PROCEEDINGS

MONDAY EVENING, APRIL 2, 1979

The eleventh annual session of the Appalachian Association of Free Will Baptist convened at the Canah Chapel Free Will Baptist Church in Erwin, Tennessee, on April 2, 1979 at 7:00 P.M. Mr. Ken deVrives led the congregational hymn, "I Will Sing the Wonderous Story" with Cindy deVrives at the piano and Stanley Sneed at the organ. Due to the absence of the Moderator, Rev. Carl Nelson, the Chair was filled by the Assistant Moderator, Rev. D. C. Byrd, who called the Association into official session. Rev. Doyle Hoilman was called upon for prayer. The delegates were recognized and seated with Associational Ministers and deacons as the voting power of this session. Visiting Ministers were recognized and seated as advisory council. The host pastor, Talmadge Brown, extended a warm welcome to the congregation. The Moderator gave a challenging message from the scripture, Jeremiah 6:16.

The Chair appointed O. P. Stokes, Elmer Carter, Jimmy Maines, Dennis Crowe, Jr. and Earnest Garland to serve as the Committee on Committees. The Tennessee State Promotional Director, Rev. Wallace Hayes, was recognized.

Music was provided by the host church choir and a special solo, "In The Rush" was sung by Mrs. Cindy deVrives. An announcement made by Rev. O. P. Stokes concerning a Christian School Rally to be held at the East Side Church on April 16, 17, 1979, was received as information. After the congregational hymn, "How Great Thou Art", Rev. Gary Hodges led in prayer.

Rev. Millard Johnson, pastor of the Trinity FWB Church in Erwin, Tenn., was introduced to bring the evening message. After prayer, Rev. Johnson read Matt. 23:13 and brought a message from the subject "Preventing Conversions". He presented four examples of the witnessing of the world and challenged the

christians to present a stronger witness of Christ than the witness of the world. He closed with prayer.

Rev. Elmer Carter presented the report of the Committee on Committees. A motion carried to adopt the report.

Benediction was by Rev. John Townsend.

TUESDAY MORNING, APRIL 3, 1979

The Tuesday morning service opened at 10:00 A. M. with Assistant Moderator, Rev. D. C. Byrd, in the Chair. Randy Riggs led the congregational hymn, "Revive Us Again". The morning devotions was by Rev. Roy Adkins. Reading Hebrews 1:1-7, he spoke of the need for God's ministers to be a flaming fire, and closed with prayer. The report of the Executive Board was read by Harold Harris and was accepted. The report of the Statistician, presented by Randy Riggs, was accepted. The Moderator called for an altar prayer and Rev. Lester Mac Kinnon led this prayer. The Financial Report for the year was presented by treasurer, Talmadge Brown. He also gave the Quarterly report for January, February, and March, 1979. Both reports were adopted. Report of the Sunday School Convention was read by the Clerk and received. The Moderator explained that he must be away during the afternoon session and opened the floor to elect a Moderator pro tem for this session. Talmadge Brown was elected. A recess was declared by the Moderator and Rev. Paul Ketterman dismissed with prayer.

The morning worship service began with the congregation singing, "Leaning on the Everlasting Arms". Rev. Carl Osborne offered prayer. An offering was received for the Home for Children and Rev. J. C. Wilson led in prayer. Mr. Randy Riggs led the congregation singing "To God Be The Glory" and Rev. Houston Blevins sang "Rock of Ages". Rev. Bill Johnson offered prayer.

Rev. Fred Greene, pastor of the Doran Addition FWB Church in Kingsport, Tennessee, was presented to bring the morning message. Reading from Isa. 21:11-12, 62:6, Acts 20:28, and Rom. 13:4, Rev. Greene brought a sermon to the "Watchmen of God". He used these special points for a good watchman: he must be called of God, he must listen for God's way, and he must live a life committed to God. An altar call for commitment was responded to by many. Rev. Greene closed with prayer.

Recessed for lunch as Rev. Roy Lester dismissed with prayer.

TUESDAY AFTERNOON, APRIL 3, 1979

The Tuesday afternoon session was called to order at 1:30 P. M. with Talmadge Brown in the Chair. Afternoon devotions was presented by Rev. Earnest Garland, using scripture from Galatians 6:7-14 and closing with prayer. Music was provided by a quartet comprised of Rev. James Raper, Rev. Dan Foster, Rev. Talmadge Brown, and Mr. Randy Riggs. They sang "The Uncloudy Day".

The report of the CTS Convention was given by Dan Foster and received as information. Report of the Youth Board was given by Talmadge Brown and

received as information. The moderator introduced Rev. Wallace Hayes, the Tenn. State Promotional Director. He gave a brief report of the state work and expressed appreciation for the support of the Appalachian Association. The Home Missions Department was represented by two Home Missionaries, Rev. Buddy Bell in Lebanon, Tn., and Rev. Glen Poston in Millington, Tn. They each gave a description of the work they are involved in as they minister in these areas. Rev. Paul Ketterman was introduced and presented information from the Free Will Baptist Bible College. These reports were received as information.

The report of the Retirement Board was presented by the treasurer, Rev. Wallace Amos, and was adopted. Rev. James Raper, Superintendent of the Home For Children, was introduced and presented information concerning finances, children, and special Home Coming Day set for May 12, 1979. A motion carried to accept the report as information. The Necrology Committee, represented by Mr. Bill Hyder, requested that any names to be included in this report should be given to them as soon as possible. The Report of the Placement Committee was presented by Rev. L. J. Oliver and adopted. Rev. O. P. Stokes read the report of the Resolutions Committee and it was adopted. Rev. Eddie Maupin read the recommendations from the Nominating Committee. A motion was made that the report be accepted and all those nominated therein be elected. Motion received a second and carried.

Mr. Bill Hyder prayed the benediction as the afternoon session closed.

TUESDAY EVENING, APRIL 3, 1979

A program of pre-service music was presented by the Believers, a visiting quartet. The evening session opened with Rev. Byrd in the Chair. Mr. Ken deVrives led the congregation in "The Solid Rock" with Carolyn Plesant at the organ. Rev. Earnest Garland led in prayer. Special music was again provided by the Believers Quartet. An offering was received for the expense of the Association amounting to \$46.74. Rev. W. C. Amos prayed the offertory prayer. "Saved, Saved" was sung by the congregation.

The Moderator presented Rev. W. L. Kell, Chairman of the Ordaining Council. Rev. Kell then presented Rev. Eddie Maupin, Clerk of the Ordaining Council who presented the recommendations of the Council. A motion was made to accept the report and adopt all recommendations therein. The motion received a second and carried.

The worship part of the service began with congregational singing. Rev. W. L. Kell, pastor of the First FWB of Morrison City in Kingsport, Tn., was presented to bring the Ordination message. Reading II Kings 2:1-25, Rev. Kell brought a message in which he held Elisha following his master, up as an example of the way Ministers should follow their Master today. He described three types of people any minister will be confronted with: (a) the doubters, (b) the despisers, and (c) the desperate ones. He closed with prayer.

Rev. Ray Stockton was presented as the candidate for ordination. Rev. Elmer Carter gave the charge using II Tim. 4:1-4. The Ordination prayer was led by Rev. Eddie Maupin. Rev. Ronnie Pritchard was presented a license to preach

for one year and the licenses of Rev. Rickey Cox and Rev. Roy Adkins were renewed for one year. Each of the young ministers gave a personal testimony.

Rev. O. P. Stokes offered prayer and a time of fellowship and song was enjoyed by all. The eleventh annual session of the Appalachian Association was adjourned.
