PROCEEDINGS

FRIDAY EVENING, APRIL 10, 1987

The nineteenth session of the Appalachian Association of Free Will Baptist met at the Calvary Free Will Baptist Church, Kingsport, Tenn., on Friday evening, April 10, 1987 at 7:00 p.m. The session opened with a congregational hymn "*Stand Up, Stand Up For Jesus*", led by Sherrill Foran with Debra Broyles as pianist. The meeting was called to order by Rev. Earl Austin. Prayer by Rev. O.P. Stokes.

The associational delegates, deacons and ministers were recognized and seated as voting power. The visiting ministers were recognized and seated as advisory council. Rev. C.B. Shoemaker extended a welcome to all. Moderator Maupin brought greetings and appointed the following to serve on Committee on Committees: Rev. O.P. Stokes, chairman, Rev. Sam Ferguson, Rev. D.C. Byrd.

Special music was presented by Carl Cox and daughter Donna Briggs. The Moderator presented Rev. An offering of \$43.36 was received for associational expenses and the offertory prayer was by Rev. Glen Hoilman.

The meeting adjourned until Saturday morning. Rev. Millard Johnson gave the benediction.

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SATURDAY MORNING, APRIL 11, 1987

The Saturday morning session opened with a congregational hymn, *Some Day*, led by Sherrill Foran with Debra Broyles as pianist. An altar of prayer was led by Rev. W.C. Amos. The meeting was called to order by moderator Maupin and Rev. Leon Gibson brought devotions, reading Titus 2, 11 and offered prayer.

Roy Duckett and approved (see report below). The reports of the Retirement and Sunday School Convention was presented by Rev. Kenneth Grindstaff and approved (see reports below). Motion was made and carried to send \$100.00 to Rev. Guy Foster and Rev. Winford Floyd. The report of the CTS Convention was presented by Rev. Dan Foster and again Dan urged all pastors to get their youths involved in CTS competition. Report approved (see report below). The report of the Youth Board was pre-

sented by Rev. Gene Deaton and he reported a balance of \$840.00 in the treasury. This was approved. The report of the children's home was presented by Rev. Jack Greene and he reported they now have 18 children and have a shelter for disturbed and abused children. Report was approved. The report of the Necrology Committee was presented by Rev. Mark Street and received as information (see report below). The report of the Placement Committee was presented by Rev. Jack Lloyd and approved (see report below). The report of the Resolution Committee was presented by Clyde Sawyer and approved (see report below). The report of the Finance Committee was presented by Rev. Millard Johnson and adopted (see report below). The report of the Nominating Committee was presented by Rev. Harry Richardson. A change in the nomination of clerk was approved and the elected clerk was also elected to serve as assistant treasurer. Report was adopted (see report below). Rev. Johnny Floyd declined his position on the youth board and Orlando Jones was elected (see report below).

The clerk, Ruby Carter was given a standing ovation and a motion was made and carried that a plaque be presented to her for her faithful and dedicated service to the association.

It was adopted that all boards should meet on the Thursday before the session of the association on Saturday.

Sherrill Foran was elected song director and Debra Broyles pianist. It was adopted that the treasurer send out self-addressed envelopes to all church clerks, reminding them to send in their associational dues.
