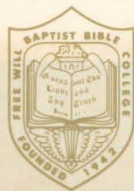

ASSOCIATIONAL PROCEEDINGS

THURSDAY EVENING

The eighth annual session of the Appalachian Association of Free Will Baptist convened at the Canah Chapel F. W. B. Church in Erwin, Tennessee, January 22, 1976, at 7:00 P. M. Mr. Tom Austin led the congregation in singing "When the Roll is Called Up Yonder". Mrs. Joyce Grindstaff served as pianist and Mr. Stanley Sneed as organist. Prayer was offered by Rev. Raymond Davis. The Assistant Moderator, Rev. Elmer Carter, called the session to order. All ministers were asked to come to the altar for a special prayer for guidance during the Association. Rev. John Gibbs led the prayer.

All ministers, deacons, and delegates were recognized and seated as the voting power of this session. Visiting ministers and other visitors were welcomed and seated as an advisory council to the Association while in session. A warm welcome was extended by the host pastor, Rev. Talmadge Brown.

Rev. Carter presented the moderator, Rev. O. P. Stokes. After greetings, he read Malachi 3:8-10, and brought a brief message on the subject, "Success, Happiness, and Prosperity in 1976". There was prayer by Rev. Guy Foster.

The Committee on Committees, appointed by the Moderator, consisted of Rev. Winford Floyd, Rev. Jack Ward, Rev. John Townsend, Rev. Eddie Maupin, and Rev. Doyle Hoilman.

The Moderator introduced the following Tennessee State Association and National Association officers: Rev. John Gibbs, State Promotional Director, Rev. Paul Ketterman, F. W. B. Bible College, and Rev. Clarence Phillips, State Moderator.

As the congregation sang "Blessed Assurance", an offering was received for the expense of the Association amounting to \$50.86. Rev. Clarence Phillips prayed the offertory prayer.

The worship service began with the congregation singing "There is Power in the Blood". Special music was provided by Rev. John Gibbs singing "I'd Rather Have Jesus", and Rev. Larry Burton singing "Who Am I". The moderator introduced Rev. E. J. Young of Paintsville, Ky., to present the evening message. Reading Hebrew 12:1, 2, he preached from the subject, "Someone is Looking On", using as examples Abel who came by the blood, Abraham who came by faith, Gideon who came with quality and not quantity, and Joshua who came with courage to stand.

The Report of the Committee on Committees was presented by Rev. Jack Ward. The report was adopted with recommended committees being accepted.

Rev. Larry Burton prayed the benediction.

FRIDAY MORNING

The Friday morning session was called to order at 10:00 A. M. by the moderator, Rev. Stokes. Mr. Tom Austin led the congregational song "I Am Thine O Lord", and Rev. Floyd Phillips offered prayer. The morning devotions were presented by Rev. Houston Blevins. Reading I Samuel 12:24, he prayed, then spoke on the subject "Great Things Has the Lord Done For Us".

The Report of the Executive Board, presented by Rev. W. L. Kell, was adopted. The Statistician's Report by Dan Foster was accepted, and a motion carried to authorize clerk to add any reports that might come in before material is ready for printers. Treasurer, Talmadge Brown, presented the Financial report for the quarter and the year. Motion was made, seconded and carried to adopt report. Mrs. Mary

Lou Stinson presented an interesting report of the Sunday School Convention, and it was received. Rev. D. C. Byrd gave the report of the Home Missions Board, and the report was received.

A ten minute recess was declared by moderator and Rev. Tom Maines dismissed with prayer.

Worship service began with congregational singing. Rev. Elmer Carter led in prayer. An offering for the F. W. B. Children's Home was received amounting to \$38.09. Rev. Eddie Maupin blessed the offering. Special music was provided by Rev. Dan Foster singing "Without Him". Rev. C. B. Shoemaker, pastor of Clay Hill F. W. B. in Blountville, Tn., was presented to bring the morning message. After praying, he read Psalms 126:1-6 and I Cor. 10:6, and preached from the subject, "Captivity to Freedom".

After the message, a time of fellowship and song was enjoyed by the congregation. Prayer of dismissal and blessings on the food was prayed by Rev. Richard Adams.

