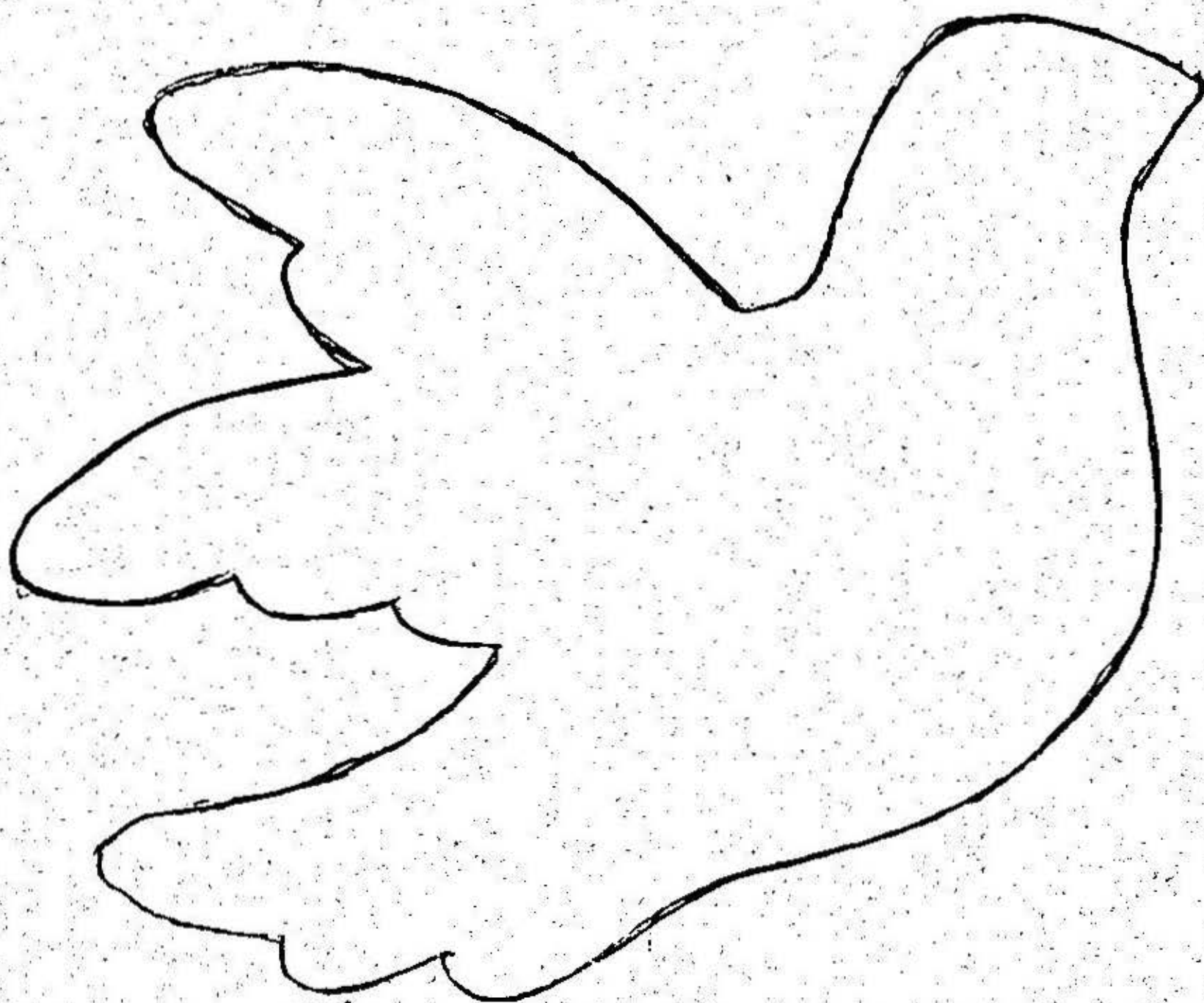

CHURCH COVENANT

Having given OURSELVES to GOD,by Faith in Christ,and Adopted the WORD of GOD as our rule of Faith and Practice, We now give OURSELVES to one another by the Will of God in this Solemn Covenant.

WE promise,by HIS GRACE,to LOVE and Obey Him in all things,to Avoid all Appearances of

Evil, to Abstain from all Sinful Amusements and Unholy Confomity to the WORLD,from all Sanction of the Use and sale of IntoxicatingBeverages, and to Provide things Honest in Sight of all men.

