The Presbytery, Officers and Delegates composing the Second Biennial Conference of the Cape Fear Presbytery, BAPTIST CONNEXION, met with the Church, at Pleasant Grove, Harnett County, N. C., on Thursday, October 10th, 1872.

PROCEEDINGS.

Thursday, 11 O'Clock, A. M.

Devotional exercises were introduced by Elder Parrot Creech, who delivered an Introductory Sermon from 1 Tim. 3: 16, "And without controversy, great is the mystery of godliness."

After sermon, Eld. Jas. Turnage, the former Moderator, presided, until the name of Eld. Creech was proposed, and he elected Moderator for the next biennial term.

Conference was organized by appointing J. Wilson Lucas, Secretary; Erasmus Lee, Assistant Moderator, and W. A. Jackson, Asst. Secretary, and enrolling the names of those present who composed the Conference, which was as follows:

First district, Turnage, Parrot Creech, Allen Fowler and Isaac Wheeler; Licentiate, J. Wilson Lucas; Delegates, 1st district, J. C. Sorrell, W. H. Canaday, B. Tew, Erasmus Lee; 2nd district, A. W. Avera, A. G. Hill, Jas. Rayner, K. M. C. Brasley, Allen Gregory.

The Moderator being authorized by Conference made the following

Secretary receives and reads out the report of Committee on preaching, as follows: "Elders Fowler and Wheeler are requested to preach to attending congregation on to-morrow."

On motion, Conference adjourned until to-morrow, 10 o'clock, A. M. Devotional services conducted by Eld. A. Fowler.

Friday, October 11th.

10 1/2 A. M., Conference called to order by the Moderator. Devotional services conducted by Eld. R. A. Johnson. Roll

was called by the Secretary, and the following names enrolled: Eld. R. A. Johnson; 1st district, W. A. Jackson, W. E. Bass, Joseph Warren, Willie Fowler; 2nd district, W. A. Ford, W. H. Barber and G. A. Whittenton.

Proceedings of Thursday were read and approved.

On motion, Elders Creech, Turnage, and Fowler were again appointed Ordaining Council for Cape Fear Connexion.

On motion, the Secretary, having received returns from the Yearly Meetings, was requested to read the same. These were approved and recorded. (See Addenda.)

On motion, the Conference authorized the transcriber to receive and record in the returns the statistics of Long Branch Church as given at the sitting of this Conference.

On motion the delegates from 2nd district were allowed to retire ten minutes to consult relative to contribution from their district.

On motion the following resolution offered by J. Wilson Lucas was received for discussion.

Resolved, That this Conference discard the complaints of all aggrieved minorities of churches belonging to the Connexion, and advise such minorities to refer their grievances to the next higher tribunal of this Connexion.

On motion, the resolution was adopted.

On motion, the Conference authorized the Moderator to appoint "a committee who shall ascertain the character and usefulness of Elders and Licentiates belonging to the Connexion and report to General Conference."

Moderator appointed as said Committee, A. G. Hill, Alex. Gregory, Edwin Johnson, A. W. Avery, W. H. Ford, Jas. Rayner, S. B. Thane, W. H. Barber, J. C. Sorrell, Willie Fowler, E. Lee and W. A. Jackson.

On motion the preachers belonging to the Connexion were requested to report their labors only to the Conference.

On motion the reports of ministerial labor for 1871 and 1872 were received and read as follows:

On motion the following resolutions, offered by Elder Johnson, were received for discussion:

- Resolved 1st.* That we meet in Conference once every year.
 2nd. That said conference be composed of preachers, and officers of this Conference and lay delegates from the several churches belonging to Cape Fear Connexion.
 3d. That these resolutions be valid from the time that they pass, and all prior resolutions of the Conference conflicting herewith be repealed.

On motion, these resolutions were laid on the table, and the following offered by Elder Johnson, was received for discussion: *Resolved.* That Art. 1st, in our discipline, on "Constitution of Annual Conference" be so amended as to read Annual Conference, instead "Annual Meeting," and "Biennial Conference." On this resolution, the ayes and nays were taken and recorded: ayes, 19; nays, 2, and it was decided in the negative.

On motion, the former resolutions, which had been tabled, were taken up, and, motion to adopt was lost.

Secretary resolved and read out the reports of committee on preaching as follows: "Elders Turnage and Johnson are requested to preach to the attending congregation to-morrow."

On motion Conference adjourned until Saturday, 10 A. M. Devotional services conducted by J. W. Lucas.

Saturday, 10½ A. M.

Conference called to order by the Moderator; devotional exercises conducted by Elder Turnage. Roll was called.

By order of Moderator, proceedings of Friday were read. Motion to receive and approve was lost, in consequence of their inconsistencies.

On motion, the resolutions offered Friday and all the proceedings relative to said resolutions, were rejected, and the other proceedings of Friday approved.

On motion, the following resolution again offered by J. W. Lucas, was received for discussion:

Resolved. That this Conference discard all complaints of aggrieved minorities of churches belonging to the Connexion, and advise such minorities to refer their grievances to the next higher tribunal of this Connexion."

On motion the resolution was adopted.

On motion, the names of J. M. Byrd and D. W. Tew, (licentiates) were erased from the minutes.

By request, the Corresponding Committee report verbally. Their report was encouraging to the Conference, which received the same and continued the committee.

The Mission Committee from the Yearly Meetings recommended "That the General Conference form a Mission Board for the support of itinerant preachers who shall be sent to the destitute churches."

The advice of the M. Com. being received, Eld. Turnage offered the following resolutions, which were received for discussion:

Resolved 1st. That this Conference form within the limits of Cape Fear Connexion, a Mission Board for the support of itinerant preaching and missionary enterprise in said Connexion, which Board shall be amendable to the General Conference.

2nd. That five dollars paid at the time of entering shall entitle to membership in the Board.

The resolutions were adopted by a unanimous vote.

On motion, the following resolution, again offered by Eld. Johnson, was received for discussion:

Resolved, That Art. 1. in our Discipline on "Constitution of Annual Conferences," be so amended as to read *Annual Conference*, where it now reads, "General Conference once every two years."

Motion to adopt was superseded by motion to lay on the table.

Committee on Sabbath Schools reported:

Large Sabbath schools are in successful operation at several of the churches, and the interest in this glorious work daily increasing.

The report was accepted, and committee continued.

Committee of Finance reported: We find in hands of Treasurer \$31 75."

The report was received and committee discharged.

On motion, J. Wilson Lucas was appointed to transcribe the proceedings of the Conference, and have them printed; for which Conference pays him \$15.00.

On motion Treasurer was ordered to deliver to the transcriber all funds in hand.

Transcriber received from Treasurer \$31.75; from Elder Fowler's collections afterwards, 75c.; total \$32.50.

On motion transcriber was ordered to have printed 400 copies of the Proceedings of this Conference.

On motion Conference granted to J. Wilson Lucas a certificate of commendation, signed by the Moderator.

On motion, Conference will hold its next session at the usual time with the church at Johnston Union, Johnston County. Introductory by J. W. Lucas.

On motion, J. W. Lucas having been examined in Conference, was commended to Ordaining Council for ordination.

On motion, Secretary was authorized to enroll the name of J. W. Lucas as Elder in Freewill Baptist denomination.

On motion, Conference adjourned.
