PROCEEDINGS

FRIDAY EVENING, APRIL 4, 1986

The eighteenth Annual Session of the Appalachian Association of Free Will Baptist met at the Watauga Valley Free Will Baptist Church, Rt. 5, Elizabethton, Tennessee on Friday Evening at 7:00 pm. The session opened with special singing by Daniel and Tom Foster. The session was called to order by Rev. Eddie Maupin, prayer by W.L. Kell. The associational ministers, deacons and delegates were recognized and seated as voting power of the session. The visiting ministers were recognized and seated as advisory council. Rev. Jerry Stout extended a warm welcome and Rev. Kenneth Grindstaff responded.
