RULES OF THE DECORUM

1--The Clerk shall call Association to order. In his absence, the oldest Minister will call Meeting to order.

2--Association shall be open by Reading of Scripture, and Prayer by the MODERATOR.

3--This Body shall be composed of Ministers, Deacons, and Delegates present from each Church.

4--By two(2/3)votes, any Decision of the Moderator may be Amended.

5--The Officers of the Association shall consist of a Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Clerk, Assistant Clerk: to be chosen from the members present.

6--It shall be the duty of the Moderator to Preside over the Body during the Session, to Keep Order and Enforce the RULES OF THE DECORUM and Deside all Questons, Discipline, and in a Tie Vote, Cast the Deciding Ballot. He may speak on any subject, but must call on the Assistant Moderator to Preside while he is Speaking.

RULES OF DECORUM CONT.

7--It shall be the Duty of the Clerk: to keep all the Minutes of the Proceeding and Read them when called upon by the Body. The Clerk shall Prerare the Minutes for Publication. The Clerk and Assistant Clerk to serve five(5) year Terms.

8--Each Church is Entitle to Three(3)Delegates.

9--A Majority of the Members Present in each Session shall Rule in all cases.

10-Delegates SHALL NOT absent himself from the House without the Consent of the MODERATOR.

11--ALL Business shall come before the Business committee and shall be disposed of by the Body.

12--NO person shall be interrupted while Speaking, UNLESS he departs from the Suject, UNLESS discussion or uses words of Personal reflection.

13--No Person shall be allowed to speak more than Twice(2)on the same Subject, nor more than Five(5)Minutes each time without the Permission of the MODERATOR.

14--Only one Person shall be allowed to speak at a Time.HE must Stand and Address the MODERATOR.

15--The Terms of office for MODERATOR and Assistant MODERATOR shall be for ONE(1) year.

16--The Clerk and Assistant Clerk elected to serve for FIVE(5)years, both Semi-Annual and Annual Conference meetings.
