

THE OFFICERS OF THE ASSOCIATION 5. SHALL CONSIST OF A MODERATOR, ASSISTANT MODERATOR, CLERK, ASSISTANT **CLERK, TO BE CHOSEN FROM THE MEMBERS PRESENT.**
