PROCEEDINGS

MONDAY EVENING, APRIL 5, 1982

The fourteenth session of the Appalachian Association of Free Will Baptists convened at the Keystone Free Will Baptist Church of Johnson City, Tn., on April 5-6, 1982 at 7:00 P.M. Tom Austin led the congregational hymn, "When We All Get To Heaven," with Jewel Dillinger as pianist.

The Assistant Moderator, Rev. Roy Duckett, called the session to order. Rev. Clarence Phillips offered prayer. The Associational ministers, deacons, and delegates were recognized and seated as voting power of the Association. The visiting ministers were welcomed and seated as advisory council to the session.

The Host Pastor, Rev. W. L. Kell, extended a warm welcome to the session.

Rev. Duckett presented the Moderator, John Townsend. After a welcome to the congregation, he read Psalms 17:14-15. An altar prayer was led by Rev. O. P. Stokes.

Appointed by the Moderator to serve on the Committee on Committees were Rev. Earnest Garland, Edgar Coleman, Johnny Townsend, Jimmy Maines and Kenneth Grindstaff.

The Gospelite Quartet from Burleson Chapel Free Will Baptist Church, Spruce Pine, N. C., presented special singing. Rev. Winford Floyd, Pastor of First Free Will Baptist Church of Elizabethton, Tn., was presented to bring the Keynote Message. Reading John 1:28-42, his subject was "The Making of a Man." He preached about how in the beginning God made man, and how God used Moses, Saul of Tarsus, Jonah, and Simon Peter to be what he wanted them to be and if we live for Him, how He can touch our lives and make us what He wants us to be. He brought a wonderful and challenging message.

Rev. Kenneth Grindstaff gave the report from the Committee on Committees and it was adopted.

Rev. Millard Johnson prayed the benediction.

TUESDAY MORNING, APRIL 6, 1982

The morning session opened at 10:00 A.M. with a special song, "Close to Thee," by Rev. Houston Blevins. Devotions were presented by Rev. Earnest Garland, reading Acts 8:26. Prayer was by Rev. Clarence Phillips. An offering of \$26.50 was received for the expense of the Association.

The report of the General Board was presented by Rev. Roy Duckett and was adopted. The report of the Sunday School Convention was presented by Rev. W. C. Amos and received as information. The report of the Statistician was presented by Rev. W. L. Kell and adopted. The report of the Ordaining Council was presented by Rev. Elmer Carter and adopted.

A ten minute recess was declared by the Moderator.

The morning worship service opened with the congregational hymn, "I Would Not Be Denied," led by Tom Austin with Lila Tittle as pianist. Rev. Arthur Luster, Pastor of the Valley Forge Free Will Baptist Church, was presented to bring the message. Reading Exodus 4:1-2, he preached from the subject, "What Have You Got In Your Hand." He instructed us to use whatever we have, whether it be a little or a lot, and use it for the glory of God that He will take it and perform miracles with it. He brought a challenging message. Rev. D. C. Byrd offered prayer.

A most delicious lunch was served in the fellowship hall by the ladies of the church and was enjoyed by all. Rev. Frank Thompson dismissed with prayer.

TUESDAY AFTERNOON, APRIL 6, 1982

The afternoon session was called to order at 1:30 P.M. A congregational hymn, "Jesus Saves," was led by Phil Poston. Devotions were presented by Rev. James Wilson, reading Rev. 2:1-5.

The report of the C.T.S. Convention was presented by Mr. Tom Pleasant and was received as information. The report of the Youth and Education Board was presented by Richard Adams. He reported the cost per camper has increased from \$35.00 to \$40.00. It was received as information. A motion was made and seconded that the Association give \$200 toward expenses on Youth Camp. This was adopted.

Rev. Adams gave a brief report on the State Office, informing us of the election of a new State Promotional Director, Rev. Raymond Riggs. This was received as information. Rev. Wallace Amos presented the report of the Retirement Board and this was adopted.

The report of the Home for Children was presented by Mrs. James Raper and she thanked the Association for their support and requested prayer that the Lord would open avenues for the children. This was received as information. The report of the Placement Committee was presented by Rev. Harry Richardson and adopted. The report of the Resolution Committee was presented by Phil Poston and adopted. A motion was made to send a letter to the Free Will Baptist Bible College informing them of this resolution: "We resolve that the Appalachian Association re-affirm our stand against alcoholic beverages and that Christ neither made fermented wine or drank it." A motion was made to table this motion.

Rev. Richard Adams presented the report of the Nominating Committee. A motion was made that the report be received and all those nominated be elected. This was adopted.

Phil Poston was elected Choir Director and Tom Austin, his assistant. Lila Tittle was elected pianist. It was moved and seconded to make a delayed report on the Finance Committee until the Committee had time to audit the books. The meeting was adjourned until the evening session.

TUESDAY EVENING, APRIL 6, 1982

The evening session opened at 7:00 P.M. with the congregational hymn, "There Is Power In The Blood." An offering of \$65.08 was received for the Free Will Baptist Children's Home.

Special music was provided by the Savings Grace Quartet.

The Moderator presented the Chairman of the Ordaining Council, Rev. Jack Greene, and he presented Rev. Jack Lloyd, Pastor of the Watauga Valley Free Will Baptist Church, to bring the ordination message. Reading Romans 10:13-15, his subject was "So You Want to Be a Preacher." He led in prayer. Elmer Carter then called Rev. Harry Richardson forward to be ordained. He gave the charge. Rev. Richardson and other ministers presenting themselves for membership were given a right hand of fellowship.

Rev. O. P. Stokes dismissed with prayer and the fourteenth session of the Appalachian Association was adjourned.
