recommends that \$40,000 of excess funds in Mike Corley's budget be used to pay for three items required at the camp in Tikhoretsk (dining hall improvements, pad for fire truck, and reopening a well).
6. The Executive Committee recommends sending any excess funds in the 2009 ACTS 1:8 budget to Free Will Baptist International Missions
7. The Executive Committee recommends approving the Executive Fund budget
8. The Executive Committee recommends approving the Promotional Office budget
9. The Executive Committee recommends approving the ACTS 1:8 budget
10. The Executive Committee recommends approving the site development plan adopted by the Alabama Free Will Baptist Children's Home Board of Directors
11. The Executive Committee recommends that the Alabama Free Will Baptist Children's Home Board of Directors Constitution and By-Laws submitted by the Board be adopted by the State Association.

There was a motion and second to recommend item #1 to the State Association. The motion carried.

There was a motion and second to recommend item #2 to the State Association. The motion carried.

There was a motion and second to recommend item #3 to the State Association. The motion carried.

There was a motion and second to recommend item #4 to the State Association. The motion carried.

There was a motion and second to recommend item #5 to the State Association. The motion carried.

Rev. Rick Cash gave the Executive Director's report and presented the Executive Fund, Promotional Office and Acts 1:8 budgets. There was a motion and second to accept the report and recommend adoption of the budgets to the State Association. The motion carried.

Bro. Cash gave the Pastors' & Workers' Conference report. There was a motion and second to accept the report as information. The motion carried.

Rev. Tim Baumgarten gave Missions and Church Extension Board Report. Rev. Danny Williams provided a financial report from the board. There was a motion and second to accept the report as information. The motion carried. There was a motion and second to amend the previous motion to set aside the 15th day of each month to fast and pray for Alabama state ministries, including missionaries. The motion carried.

Rev. Rick Taylor gave the State Christian Education Board Report. There was a motion and second to accept the report as information. The motion carried.

Bro. Rodney Yerby gave the Children's Home report. There was a motion and second to accept the report as information. The motion carried.

After a discussion of the value of continuing to hold the General Board Meeting, there was a motion and second to recommend that the State Association amend the constitution by replacing Article Five, Section 8 - General Board, subsection (A) with:

"The General Board shall meet with the Executive Committee prior to the meeting of the Alabama State Association of Free Will Baptists."

The motion carried, and this item became General Board recommendation #12.

Rev. Jerry Williams presented the Nominating Committee report. There was a motion and second to accept the report and recommend the nominations. The motion carried.

There was a motion and second to adjourn. The motion carried. The meeting was closed with prayer led by Rev. Jerry Smith.

STATE ASSOCIATION MEETING THURSDAY MORNING, NOVEMBER 5, 2009

Bro. Chad Donoho opened the service by leading the congregation in singing "To God Be The Glory". The Moderator, Rev. Wayne McDaniel, introduced the first speaker of the morning, Rev. Steve Trail, pastor of First Free Will Baptist Church of Dothan.

Prior to the message, Rev. Jason Miller sang "I'd Rather Have Jesus."

Bro. Trail preached on "The Superlatives of the Savior," from Heb. 1:1-3. Bro. Trail closed the message with prayer.

Rev. Kenneth Terry gave the Credential's Committee Report. There was a motion and second to receive the report and seat the delegates. The motion carried.

Dr. Joe Godfrey gave the ALCAP report.

Rev. Mickey Crane dismissed the session in prayer.

After a short break, Bro. McDaniel reconvened the session. Bro. Rick Cash reminded everyone to buy a Tortilla Wrap to fund the purchase of hymnals for Mexico, and use the Tortilla Wrap as a prayer reminder for Mexico.

Rev. Keith Burden, Executive Secretary of the National Association of Free Will Baptists, gave a report from the National Executive Office. The report was received as information.

Bro. Rodney Yerby (Chairman of the Board) and Bro. Mike Corley (Executive Director) gave the Children's Home Report. There was a motion and second to receive the report. The motion carried. There was a motion and second to adopt the budget. The motion carried.

Bro. David Corum gave the Christian Education Board report. There was a motion and second to receive the report as information. The motion carried.

Rev. Tim Baumgarten presented the State Mission report. Rev. Danny Williams presented the Mission Board financial report. There was a motion and second to accept the report, including the recommendation to fast and pray on the 15th of each month for state ministries. The motion carried.

There was a motion and second to adjourn. The motion carried. Rev. Mickey Crane dismissed the session with prayer.

THURSDAY EVENING, NOVEMBER 5, 2009

Bro. Chad Donoho opened the evening session leading the congregation singing "Glory to His Name," Hallelujah! Praise the Lamb!" and "O How He Loves You and Me." The Alabama Minister's Quartet sang "There's a Sweet, Sweet Spirit."

Rev. Barry Simpson gave a report from Free Will Baptist International Missions. There was a motion and second to receive the report. The motion carried.

Rev. Larry Powell gave a report from Free Will Baptist Home Missions. There was a motion and second to accept the report as read. The motion carried.

Bro. Bud Bivens gave a report from Mexico. There was a motion and second to accept the report as given. The motion carried.

Rev. Barry Long, missionary to Colorado, gave a report. There was a motion and second to accept the report as given. The motion carried.

The moderator asked for prayer to bless the refreshments, and for prayer for Rev. Jerry Smith and his son. Bro. McDaniel called on Rev. Burble Alexander to pray.

Bro. David Brown gave a report from Free Will Baptist Foundation. There was a motion and second to accept the report as given. The motion carried.

Missionaries to Spain Matthew and Brooke Turnbough gave a live report via video.

Bro. Josh Bramblett gave a report from Board of Retirement. There was a motion and second to accept the report as given. The motion carried.

Rev. Brian Williams, missionary to New York, gave a report. There was a motion and second to accept the report as given. The motion carried.

Bro. Rodney Yerby led the congregation singing "Blessed Be the Lord." Bro. Chris Wilhite led prayer. Bro. Yerby led the congregation singing "What A Lovely Name." An offering of \$63.00 was received, with prayer led by Bro. Terry Hamm. Waymon and Gail Fields sang "Roll Back the Clouds."

Bro. McDaniel introduced the morning speaker, Rev. Bill Smith. Bro. Smith preached on "How Should We Live Our Christian Life?" from Phil. 1:27-29.

Bro. McDaniel announced that South Highland Free Will Baptist Church in Muscle Shoals had requested to hold the 2010 State Association. There was a motion and second to accept the request. The motion carried. The 2010 State Meeting will be on November 10-12, 2010.

The clerk gave the registration report. Registration statistics for the 2009 session were as follows:
