RULES OF THE DECORUM

1--The Clerk shall call the Association to Order.
In, (his) or (her) absence, the Oldest Minister
will call the Meeting to Order.

2--Association shall be opened with reading
of Scripture and Prayer by the Moderator.

3--This Body Shall be composed of Ministers,
Deacons and Delegates present from each Church
4--By two-thirds (2/3) votes, any Decision of
the Moderator may be Amended.

5--The Officers of the Association, **Shall** con-
sist of a Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Clerk,
Assistant Clerk, to be chosen from the Members
present.

6--It Shall be the Duty of the Clerk to keep
all the minutes of the Proceedings and read
them when called upon by the Body The Clerk
shall Prepare the Minutes for Publication.
The Clerk to serve **TWO** (2) years.

7--It shall be the Duty of the Moderator to
Preside over the Body during the session, to
keep ORDER and Enforce the Rules of the
Decorum, and Decide ALL Questions, Discipline,
and in a tie vote cast the Deciding Ballot.
He may speak on any Subject, but must call on
the Assistant Moderator to Preside before he
may Speak.

8--Each Church is Entitled to **THREE** (3)
Delegates.

9--A Majority of the Members Present in Each
SHALL RULE IN ALL CASES.

10--No Delegate SHALL ABSENT HIMSELF OR HER-
SELF from the meeting WITHOUT the CONSENT of
Moderator.

11--All the Business Shall come before the
Business Committee and shall be Disposed of
by the Body.

12--No person shall be interrupted while,
Speaking, Unless, he departs from the Subject
of Discussion, or uses words of Personal
reflection.

13--No Person shall be allowed to speak more
than Twice (2) on the same Subject, NOR more
than five (5) minutes each time, without the
Permission of the Moderator.

14--Only one Person shall be allowed to
Speak at a time. He must stand and Address the
Moderator

15--The Terms of Office of

15--The Terms of OFFICE for moderator and Assistant Moderator shall be for one(1) Year only.

16--The Clerk and Assistant Clerk elected to serve TWO(2)years.(2 Semi-Annual and 2 Annual) Conference Meetings.

We will not forsake the ASSEMBLING of OURSELVES for CHURCH CONFERENCES, PUBLIC WORSHIP, and the OBSERVANCE of the ORDINANCES of the GOSPEL: nor fail to pay according to our ability, for the SUPPORT of the CHURCH, of its POOR, and all of its BENEVOLENT WORK.

We agree to accept CHRISTIAN ADMONITION and REPROOF, with MEEKNESS and to WATCH over one another in LOVE, ENDEAVORING to "KEEP the UNITY of the SPIRIT" in the bonds of PEACE, to be careful of one another's HAPPINESS and REPUTATION, and SEEK to STRENGTHEN THE WEEK, ENCOURAGE the AFFLICTED, ADMONISH the ERRING, and as far as we are able, Promote the Success of the CHURCH and of the GOSPEL.

We will everywhere hold CHRISTIAN principle SACRED, and CHRISTIAN obligations and enterprises SUPREME, counting it our chief business in life

to, extend the Influence of CHRIST in SOCIETY, CONSTANTLY PRAYING and TOILING that the KINGDOM of GOD may come, and HIS WILL be done on EARTH as it is in "HEAVEN".

To this end, WE agree to LABOR for the PROMOTION of EDUCATIONAL and DENOMINATIONAL ENTERPRISES, the SUPPORT of Missions, the SUCCESS of SUNDAY SCHOOLS and EVANGELISTIC EFFORTS for the SALVATION of the WORLD.

And may the GOD of PEACE SANTIFY us WHOLLY and PRESERVE us BLAMELESS, unto the coming of our "LORD JESUS CHRIST.
