## MINISTER'S AND DEACON'S CONFERENCE RULES

#1 This Conference shall be known as the Minister's and Deacon's Conference of the B'ham District Association of Free Will Baptist Inc.

#2 It shall be composed of Ordained Ministers and Deacons.

#3 When in session, it shall be composed of duly elected Moderator, Assistant Moderator and Clerk.

#4 Moderator to be elected at end of each session for the next session.

#5 Clerk to be elected every five(5) years, and shall be elected by the majority present.

#6 To be eligible to be a standing delegate to the Annual and Semi-Annual Conference, a Minister and Deacon should belong to the Minister's and Deacon's Conference.

#7 Ordained Ministers coming from another Denomination shall be eligible to belong to the Conference, but must serve for one year under the watch care of this body before being granted Ordination Papers from this body.

#8 Ministers or Deacons coming from another Association must bring a letter from his Association and must be in good standing.

#9 Ministers or Deacons making application for membership must be the husband of one living wife, or none.

## RULES OF THE DECORUM

- #1 After an introductory sermon is preached, the Association shall be called to order by Moderator that presided over the last session. In case of his absence, the Assistant Moderator shall call the body to order. Also the former Clerk will officiate until organized.
- #2 This body shall be composed of Ministers, Deacons, Church Clerks, and Delegates present from each Church.
- #3 The Officers of the Association shall consist of a Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Clerk, and Assistant Clerk, to be chosen from the members present.
- #4 It shall be the duty of the Moderator to preside over the body during the session at which he is elected, to call the next session to order and to preside until reorganized and election and installation of his successor. It shall be his duty to keep order, enforce the rules of the Decorum, and decide all questions, discipline, and in case of a tie vote, cast the deciding ballot. He may speak on any subject, but must call on the Assistant Moderator to preside while he is speaking.
- #5 It shall be the duty of the Clerk to keep the minutes of the proceedings and read them when called upon by the body. The Clerk shall prepare the minutes for publication.
- #6 Each Church is entitled to three Delegates.
- #7 A majority of the members shall rule in all cases.
- #8 No member shall absent himself from the house without the consent of the Moderator.
- #9 All business shall be brought before the body by the Business Committee and shall be disposed of by the body.
- #10 No brother shall be interrupted while speaking, unless he departs from the subject under discussion, or uses words of personal reflection.
- #11 No person shall be allowed to speak more than twice on the same subject, nor more than ten minutes each time, without permission of Moderator.
- #12 Only one person shall be allowed to speak at a time and he must arise and address the Moderator.