We,agree Faithfully to Discharge our Obligation in Reference to the Study of the Scripture, Secret Prayer, Family Devotion and Social Worship, and by Self-Denial, Faith,and Good Works, Endeavor to"Grow in Grace and the Knowleage of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ".

We will not foresake the Assembling of Ourselves for Church Conferences, Public Worship and the Observance of the Ordinance of the Gospel: nor fail to Pay according to our ability, for Support of the Church, its Poor and all of its Benevolent Work.

We, agree to accept Christian Admonition and Re-Proof,with Meekness and to Watch over one another in Love, endeavoring to "Keep the Unity of the Spirit" in the bonds of Peace, to be

careful of one another's Happiness and Reputation and Seek to Strengthen the Weak, Encourage the Afflicted, Admonish the Erring, and as far as We are able, Promote the Success of the Church and of the Gospel.

We, will everywhere hold Christian Principle Sacred, and Christian Obligations and Enterprises Supreme, counting it our Chief Business in Life, to extend the Influence of Christ in Society, Constantly Praying and Toiling that the Kingdom of God may come.

To this end, We agree to Labor for the Promotion of Education and Denominational Enterprises, the Support of Missions, the Success of Sunday Schools, and Evangelistic Efforts for the Salvation of the World.

And may God of Peace Sanctify us Holy and Preserve us Blameless, unto the coming of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

RULES OF THE DECORUM

1--The Clerk Shall call the Association to ORDER. In (his) or (her) absence, the OLDEST Minister will call Meeting to ORDER.

2--Association shall be opened with reading of Scripture and Prayer by the Moderator.

3--This Body Shall be composed of: Ministers, Deacons and Delegates present from each CHURCH.

4--By two-thirds (2/3) votes, any Decision of the Moderator may be Amended.

5--The Officers of the Association Shall consist of a Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Clerk, Assistant Clerk, to be chosen from the Members present.

6--It Shall be the Duty of the Clerk to Keep All the Minutes of the Proceedings and Read them when Called upon by the Body. The Clerk Shall Prepare the Minutes for Publication. The Clerk to Serve two (2) years at a time.

7--It Shall be the Duty of the Moderator to Preside over the Body during each Session, to Keep Order, and Enforce the Rules of the Decorum, and Decide All Questions, Discipline and in a tie vote cast the Deciding Ballot. He may speak on any Subject, But must call on the Assistant Moderator to Preside over meeting, before he may Speak.

8--Each Church is Entitled to Three (3) Delegates.

9--A Majority of the Members Present in Each Conference SHALL RULE IN ALL CASES.

10--No Delegate SHALL ABSENT HIMSELF OR HERSELF the Meeting, without the Consent of the Moderator.

11--All BUSINESS SHALL come before the Business Committee, and Shall be Disposed of by the Body.

12--No person Shall be interrupted while Speaking, Unless, He departs from the Subject of Discussion, or uses words of Personal Reflection.

13--No Person Shall be allowed to speak more than Twice (2) on the Same Subject, Nor more than Five (5) minutes each time, without the Permission of the Moderator.

14--Only one Person Shall be allowed to Speak at a time, He must STAND and ADDRESS the Moderator.

15--The Terms of Office for Moderator and Assistant Moderator for ONE YEAR ONLY.

16--The Terms of Office for the Clerk and Assistant Clerk for Two (2) years. Two (2) years. Two (2) Semi-Annual and Two (2) Annual Conference Meetings.

GUIDE LINE FOR ORDINATION

1--This Association Ordaines no one that has more than ONE (1) living Wife, Nor a man whose Wife has more than ONE (1) living Husband.

2--Every Licensed Minister carry a License until he is either called to a Church or enters Full Time Evangelistic Work. The Licenses of Ministers, Licensed by this Association, are to be Re-ISSUED each year, IF AND ONLY IF the Church of which They are a Member, makes this REQUEST. Amendment--Licensed Misters will Conduct the ORDANIES of Baptism, Foot Washing, Communion Service, or Perform Marriage Ceremonies.

3--This Association Ordains NO ONE that DO NOT Believe and Practice Tithing.

4--This Association ORDAINS NO ONE that DO NOT Believe Fully, the FAITH and PRACTICE of the Free Will Baptist Treaty.
