PROCEEDINGS

MONDAY EVENING, APRIL 2, 1984

The sixteenth Annual session of the Appalachian Association of Free Will Baptists, met at the Morrison City Free Will Baptist Church, Kingsport, TN on Monday evening, April 2, 1984 at 7:00 p.m.

The session opened with a Congregational Hymn "Standing on the Promises" led by Sherrill Foran with Lila Title as Pianist.

The session was called to order by Rev. W.L. Kell. The Associational delegates, Ministers, and Deacons were recognized and seated as voting power of the Association. The visiting Ministers were seated as advisory council. Rev. Guy Foster, host Pastor, extended a warm welcome to all. Rev. Kell introduced Moderator, Elmer Carter, who brought greetings and read 1st Corinthians 14:40, he then read the By-Laws of the Association, and offered Prayer. Moderator Carter appointed the following to serve on the Committee on Committees: C.B Shoemaker, Gilbert Abel, Dan Foster, David Luster, and Ronny Pritchard.

Special music was presented by Mark and Donna Yontz, members of the host Church.

Moderator Carter presented the Keynote Speaker, Rev. David Carter, Pastor of the Valley Falls Free Will Baptist Church, Spartanburg, SC. David preached from the subject "Crucified with Christ," reading Galations 2:12-20, Romans 6:6, and Matthew 16:24. He noted that Paul said I am crucified with Christ: and reminded us that self was the problem in the Church today. He gave us four good points that we should crucify.

1. Self-energy
2. Self-complacency
3. Self-glory
4. Self-pity

This was a wonderful, spirit filled message. He closed with Prayer.

A special offering of \$200.49 was received for the Lebanon Tennessee Church, a State Association Home Missions project.

The committee on Committees report was presented by Rev. Dan Foster. (See report below). Following announcements the service adjourned till Tuesday morning. Rev. Robert Parker dismissed in Prayer.

TUESDAY MORNING, APRIL 3, 1984

The Tuesday morning session opened with congregational singing led by Tom Foster with Lila Title as Pianist. Devotions were presented by Rev. James Richardson, Pastor of Morre's chapel Free Will Baptist Church. He read 2nd Corinthians 9:12 and led in Prayer.

The report of the Executive Board was presented by Rev. Jack Lloyd, and it was moved and motion carried that this report be adopted. (See report below). The report of the Statistician was presented by Rev. Doyle Hoilman and this report was adopted. (See report below). The report of the Treasurer was presented by Rev. Roy Duckett in absence of Millard Johnson and this report was adopted (See report below). The Sunday School Convention had not met so there was not any report. (See report below for Officers). The report of the CTS Convention was presented by Rev. Amos. He reported a good interest and attendance. (See report below). This was received as information. The report of the Youth was presented by Phil Poston and he encouraged all Pastors to rally behind their youth and encourage them to attend the Youth Camp, he noted that they would have some interesting speakers. This was received as information. Rev. Wallace Hayes brought greetings from the Foreign Mission Department and this was received as information. Rev. W. L. Kell offered Prayer.

The Moderator presented Rev. W.L. Kell, Pastor of Keenburb Free Will Baptist Church, to bring the Morning Message. His subject was "Standing on Wits End." He read Psalms 107:23-30. He preached that when we have used all of our ability, talents and etc, and get to the point in life that we don't know what else to do, we have to totally depend on the power of God. He closed with Prayer. A good challenging message.

An offering of \$39.00 was received for the Childrens' Home.

The Morning worship service closed with Prayer, and a delicious lunch was served in the Fellowship Hall by the ladies of the Church.

TUESDAY AFTERNOON SESSION, APRIL 3, 1984

The Tuesday Afternoon session opened with a Congregational Hymn, "When we all get to Heaven," led by Rev. Dan Foster with Lila Title as Pianist. Johnny Townsend brought Devotion from Jeremiah. He offered Prayer.

Rev. W.L. Kell brought greetings from the Tennessee State Home Missions office and thanked the session for the special offering, received for the Lebanon Tennessee Church. This was received as information. The report of the Retirement Board was presented by Rev. W.C. Amos and this report was adopted. (See report below). Bro. Amos announced his resignation from the board, after 16 years of dedicated service. A motion was made and carried that he be presented with a plaque in appreciation of his 16 years of faithful service to the Association. The report of the Home for Children was presented by the Superintendant, Rev. James Earl Raper. He reminded us of the Annual Homecoming and thanked the Association for their support and Prayers. This was received as information. The reports of the following committees were presented. Placement, by Rev. Harry Richardson and was adopted. (See report below). Nominating Committee was presented by Rev.

W.C. Amos and was adopted. Sherrill Foran was elected Song Director, Lila Title as Pianist. Ernest Garland as Promotional Director of local Association. The following officers were elected: Mrs. Ruby Carter, Clerk, Rev. W.L. Kell, Moderator, Rev. Jack Lloyd, Assistant Moderator, Rev. Millard J. Johnson, Treasurer, Mrs. Ruth Duckett, Statistician, S.A. Foran, Executive Board member, Rev. James Richardson, Youth Board, Kenneth Grindstaff, Retirement Board member, Rev. Doyle Hoilman, Ordaining Council member. This report was adopted. Rev. Kenneth Grindstaff presented the Resolutions report, and he suggested that the young ministers be used more by our Churches and they be put on the Quarterly and Annual Programs. It was pointed out by the Moderator that this was not a form of resolution and ruled it out of order. He also pointed out that the Churches selected their own speakers for the Quarterly meeting and the Executive Board for the Annual Program. (The resolution adopted is in report below). It was suggested that each Church send in the names of their deceased to the Associational Clerk and it be printed in the Annual Minutes.

Several Ministers in the delegation expressed concern over the revised By-Laws of the Board of Retirement of the National Association, after much discussion it was adopted that the Board contact the Director, Herman Hershey and advise him how we stand on the issue and report back to the next Quarterly meeting in July. It was suggested that the Ministers who have paid in the Retirement, withhold their monies till they can be contacted concerning this.

The report of the Finance Committee was presented by Rev. Roy Duckett and adopted. (See report below in minutes).

It was moved and motion carried that the By-Laws of the Constitution of the Appalachian Association stay on the table till the next Quarterly meeting.

It was moved to adjourn till the Evening session and Rev. Earl Austin dismissed in Prayer.

TUESDAY EVENING SESSION, APRIL 3, 1984

The Tuesday Evening session opened with Congregational singing led by Mark Yontz. The Choir of Morrison City Free Will Baptist Church presented special music, directed by Mark Yontz.

It was moved and motion carried that instead of the usual Offering being received for the Associational expenses that it be received for Rev. C.B. Shoemaker. The Moderator presented Rev. O.P. Stokes who had charge of the Ordination service. The report of the Ordaining Council was presented by Rev. Dan Foster and all recommendations were adopted. (See report below). Dan also gave the charge to Johnny Townsend who was ordained, and Rev. Johnnie Floyd, Jr. brought the Message, reading Titus 1:9 and 1st Chronicles 9. He spoke about the duties of Ordained Ministers and Deacons. He closed with Prayer. A right hand of fellowship was extended to Johnny Townsend, who was ordained, Sam Ferguson who is licensed to preach and to Rev. Earl Austin who is coming for membership. A good fellowship was enjoyed by all.

The 16th Annual session of the Appalachian Association adjourned. Rev. Sam Ferguson prayed the Benediction.
