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PROCEEDINGS

MONDAY EVENING, APRIL 1, 1985

The seventeenth Annual Session of the Appalachian Association of Free Will Baptist met at the Keenbourg Free Will Baptist Church, Elizabethton, TN on Monday evening April 1, 1985 at 7:00 p.m. A Congregational Hymn "Amazing Grace" was led by E.J. Johnson, with Lila Tittle as Pianist.

The session was called to order by Rev. Jack Lloyd, Prayer by Rev. Jack Greene. The Associational Delegates, Minister's and Deacons were recognized and seated as voting power of the Convention. The Visiting Ministers were welcomed and seated as advisory Council. The Host Pastor Rev. Eddie Maupin extended a warm welcome to all. Rev. Lloyd introduced the Moderator Rev. W.L. Kell. After a welcome to the Session, he read Psalms 133 and led in Prayer. Moderators message (see below).

An Altar of Prayer was led by Rev. Frank Woods. Moderator Kell appointed the following to serve on the Committee of Committees: Jack Lloyd, Gene Deaton, Eddie Maupin, Kenneth Grindstaff, Ronnie Pritchard.

Moderator Kell brought greetings from the State Home Mission Board and then presented the Keynote speaker, Rev. James Earl Raper, Supt. of Childrens' Home, Greenville, TN. Before he presented he gave a brief report on the Childrens' Home and reported everything well and reminded us of the Annual Homecoming at the Home in May. He brought a good message, reading Acts 13, 5-13. He preached from the subject: "Alive in Dedication." He spoke about some dedicated men John Mark and Saul and Barnabas, about their assets and liabilities, how they were not half hearted committed but totally dedicated for their lives to be used for God, and reminded us that we should also be willing to let our lives be used for the glory of God. He closed with Prayer and gave an invitation.

Rev. Gene Deaton presented the report of Committee on Committees and the following were elected. (see report below).

An Offering of \$70.10 was received for the expenses of the Association. Prayer by Rev. Guy Foster.

The meeting adjourned till Tuesday Morning. Rev. Carl Grindstaff prayed the Benediction.

TUESDAY MORNING, APRIL 2, 1985

The Tuesday Morning session opened with a Congregational Hymn, "Blessed Assurance" led by Sherrill Foran. Rev. D.C. Byrd offered Prayer. Devotions were presented by Rev. Edwin Bailey, Pastor of Southside Free Will Baptist Church, Elizabethton. He read Phillipians 3, 13-14 and led in Prayer.

The report of the General Board was presented by Rev. Jack Lloyd and this was adopted (see report below). The report of the Statistician was presented by Ruth Duckett, and this report was adopted. (see report below). There wasn't any report of the Sunday School Convention since it hadn't met yet, but received it later. (see report below). There also wasn't a report of the CTS Convention, which hadn't met yet. Received it later. (see report below). The report of the Youth Board was presented by the Director of Youth Camp Rev. Richard Adams, he encouraged all Pastors to get behind their Youth at their Churches and encourage them to attend Youth Camp. This report was received as information. The report of the Treasurer was presented by Rev. Millard Johnson and the report was adopted (see report below).

The Moderator declared a ten minute recess.

The Morning Worship Service opened with a Congregational Hymn "He set me Free" led by Sherrill Foran with Mrs. Edith Arnold, as pianist. An offering of \$40.38 was received for the Childrens Home and Rev. Lester MacKinnen prayed the Offertory Prayer.

Special music was presented by Louise Kell and Edith Arnold, and Rev. Houston Blevins also presented special music.

The Moderator presented Rev. Millard Johnson to bring the Message. His subject: "Alive through Separation," reading 1 John 3, 1-4 and Ephesians 2, 1-4, and II Corinthians 14. He pointed out how we need to come out from the world and be a separate people and that we need to practice spiritual separation. Also supporting one another in their endeavor to living a more dedicated life for God. This was a good challenging message, he closed with Prayer.

The morning Worship Service closed with Prayer by Rev. O.P. Stokes, and lunch was served by the ladies of the Church in the Fellowship Hall.

TUESDAY AFTERNOON SESSION, APRIL 2, 1985

The Tuesday Afternoon session opened with a Congregational Hymn, "Won't It be Wonderful There." Devotions were presented by Rev. Harry Mintz, Pastor of Union Hill Free Will Baptist Church, Elizabethton. Reading I Peter 3-15, and Romans 1, 14-16. He offered Prayer.

There was no report of the CTS Convention, since it hadn't met yet, but received a report later, (see report below). The report of the Retirement Board was presented by Harper Pittman and this report was adopted. (see report below). The report of the Placement Committee was presented by Rev. Roy Duckett and this was adopted (see report below). There was no report on the Necrology Committee but was received later. (see report below). It was moved and motion carried that since we the Association didn't know of the death of one of our Associational Ministers, Rev. W.M. Helton of Kingsport, till the Annual Meeting, that we send a

check in lieu of flowers to the family of Brother Helton, along with a letter of sympathy.

The report of the Resolution Committee was presented by Sherill Foran and was adopted. (see report below).

The report of the Nominating Committee was presented by Rev. Jack Lloyd and all was elected but a member of the Retirement Board, it was moved and motion carried that we receive a partial report and elect a Retirement board member at the Evening Service. (see report below). Along with the Nominating Committee, Miss Debra Broyles was elected Pianist, in place of Lila Tittle who resigned. Sherrill Foran is Music Director.

The report of the Finance Committee was presented by E.J. Johnson and this report was adopted. (see report below).

It was moved to adjourn for the Evening Service, Rev. W.L. Kell dismissed in Prayer.

TUESDAY EVENING SESSION, APRIL 2, 1985

The Tuesday Evening session opened with a Congregational Hymn "Standing on the Promises." A brief business session was conducted with another member elected on the Retirement Board. Rev. Sam Ferguson was elected. A motion was made to change the Annual Meeting to Friday and Saturday, but since this required a Constitutional Change, it was moved and motion carried that the By-Laws be placed on the Table till the next meeting in July.

Special music was presented by the Keenburb Choir under the direction of E.J. Johnson. Rev. Jonas Revis offered Prayer.

The Moderator presented the Chairman of the Ordaining Council, Rev. O.P. Stokes and after a greeting to the session, he presented the speaker for the Evening, Rev. Elmer Carter. He spoke from the subject: "Alive for Proclamation." He read II Timothy 4, 1-6-8 and Hebrews 9:27. He brought a good message. He closed with Prayer. The report of the Ordaining Council was presented by Rev. Guy Foster and the following recommendations were adopted. (see report below).

The Moderator called for a standing ovation in Appreciation for the lunch which was served in the fellowship hall by the ladies of the host church.

A Resolution from the Ministers Conference was presented, which is that all Ministers appearing for license to Preach the Gospel still be placed under the watch care of the Ordaining Council for 90 days, and that all Ordained Ministers seeking membership into the Appalachian Association from another Association will be received under the approval of the Ordaining Council. This was adopted.

The 17th Annual Session of the Appalachian Association adjourned with a right hand of fellowship. Rev. Jack Lloyd prayed the Benediction.

"UNITY" Psalms 133

Note four things of which Unity consists:

- I. It consists in the Acceptance of the same truth in the same mind.
 - (A) Essential oneness in aim and spirit, all being the animated by the same desire to promote the Glory of Christ.
 - (B) Readiness to concede and cooperate.

II. Its Attractiveness:

(A) As fragrant as the sacred oil used, in priestly Consecration is the odor of brotherly love.

(B) As an exquisite fragrance attracts, so the presence of unity in the Church is a constant invitation, voiceless but influential and effective. Many hearts will be won and many feet will make a path the circle where peace and concord dwell.

III. Its beauty:

(A) Its as beautiful in the moral realm as the dew on which the sun is shining in the material.

(B) We admire unity when we see it. It is the fair product of obedience to the word and the will of God.

IV. Its value as Vital to all true success:

(A) There may be an appearance of success without it, but not the reality. Other qualities may attract crowds and large contributions, but without unity, which the Lord requires in his people, there will be no divine blessing.
