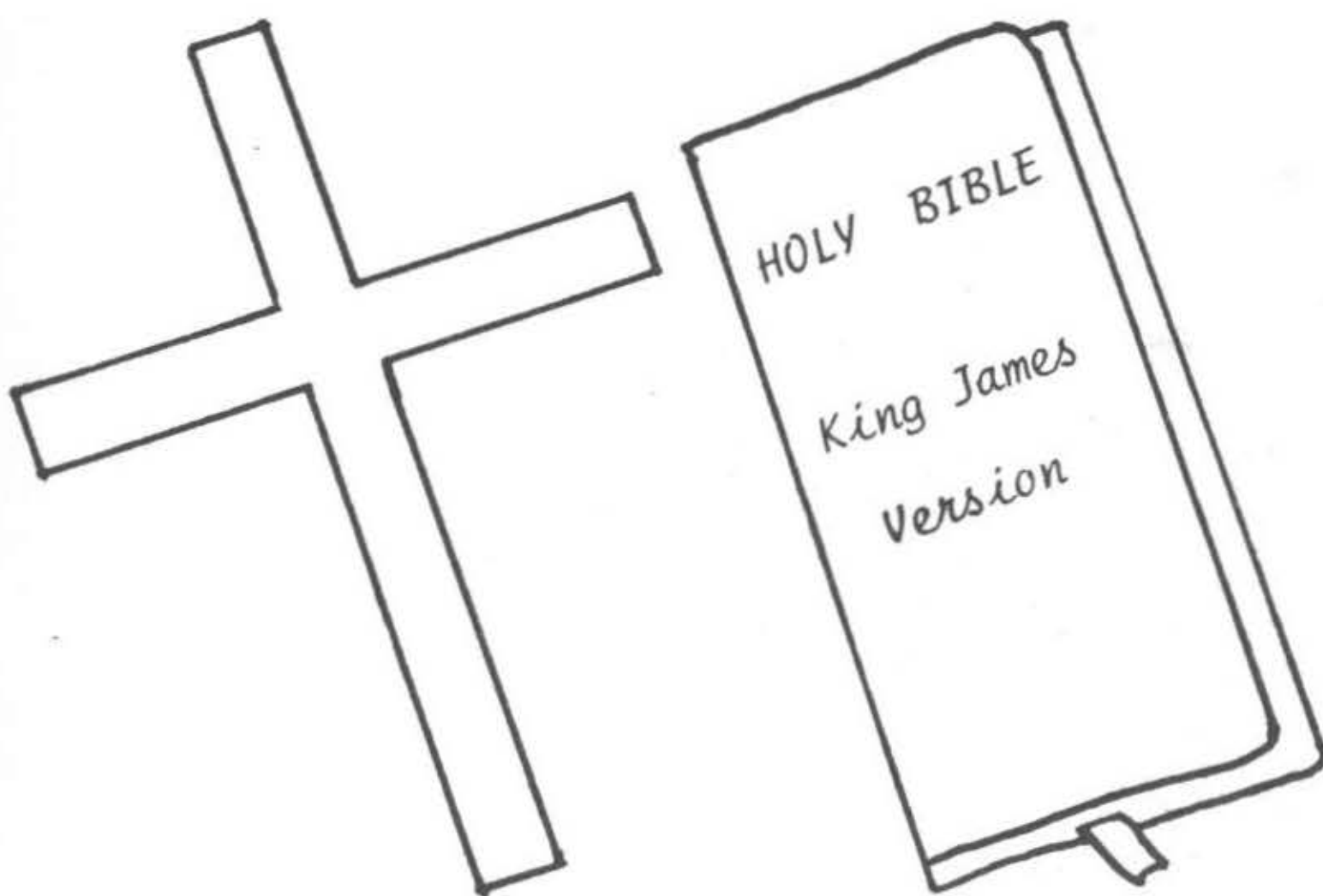

MINISTER'S AND DEACON'S CONFERENCE RULES

1. This conference shall be known as The Minister's and Deacon's Conference of The Birmingham District Association of Free Will Baptist, Incorporated.
2. It shall be composed of Ordained Ministers and Deacons.
3. When in session, it shall be composed of duly elected Moderator, Assistant Moderator and Clerk.
4. The Moderator shall be elected at each session and remain in office until the election and installation of his successor.
5. The Clerk shall be elected for one year and shall be elected by the majority present.
6. To be eligible to be a standing delegate to the Annual and Semi-Annual Conference, a minister or deacon should belong to the Minister's and Deacon's Conference.
7. Ordained Ministers coming from another denomination shall be eligible to belong to the order, but must serve for one year under the watch-care of this body before being granted ordination papers from this body.
8. Ministers coming from another Association must bring a letter from his association and must be in good standing.
9. Ministers or Deacons making application for membership must be the husband of one living wife, or none.