FRIDAY AFTERNOON

The Friday afternoon session convened at 1:30 P. M. Tom Austin led the congregation in singing "Stand Up for Jesus". Since the scheduled devotional speaker was absent, this time was used for special prayer request. Special prayer was asked for Rev. and Mrs. John Cansler, Mrs. Blanche Howington, Bob Shockey, and a member of the Morrison City Church having heart surgery. Rev. Edward Swartz led the prayer.

The Children's Home was represented by Rev. and Mrs. Raper and several of the children from the Home. A brief description of the way the Home is operated was presented by Rev. Raper. He introduced the children with him, expressed his thanks for the financial contributions from our Assoc., and made some special prayer request concerning the children of the Home. Rev. Paul Ketterman, representing the F. W. B. Bible College, was presented by the Moderator. He let us see some of the behind-the-scenes men of the college, as he described their work and the great contribution they make to the operation of the College. Tennessee State Promotional Director, Rev. John Gibbs, presented a brief report on the program of the state work. A motion was made to receive all these reports as information. Motion was seconded and carried. Rev. Talmadge Brown presented a report from the CTS Convention and read a request from the Teach and Train Board that each church send \$10.00 to help finance the fees, etc. for the State winners at the National Assoc. The report was received.

Rev. W. C. Amos presented the financial report of the Retirement Board, and it was received. Report of the Resolutions Committee, presented by Rev. Buddy Henry, was adopted by vote. Report of the Placement Committee was adopted. Rev. Jack Ward read the report of the Nominating Committee. The report was received with those nominated being elected. The State Home Missions Board was represented by Rev. Gibbs. Report was received as information.

A motion was made to give \$500.00 to the Tenn. State Office to be ear-marked for the station-wagon account. The motion received a second. A motion was made to add an amendment also giving \$200.00 to the Children's Home, and \$100.00 to the Bible College. The amendment was seconded and carried. The amended motion was voted on and carried. A motion was made to supplement the Retirement Board with \$200.00 from the general fund. Motion carried.

The date for the next annual Association was set for January 20, 21, 1977.

FRIDAY EVENING

Praise in song opened the service for Friday evening as Mr. Tom Austin led the congregation in "Praise Him, Praise Him", and "Blessed Assurance". There was a prayer by Rev. Carl Nelson. The moderator, Rev. O. P. Stokes, welcomed the congregation.

The Moderator read a recommendation by which the Appalachian Association could recognize and recommend Rev. Carl Nelson as a full time evangelist. A motion was made to adopt the recommendation, and authorize the clerk to send notices to our State and National publications. Motion received seconded and carried.

Clerk of the Ordaining Council, Rev. Eugene Deaton, read their report. The report was received with all recommendations being adopted.

As the congregation sang "Amazing Grace", an offering was received for Associational expenses. Rev. Stanley Parkey prayed the offertory prayer. The offering received was \$25.50.

The Christian Four from the Berea F. W. B. Church in Johnson City, Tenn., provided the special music. They sang, "He'll Call My Name", "Tears Will Never Stain the Streets of That City", and "Jesus is Mine".

Rev. Frank Thompson, an evangelist from Johnson City, Tenn., was introduced to bring the Ordination Message. Reading Scriptures from Jer. 23:29, II Tim. 2:15, and II Tim 3:16, 17, Rev. Thompson used the subject, "Do You Know How To Use God's Hammer?". His message challenged the young preachers, as well as all christians, to qualify to use God's hammer by keeping their lives pure and above reproach, to be sure of the call from God to use His hammer, to put winning souls to Christ before everything else, and to know God's hammer, which is His Word. He closed by quoting II Tim. 4:1-5 to the men being ordained.

Rev. Eugene Deaton introduced Rev. Ivery Padgett and Rev. Eddie Maupin who were being ordained into the ministry. Their wives joined them at the altar. Rev. Dan Foster presented the Scriptural Charge reading I Tim. 3:1-7. Rev. Buddy Henry continued the Charge placing special emphasis upon the importance of their call and the responsibility it places upon them. Rev. Carl Nelson led the ordination prayer.
