FRIDAY EVENING, APRIL 1, 1988

REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON REVISING THE FINANCIAL AND THE STRUCTURE OF THE ASSOCIATION

March 31, 1988

The committee on revising the financial report and structure of the Association met on January 7, 1988 and again on February 18, 1988 at the First Free Will Baptist Church in Johnson City. Members present were Gene Deaton, Dan Foster, Millard Johnson, Jack Lloyd, and Johnny Floyd. After much discussion the following recommendations were made:

1. We recommend that the 2% dues paid into the Association by the churches be designated as follows: Retirement 55%, General Fund 25%, Youth Board 10%, Tithe 10%.

2. We recommend that the churches send \$5.00 with the church Quarterly report and \$10.00 with the annual report.

3. We recommend that the \$1.00 fee paid by the ministers with their reports be deleted.

4. We recommend that designated amounts of \$40.00 for Quarterly meetings and \$60.00 for the Annual meeting be given to the host church of said meetings.

5. We recommend that the following items be taken off the Quarterly Report for churches: died, number in auxiliary, on building and repairs, running expense, benevolent, paid evangelist, special offering, paid minister, total expenditures for Quarter.

6. We recommend the following items be retained and or added to the ministers report: name of church one pastors or attends, sermons preached, professions of faith witnessed, number baptized, years in ministry. We recommend these items be placed with the minister's name and address in the minutes each year.

7. We recommend that the Minister's Examination for License and for Ordination be referred to the Ordination Council for revision at the April 1988 meeting.

8. We recommend that the term "general offering" be defined by Clerk and Moderator so as to give a better understanding of the 2% dues. (General offerings and all undesignated monies).

These recommendations were adopted by the Association.
