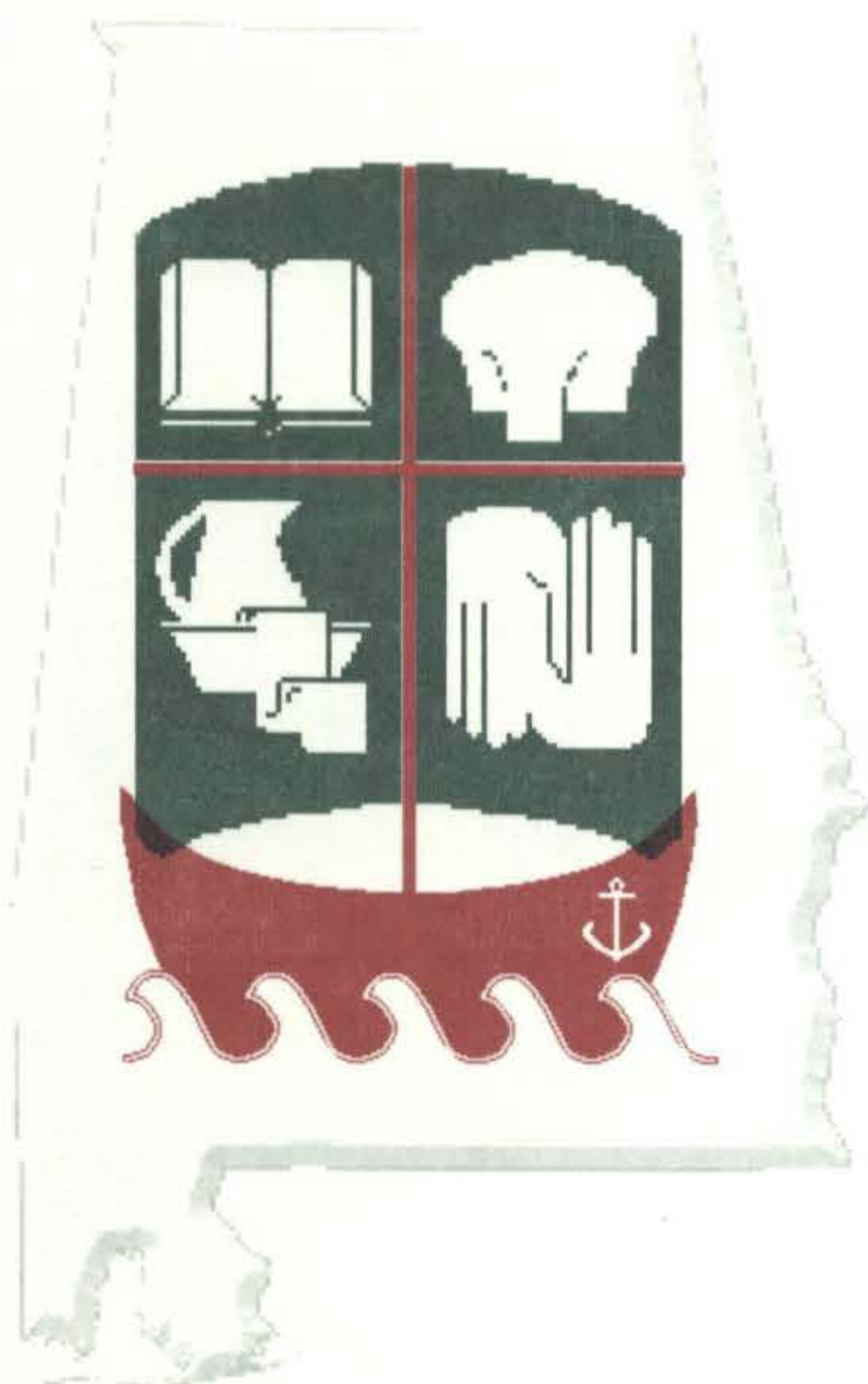

GENERAL BOARD MEETING WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON, NOVEMBER 10, 2010

The General Board met on Wednesday afternoon, November 10, 2010. The assistant moderator, Rev. Jerry Smith, called the meeting to order and opened the meeting with Scripture reading from I Thessalonians 5:1 and prayer.

The clerk, Bro. Rodney Yerby, called the roll of the General Board members. There were 9 members of the General Board present, representing 6 of the 13 District Associations and 3 of the 4 standing boards. The following items were considered by the General Board:

1. Sis. Carolyn Hendrix presented the Women Active for Christ report. There was a motion and second to receive the report. The motion carried.
2. The clerk presented a partial report from the Executive Committee, bringing recommendations to the General Board from the Executive Committee regarding budgets, State Association dues increase and future State Association meeting locations. The General Board dealt with the items as follows:
3. There was a motion and second to recommend the ACTS 1:8 budget (printed on page 26 of the *2010 Digest of Reports*) to the State Association for adoption. The motion carried.
4. There was a motion and second to recommend the Executive Fund budget (printed on page 24 of the *2010 Digest of Reports*) to the State Association for adoption. The motion carried.
5. There was a motion and second to recommend increasing State Association dues by \$50 per church, to offset the increase from the National Association. The motion carried.
6. There was a motion and second to recommend holding future State Association meetings at the following churches, rotating through a six year cycle, unless some other church asks to host the State Association meeting. The motion carried:
 - a. 2011 – Northport
 - b. 2012 – First Dothan
 - c. 2013 – Forestdale
 - d. 2014 – Madison
 - e. 2015 – New Oak Grove
 - f. 2016 – South Highlands
7. Executive Director of State Ministries Rick Cash gave the Executive Director's report. There was a motion and second to receive the report. The motion carried.
8. Rev. Mike Beckon gave the Pastors' and Workers' Conference report. There was a motion and second to receive the report. The motion carried.
9. Rev. Tim Baumgarten gave the Mission Board report. There was a motion and second to receive the report and recommend adopting the budget (printed on page 22 of the *2010 Digest of Reports*). The motion carried.
10. Executive Director Mike Corley and Board Chairman Rodney Yerby gave a report from the Children's Home. There was a motion and second to receive the report and recommend adopting the budget (printed on page 18 of the *2010 Digest of Reports*). The motion carried.
11. The clerk completed the report from the Executive Committee, bringing recommendations to the General Board from the Executive Committee regarding a state office building and future General Board meetings. The General Board dealt with the items as follows:
12. There was a motion and second to recommend building a State Office building, located on the Children's Home property, in accordance with the plans on display, at a cost not to exceed \$250,000, as designated funds are received. The motion carried.

13. There was a motion and second that in future years, the General Board and the Executive Committee will meet together prior to the State Association meeting, typically on Wednesday at 2:00 PM. The motion carried.
14. The General Board received the Nominating Committee report (printed on page 16 of the *2010 Digest of Reports*).
15. The General Board discussed an invitation from Jaimie Lancaster, missionary to Uruguay, for the moderator or other representatives to attend the building dedication in Melo, Uruguay, on December 11, 2010.
16. There was a motion and second to adjourn. The motion carried.

THE NINETY-FIRST SESSION of the ALABAMA STATE ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTISTS WEDNESDAY NIGHT, NOVEMBER 10, 2010

The Alabama State Association of Free Will Baptists convened at South Highlands Free Will Baptist Church in Muscle Shoals, Alabama on Wednesday evening, November 10, 2010.
