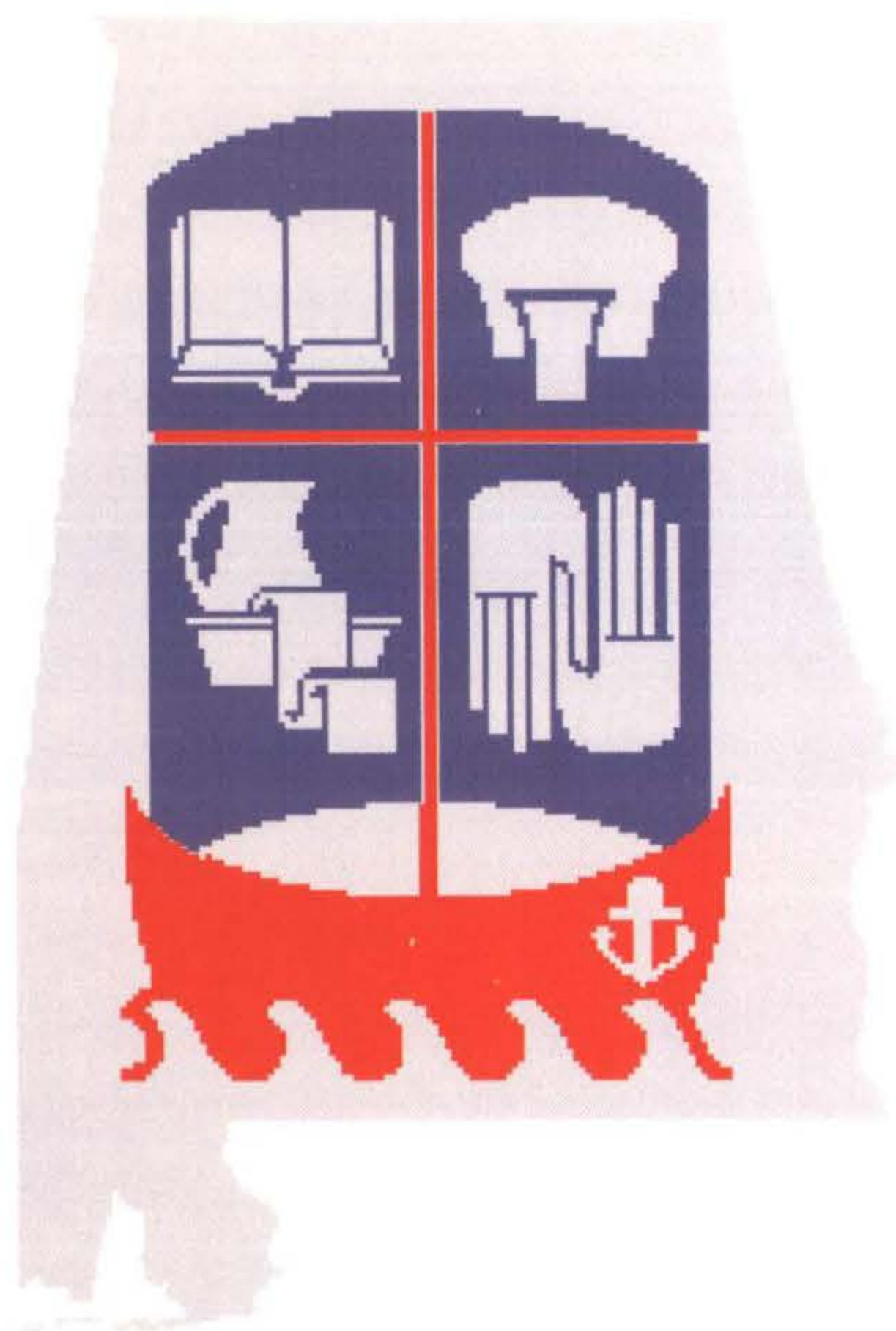

GENERAL BOARD MEETING **WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON, NOVEMBER 9, 2011**

The General Board met on Wednesday afternoon, November 9, 2011. The moderator, Rev. Jerry Smith, called the meeting to order and opened the meeting with Scripture reading from Ephesians, and remarks about the battle we are in. Bro. Smith led in prayer.

The clerk, Bro. Rodney Yerby, called the roll of the General Board members. There were 13 members of the General Board present, representing 7 of the 13 District Associations and 3 of the 4 standing boards (the total of 13 includes 8 members of the Executive Committee; 5 of the 13 people present serve in multiple capacities). The following items were considered by the General Board:

1. Executive Director of State Ministries Rick Cash gave the Executive Director's report. There was a motion and second to accept the report and recommend the budgets. The motion carried.
2. Minutes of the Executive Committee were distributed. There was a motion and second to approve the minutes as printed. The motion carried.
3. Rev. Rick Taylor gave the Board of Christian Education report. The report was received as given.
4. Rev. Danny Williams gave the Mission Board report. There was a motion and second to accept the report. The motion carried.
5. Executive Director Mike Corley gave the Children's Home report. There was a motion and second to accept the report. The motion carried.
6. Sis. Carolyn Michael presented the Women Active for Christ report. There was a motion and second to accept the report as given. The motion carried.
7. Rev. Danny Thompson gave the Nominating Committee report and a report from Castle Rock, CO. The report was received as information.
8. Future State Meeting locations were discussed. First Free Will Baptist of Florence has asked to be included in the meeting location rotation. There was a consensus to direct the Executive Committee to meet with Florence, South Highland, and Dothan to obtain agreement to add Dothan every 4th year, and make a recommendation to the State Association for a new meeting location rotation.
9. There was a suggestion to move the General Board meeting starting time to later in the afternoon. There was a motion and second to meet at 2:00 PM. The motion carried.
10. There was a motion and second to adjourn. Rev. Steve Trail dismissed the meeting in prayer.

THE NINETY-SECOND SESSION **of the** **ALABAMA STATE ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTISTS** **WEDNESDAY NIGHT, NOVEMBER 9, 2011**

The Alabama State Association of Free Will Baptists convened at First Free Will Baptist Church of Northport, in Northport, Alabama on Wednesday evening, November 9, 2011.

The moderator, Rev. Jerry Smith called the meeting to order, and introduced Andra Pate (Disaster Coordinator) from Cordova, who talked about Disaster Relief Efforts.

The Northport Choir sang special music, "Jerusalem." Congregational fellowship followed.

Bro. Chad Donoho led the congregation in singing "Sweet By and By", "When We All Get to Heaven" and "When We See Christ."

Rev. Tim Baumgarten, pastor of the host church, welcomed the State Association to Northport. Bro. Baumgarten led in prayer.

Rev. Larry Powell presented a report from the National Home Missions Department.
