PROCEEDINGS

The 49th Annual Session of the Albemarle Conference of Original Free Will Baptists met October 6, 1993, with Sound Side Free Will Baptist Church, of Columbia, North Carolina.

The congregation sang "There's Power in the Blood" and the Rev. Frankie Baggett gave the devotions using Scripture from Ezekiel 37:1-10. It was a very inspiring message, "Still Serving the Same God." He closed with prayer.

The Rev. Robert May gave the welcome and Bro. Lloyd Jones gave the response. Mr. May brought to our attention that the Rev. Charlie Overton and wife were sick and in the hospital. This was the first Conference he had missed since it was first organized. The Clerk called the Conference to order by using words of the late Mr. Oscar Webster (past Clerk). The adoption of the program was by motion. The enrollment of ministers was next with twelve present, three absent, one sick, and two excused.

A welcome was given to visiting ministers, the Rev. James B. Hardee, of the Pee Dee Association; and the Rev. John Mark Windley, a newly ordained minister of the Albemarle Conference. He asked to become a member of the Conference and was accepted by motion.

The Rev. Robert May, moderator, addressed the Conference, using Scripture from Matthew 18, speaking on the lost sheep and some conditions of our churches today. We need to put Christ first and leave off the world. He then gave the rules of the Conference for the day and appointed the temporary committees: Resolutions and Nomination.

No reports of the standing boards were given except the report of Ordination prepared by the Rev. Charlie Overton (who was sick) was given by the Rev. Frankie Baggett. Report was accepted by motion. (See Reports.)

Albemarle Conference

After various announcements, the roll call of churches were made, with all represented but two. The congregation then sang "Love Lifted Me," while the Executive Board met to reinstate two ministers who had been absent from the Conference for two years without excuse.

The Rev. C. H. Overman gave the report of the Convention. Other reports were given as follows: Home Missions and Evangelism, the Rev. David Charles Hansley; Retirement Homes, the Rev. Walter Sutton; Child Care Ministry of the Children's Home, Dr. Bobby Taylor; Mount Olive College, Mr. Lloyd Jones Jr.; Foreign Missions, Cragmont, Church Finance, and the Free Will Baptist Press, the Rev. C. H. Overman. These reports were accepted by motion as information.

An offering was taken for the benefit of the Conference. The Rev. John Mark Windley prayed the offertory prayer and a prayer for the sick: the Rev. Charlie Overton and his wife, and the family of the Rev. Ken Hardison who passed away.

The delegate's report of the Convention, by Mrs. Eunice Sexton, was accepted by motion. The Rev. Ralph Sumner reported Camp Vandemere had a good year: Many young people were saved; it will soon be celebrating its 25th year of service. Report accepted by motion as information.

Mr. Lloyd Jones Jr. gave the Treasurer's report, which was accepted by motion. (See Reports.)

This ended the business of the morning session. We entered into worship by the congregation singing "What a Friend We Have in Jesus." Mrs. Connie Liverman sang "I Need No Mansion Here Below" and "The Only Real Peace I Have Is in You."

The Rev. W. S. Burns brought a very inspiring message, using Scripture from John 1:14: And "The Word Was Made Flesh and Dwelt Among Us." He closed with the congregation singing "Amazing Grace." The benediction and thanks for the meal were given by the Rev. Robert May.

AFTERNOON SESSION

The afternoon session began with the congregation singing "When We All Get to Heaven." The Rev. Dan Beaman gave the devotion, using Scripture taken from Matthew 5:14-16: "Ye are the light of the world." He asked, "Would you like to make a change as an individual in the world today?", closing with prayer.

A memorial service was given by the Rev. John Mark Windley, using Scripture from Romans 14:7-9. He closed after the reading of all names of the deceased members of the churches and the deceased ministers of the Convention.

A motion was made to revise the rules and regulations of the Ordination Examination given to a candidate to become an ordained minister; motion carried. Those appointed on this committee were the Revs. Charlie Overton, Frankie Baggett, and James Owens.

The Rev. James Corbett reported on the Albemarle Ministerial Association. Report carried by motion as information.

Delegates to the 1994 Convention will be Mr. Gary Burbage and Mrs. Eunice Sexton; accepted by motion.

The Rev. Richard Holmes, pastor of Sidney Church, invited the Conference to meet with them next year. The Conference accepted the invitation. The Rev. Richard Holmes will give the message.

The Rev. Everett Harper gave the report of the Resolutions Committee. Number I was accepted by motion; Number II was accepted by motion; Number III was accepted by a standing vote of appreciation to Sound Side Church for their hosting the Conference in a great way. (See Reports.)

Mr. Billy Dilday gave the report of the Nominating Committee. All the officers were to remain the same except: on the Board of Ordination, the Rev. Harold Swinson was to replace the Rev. Joe Griffith, and the Rev. Richard Holmes to replace the Rev. Joe Griffith on the Board of Missions. Report accepted by motion. (See Reports.)

A motion was made to send \$100 to the Rev. C. H. Overman, executive administrator, for the Convention; \$50 to be sent to the Children's Home to help with Smith Cottage; \$50 to be sent to the Retirement Homes. Motion carried.

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The Minutes of the Conference were read and accepted.

Upon proper motion to adjourn, benediction was by Mr. Billy Dilday.