The Ordaining Council laid hands on Bro. Eugene Taylor and Ordained him to Preach the Gospel.

The Ordaining Council laid hands on Bro. Kenneth Dan Martin and Ordained his as a Deacon. Both of these men from Pleasant Hill Church.

Bro. Claudie Lee Deavers Jr, from Liberty Church, was given a License to Preach the Gospel by this body.

CHURCH COVENANT

Having given ourselves to God, by faith in Christ, and adopted the Word of God as our rule of faith and practice, we now give ourselves to one another by the will of God in this solemn Covenant.

We promise, by his grace, to love and obey him in all things, to avoid all appearances of evil, to abstain from all sinful amusements and unholy conformity to the world, from all sanction of the use and sale of intoxicating beverages, and to provide things honest in the sight of all men.

We agree faithfully to discharge our obligation in reference to the study of the Scriptures, secret prayer, family devotions and social worship; and by self-denial, faith and good works endeavor to "grow in grace and the knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ".

We will not forsake the assembling of ourselves together for Church conferences, public worship, and the observance of the ordinances of the Gospel: nor fail to pay according to our ability for the support of the Church, of its poor and all its benevolent work.

We agree to accept Christian admonition and reproof with meekness, and to watch over one another in Love, endeavoring to "Keep the unity of the Spirit", in the bonds of peace. To be careful of one another's happiness and reputation, and seek to strengthen the weak, encourage the afflicted, admonish the erring, and as far as we are able, promote the success of the Church and of the Gospel.

We will everywhere hold Christian principle sacred and Christian obligations and enterprises Supreme; counting it our chief business in life to extend the influence of Christ in society, constantly praying and toiling that the Kingdom of God may come, and His will be done on Earth as it is in Heaven.

To this end we agree to labor for the promotion of educational and denominational enterprises, the support

of missions, the success of Sunday Schools, and evangelistic efforts for the salvation of the World. And may the God of Peace sanctify us wholly, and persevere us blameless unto the coming of our LORD JESUS CHRIST.

RULES OF THE DECORUM

- #1 After an introductory sermon is preached, the Association shall be called to order by the Moderator who presided over the last session. In case of his absence, the Assistant Moderator shall call the body to order. Also, the former clerk will officiate until organized.
- #2 This body shall be composed of Ministers, Deacons, Church Clerks, and Delegates present from each Church.
- #3 The Officers of the Association shall consist of a Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Clerk and Assistant Clerk, to be chosen from the members present.
- #4 It shall be the duty of the Moderator to preside over the body during the session at which he is elected, to call the next session to order and to preside until reorganized and election and installation of his successor. It shall be his duty to keep order, enforce the rules of the Decorum, and decide all questions, discipline, and in case of a tie vote, to cast the deciding ballot. He may speak on any subject, but must call on the Assistant Moderator to preside while he is speaking.
- #5 It shall be the duty of the Clerk to keep the minutes of the proceedings and to read them when called upon by the body. The Clerk shall prepare the minutes for publication.
- #6 Each Church is entitled to three Delegates.
- #7 A majority of the members shall rule in all cases.
- #8 No member shall absent himself from the house without the consent of the Moderator.
- #9 All business shall be brought before the body by the business committee and shall be disposed of by the body.
- #10 No person shall be allowed to speak more than twice on the same subject, nor more than ten minutes each time, without permission of the Moderator.

#11 No Brother shall be interrupted while speaking, unless he departs from the subject under discussion, or uses words of personal reflection.

#12 Only one person shall be allowed to speak at a time and he must arise and address the Moderator.

#13 No business shall be voted on without the whole delegation is present.

#14 This decorum may be altered, amended or abridged at any session of the Association by a majority vote of the members present.

#15 The Minister who receives the most votes shall be Moderator and the next highest, Assistant Moderator.

#16 We recommend that we correspond and ask correspondence with other Associations.

#17 We recommend that all preachers and churches coming from other Associations or Denominations, be examined by a committee before being received into this body.

#18 We recommend that all Ministers and Deacons attend or represent by letter before receiving a certificate of standing, and that this be strictly enforced.

#19 We recommend that all Ministers who reach the age of Sixty be given a lifetime certificate of standing.

AMMENDMENTS

- #1 We recommend that this body, henceforth, refuse a request from any Church in this organization to ordain or license any Minister or Deacon who has two living wives.
- #2 Any Minister not having been licensed by the Birmingham Association or quarterly meeting must carry a license from this Association for one year.
- #3 We recommend that if any Ordained member of this body is absent for four successive meetings without provential reasons, or refuses to support this body, it be a violation of the Covenant and is sufficient reason for dismissal from this body.
