

RULES OF THE DECORUM

1--The Clerk Shall call the Association to ODER. In (his) or (her) absence, the OLDEST Minister will call Meeting to ODER.

2--Association shall be opened with reading of Scripture and Prayer by the Moderator.

3--This Body Shall be composed of: Ministers, Deacons and Delegates present from each CHURCH.

4--By two-thirds (2/3) votes, any Decision of the Moderator may be Amended.

5--The Officers of the Association Shall consist of a Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Clerk, Assistant Clerk, to be chosen from the Members present.

6--It Shall be the Duty of the Clerk to Keep All the Minutes of the Proceedings and Read them when Called upon by the Body. The Clerk Shall Prepare the Minutes for Publication. The Clerk to Serve two (2) years at a time. 7--It Shall be the Duty of the Moderator to Preside over the Body during each Session, to Keep Order, and Enforce the Rules of the Decorum, and Decide All Questions, Discipline and in a tie vote cast the Deciding Ballot. He may speak on any Subject, But must call on the Assistant Moderator to Preside over meeting before he may Speak.

8--Each Church is Entitled to Three (3) Delegates.

9--A Majority of the Members Present in Each Conference SHALL RULE IN ALL CASES.

10--No Delegate SHALL ABSENT HIMSELF OR HER-SELF the Meeting, without the Concent of the Moderator.

11--All BUSINESS SHALL come before the Business Committee, and Shall be Disposed of by the Body.

12--No person Shall be interupted while Speaking, Unless, He departs from the Subject of Discussion, or uses words of Personal Reflection.

13--No Person Shall be allowed to speak more than Twice (2) on the Same Subject, Nor more than Five (5) minutes each time, without the Permission of the Moderator.

14--Only one Person Shall be allowed to Speak at a time, He must STAND and ADDRESS the Moderator.

15--The Terms of Office for Moderator and Assistant Moderator for ONE YEAR ONLY.
16--The Terms of Office for the Clerk and Assistant Clerk for Two (2) years. Two (2) years. Two (2) years. Two (2) Semi-Annual and Two (2) Annual Conference Meetings.

GUIDE LINE FOR ORDINATION

1--This Association Ordaines no one that has more than ONE (1) living Wife, Nor a man whose Wife has more than ONE (1) living Husband.
2--Every Licensed Minister carry a License until he is either called to a Church or enters Full Time Evangelistic Work. The Licenses of Ministers, Licensed by this Association, are to be Re-ISSUIED each year, IF AND ONLY IF the Church of which They are a Member, makes this REQUEST. Amendment--Licensed Misters will Conduct the ORDANIES of Baptism, Foot Washing, Communion Service, or Perform Marriage Ceremonies.

3--This Association Ordains NO ONE that DO NOT Believe and Practice Tithing.

4--This Association ORDAINS NO ONE that DO NOT Believe Fully, the FAITH and PRACTICE of the Free Will Baptist Treaty.

5--This Association WILL NOT ORDAIN WOMEN TO PREACH.

6--This Association Wil Not ORDAIN No One That DO NOT Believe in the VERBAL INSPIRATION of the WORD of GOD.

7--This Association WILL NOT ORDAIN ANYONE that is AFFILIATED with the WORLD COUNCIL OF CHURCHES.

8--Thi Association WILL NOT ORDAIN ANYONE with BAD CHARACTER with them that are with out.

CONTETENCE SHALL RULE, IN ALL CASES.

9--This Association will not <u>Ordain Anyone</u> that <u>Does Not Believe and Practice the Ordinances of</u> the Free Will Baptist.

10--This Association wil not <u>Ordain Anyone</u> that <u>Do Not Believe a Person</u> can <u>Apostatize</u> and be <u>Lost</u>.
