- 6. Ordained ministers coming from another denomination shall be eligible to belong to the order but must serve for one year under the watch care of this body before being granted ordination papers from this body.
- 7. Ministers coming from another association must bring letter from his association and must be in good standing.
- 8. Ministers or deacons making application for membership must be the husband of one living wife, or none.
