ASSOCIATIONAL PROCEEDINGS

THURSDAY EVENING

The seventh annual session of the Appalachian Association of Free Will Baptist convened at the First Free Will Baptist Church of Johnson City, Tenn., January 23, 1975, at 7 o'clock P. M. Tom Austin was in charge of the music for the association. "Amazing Grace" was sung by the congregation. The Assistant Moderator, Rev. Elmer Carter, called the meeting into session. An altar prayer was led by Rev. Buddy Henry. Associational ministers, deacons, and delegates were recognized and seated as the voting power of the association. Visiting ministers were recognized and seated as advisory council. Rev. Carter presented the moderator, Rev. O. P. Stokes. After greetings, he read I Cor. 12:31, 14:1, and 14:3, and brought the moderator's message. He presented three things a good ministry will include: a ministry of comfort, a ministry of teaching and a ministry of evangelism.

Buddy Henry, Tom Maines, Ray Scaff, Eddie Maupin, and Doyle Hurdtt were appointed by the moderator to serve as the Committee on Committees.

Rev. Stokes introduced the State Promotional Director, Rev. John Gibbs. He presented information concerning the duties of this new work. He will be traveling over the state, promoting all areas of the work. He will also be editor of the state paper, **Echo**.

The worship service began with the congregation singing "Blessed Assurance" and "There is Power in the Blood". Mike Wright presented the special music singing "If you Know the Lord" and "The Longer I Serve Him". Rev. W. L. Kell offered prayer.

The moderator introduced Rev. Daniel Foster, pastor of the Grace F. W. B. Church in Johnson City, Tenn., to bring the evening message. Reading Matt. 16:13-18, he preached on the subject "The Great Cause of the Church". He proclaimed that Christ is our great cause and because of Him, we have a great worship, a great responsibility, a great motive, and one day will have a great victory. He closed with prayer.

The report of the Committee on Committees was presented by Rev. Buddy Henry. Motion was made, seconded, and carried to receive the report.

Rev. Clarence Phillips prayed the closing prayer.

FRIDAY MORNING

The Friday morning session was called to order at 10:00 A. M. with a congregational hymn, "At Calvary". The morning devotions was given by Rev. M. C. Taylor. Reading Amos 6:1, he spoke of the comparison of the church age today and the condition of Israel when God accused them of "being at ease in Zion".

Rev. W. L. Kell presented the report of the General Board and it was accepted. A report of the C. T. S. Convention was presented by Mike Wright. Motion carried to accept report. Rev. Daniel Foster gave a statistician report. Motion was made, seconded, and carried to receive the report. Rev. D. C. Byrd presented a report from the Home Missions Board. Motion carried to accept the report. Talmadge Brown gave the Treasurers report and the report was adopted.

A ten minute recess was declared by the moderator.

The morning worship service began with congregational singing led by Tom Austin. Rev. Gilbert Abel led in prayer. An offering was received for the F. W. B. Home for Children amounting to \$27.46.

Special music included "What Can I Offer the Lord" by Tom Foster, "In the Shelter of His Arms" by Tom, Dan, and Mrs. Guy Foster, and "I Won't Have to Cross Jordan Alone" by Rev. John Gibbs.

The moderator introduced Rev. Doyle Hoilman, pastor of the Y Free Will Baptist Church of Johnson City, Tenn., as the morning speaker. He read Heb. 1:1 and Mark 4:22 and Rev. Tom Maines offered prayer. Rev. Hoilman, preaching from the subject, "God Sees, God Hears, and God Speaks", emphasized the need for today's preachers to preach the Word and face issues.

A partial report of the Ordaining Council was given recommending that the First F. W. B. Church of Church Hill be received into the Appalachian Association. Motion was made, seconded, and carried to receive them into the Association, and the right hand of fellowship was extended to the delegates and pastor of the church during a time of song and fellowship.

A motion carried to adjourn for lunch.

FRIDAY AFTERNOON

The Friday afternoon session convened at 1:30 P. M. Tom Austin led the congregation in singing "Revive Us Again". Rev. Ray Scalf presented a devotion. Reading St. John 1:12, he challenged Christians to live like sons of God—because He has adopted us! Rev. Winford Floyd offered prayer.

The report of the Sunday School Convention was presented by Carl Nelson and was received.

Rev. Carl Nelson presented a recommendation from the Nominating Committee that all officers be retained until the next annual meeting, since the change of dates of the meeting resulted in some officers having served for only six months. Motion was made to adopt the report and retain the same officers. Motion was seconded and carried.

Greetings from the State Home Missions were expressed by Rev. John Gibbs. He gave a general report of our mission work in Memphis, Crossville, and Murfreesboro, praising God for the progress being seen in these areas and requesting prayer for them.

W. C. Amos presented the report of the Retirement Board and motion carried to adopt the report. The Placement Committee's recommendations were presented and adopted.

A standing vote of appreciation was given to the host pastor, Rev. Clarence Phillips, and to the First Free Will Baptist Church of Johnson City for their hospitality.

The moderator presented Rev. James Raper, Superintendent of the Home for Children. He introduced members of his staff and a large number of the children now in the Home. A special program of songs was presented by a group of the children. Rev. Raper expressed his appreciation for the support and prayers of the Appalachian Association.

A question was brought to the floor by Rev. Clarence Phillips concerning a possible violation of the Constitution and By-Laws governing the Association. He read portions of the F. W. B. Treatise and the Constitution of the Association concerning the transfer of a minister from one Association to another. During the discussion it was established that Rev. Gilbert Abel had been received into the Appalachian Association on October 19, 1974 without a letter of recommendation from the Jack's Creek Association of which he formerly was a member. After several different views were expressed from the floor, Rev. Guy Foster, chairman of the Ordaining Council, made a motion

that the matter be tabled until the next (quarterly) meeting when he would either produce a letter of recommendation or ask that Rev. Abel be dropped from the Association. The motion received a second and carried.

Motion carried to adjourn and Brother I. L. Stanley dismissed with prayer.

FRIDAY EVENING

The Friday evening session opened with a congregational hymn, "Stand Up For Jesus". The Quartet of the host church provided the special music, singing "Day of Mercy", "At the Feet of Jesus", and "Let's Just All Praise the Lord". Rev. Terry Hopson led in prayer. The report of the Ordaining Council was presented by Eugene Deaton. Motion was made, received a second, and carried to adopt the report.

A solo, "Follow Me" was rendered by Rev. John Gibbs. The moderator presented Rev. Elmer Carter, pastor of Keensburg F. W. B. in Elizabethton, to bring the Ordination Message. Reading Matt. 7:28, 29, Matt. 28:18-20, and II Tim. 1:12, Rev. Carter preached from the subject, "Preach With Authority", and closed with prayer.

The moderator presented the chairman of the Ordaining Council, Rev. Guy Foster. He presented Ray Scalf and Grady Holder as candidates for ordination. The scripture charge, I Tim. 3:1-7 was read by Rev. Eugene Deaton. Rev. Carl Steele gave the Ordination Charge. The prayer of dedication was led by Rev. Carl Nelson. Rev. Scalf and Rev. Holder were joined by their wives and each minister gave a testimony. Licenses were presented to Joe Williams and George Scalf, Jr. A time of fellowship was enjoyed by all.

A motion was made to give \$300.00 to the State Executive Department, to be placed in the account for the Promotional Director. Motion carried. A motion was made to increase by \$25.00 the fee paid the Assoc. clerk per year. Motion received second and carried.

A motion was made that the seventh annual session of the Appalachian Association be adjourned. Motion carried and Rev. C. B. Shoemaker prayed the benediction.
