Proceedings

The 61st Annual Session of the Albemarle Conference of Original Free Will Baptist met Wednesday, October 5, 2005 at Union Chapel Free Will Baptist Church, Plymouth, NC.

The Session began with the singing of "Are You Washed In the Blood," led by Bro. Lloyd Jones and accompanied by Mrs. Lucille Jones. The Reverend H. P. Norman brought the devotion from 1 Corinthians 15:1-4. The Reverend Al Markuson from the host church gave the welcome to the conference and The Reverend Billy Reynolds gave the response.

The clerk called the 61st Annual Session to order using the words of the late Oscar Webster, "I, David Pooser, clerk of the Albemarle Conference of Original Free Will Baptist do declare the 61st Annual Session of the Conference is now officially in session; for prayer and praise to God, for the preaching of His Word, and the transaction of any business pertinent to the ongoing business of said conference. May God to our good and His glory bless our coming together. The Reverend Bill Mobley, moderator, now presiding," and presented the moderator to preside over the session.

The Roll Call of churches was made with eleven churches present. Four churches were absent.

The roll call of ministers was made with nine present. Five ministers were excused while absent.

The Reverend Bill Mobley gave the Moderator's address challenging us to remember that God's Spirit brings refreshing power to our lives to defeat Satan who seeks to oppose all of God's work, especially in our churches.

The reports of the standing committees were given with no committee having any report.

Bro. Lloyd Jones recommended to the Conference a rising vote of thanks be given to Union Chapel Free Will Baptist Church for the hospitality it showed in hosting the Conference.

Announcements of the revival services and winter events were heard from many churches in the Conference, and from many of the ministries of the Original Free Will Baptists.

Due to the time left before the worship service reports from six ministries of the denomination were heard at this time. Reports were heard from: Sunday School, Mrs. Mary Dudley; Children's Home, Dr. Bobby Taylor; Church Finance, no report; Cragmont Assembly, Mr. Lloyd Jones; Retirement Homes, Mr. Ronnie Taylor; Home Missions and Evangelism, Mrs. Mary Dudley (for Harold Swinson, who was attending a funeral).

The Conference entered into worship with special music by Mrs. Markuson, who sang, "My House is Full," and "Holy Spirit, Touch Through Me." The Reverend Al Markuson followed the special music with the message, "TLC: Touching Lives Christians," from the Biblical passage, Luke 4:1-10. Brother Al challenged us to touch lives and in an honesty seeking manner asked us to question our carrying through of our resolution to rededicate ourselves to seeking the lost and sharing the gospel next door and throughout the world.

The time of worship closed and directions were given to lunch.

The afternoon session began with the hymn, "O How I Love Jesus," and a devotion by The Reverend Royce Reynolds.

The remaining denominational ministries gave reports as follows: Foreign Missions, The Reverend Harold Jones; Free Will Baptist Press, Mr. Darren Davenport; Mt.
