#### **RESOLUTION COMMITTEE REPORT**

No. 1 Be it resolved that Amendment No. 1<sup>of</sup> our By-laws be made Article 12 and Article 12 be made Article 13. That Article 12 be made to read as follows: That each subordinate association send a letter to this conference giving names of all ministers and deacons who are in good standing.

No. 2 Be it resolved that any business from subordinate conferences, pertinent to this body, be forwarded to this body for consideration of the resolution committee for presentation.

No. 3 Be it resolved that the State Ministers and Deacons Conference recommend that each subordinate or District Ministers and Deacons Conference examine each member for membership according to the standards of the State Conference.

No. 4 Be it resolved that we give a standing vote of thanks to the Turlock Church for their splendid care of this setting of the Ministers and Deacons Conference.

# By Laws

#### ARTICLE 1

The clerk or assistant clerk, or in their absence the senior minister in years, shall call the ministers present into conference. If a quorum is present the President or in his absence the Vice-President shall moderate the meeting. If neither of these are present, the senior minister in years shall be in charge.

#### ARTICLE 2

It shall be the duty of the clerk to enroll the ministers of the conference. Ministers and Deacons shall present themselves with proper evidence of their rights to seats therein, and those enrolled by the clerk shall compose the conference. In case of questionable representation the case under question shall be referred to the Credential Committee.

#### ARTICLE 3

Each minister and deacon belonging to this conference must be a member of some church in California and should report to each session in person or by letter and failing to do so for one year is subject to discipline.

#### ARTICLE 4

'Each conference shall be opened by reading a portion of God's word and prayer, and each session shall be closed with prayer.

# ARTICLE 5 By a two-thirds vote of the members present a ruling of the President may be overruled.

ARTICLE 6 This conference shall sit with open doors, except when it shall go into a committee as a whole.

## ARTICLE 7

No member shall absent himself from the conference during its meeting without permission from the President.

# **ARTICLE 8**

No person shall be allowed to nominate more than one member of a committee, unless person nominated is not elected.

## **ARTICLE 9**

The President shall not allow discussions when not carried on in a Christian spirit, or when he thinks it will cause discord.

#### ARTICLE 10

Anyone desiring to speak shall rise and address the President by the appellation, "Brother President," but shall not speak further until recognized.

#### ARTICLE 11

No member of this conference shall be allowed to speak more than five minutes, nor twice on the same subject without permission from the President.

## **ARTICLE 12**

Be it resolved that each subordinate association send a letter to this conference, giving names of all ministers and deacons who are in good standing.

# ARTICLE 13

These By-Laws may be altered or amended at any regular or adjourned session of this conference by a two-thirds vote of the members present.

# Constitution

#### ARTICLE 1

This ministers and deacons conference shall be called the California State Free Will Baptist Ministers and Deacons Conference and shall be composed of ordained Free Will Baptist Ministers and Deacons who are members of some orthodox Free Will Baptist Church in the state of California.

#### ARTICLE 2

The officers of this conference shall be President, Vice-President, Clerk, Asst. Clerk and Treasurer, who shall be elected annually.

#### ARTICLE 3

This conference shall have the power to discipline its members.

#### ARTICLE 4

Every ordained minister and deacon in the State of California should be a member of this conference and is required to report in each session in person or by letter. Every member shall be required to carry a card of identification and recommendation from this conference, and said card to be issued annually.

#### ARTICLE 5

# This conference shall meet annually.

## ARTICLE 6

This Constitution may be amended by a twothirds vote of the members present at any regular session.

### Amendment No. 1

Be it resolved that the Ministers and Deacons Conference of California will not recognize any minister advocating Premellinialism as Free Will Baptist doctrine.
