## PROCEEDINGS

The one hundred thirty-fifth session of the Cape Fear Conference of Original Free Will Baptists of North Carolina convened at Smyrna Church, Route 6, Dunn, North Carolina, Thursday, November 2, 1989.

The meeting opened with the congregation singing "Praise Him! Praise Him!" Peyton Lee directed the music and Mrs. Christine Godwin served as pianist.

The morning Scripture and prayer were by the Rev. K. Alan Lamm, pastor of the First Free Will Baptist Church, Smithfield, North Carolina.

The Rev. T. C. Farmer, host pastor, extended a most gracious welcome to everyone present. Kenneth Jackson responded.

The moderator declared the meeting in session. The Rev. Calvin Heath, chairman of the Credentials Committee, explained the registration procedure of the Conference adopted at the one hundred fourteenth session which states: "In all future sessions of the Cape Fear Conference, the Credentials Committee shall be instructed to issue a badge of identification to all duly registered ministers, delegates and visitors, and that no person be allowed to vote who does not properly display said badge. It is understood that visitors shall be granted all rights and privileges except that of voting. It shall be the duty of the Credentials Committee to explain the registration at the opening of the Cape Fear Conference."

The roll was called of officers, ministers, standing boards and churches.

The moderator extended greetings to 10 visiting ministers and other visitors in attendance.

The moderator based his remarks on Scripture from John 15:12. He said we should express our love to God, our church and the Free Will Baptist denomination.

He suggested we follow four roads in our Christian life: The Damascus Road, which is conversion; The Jericho Road, which is service; The Golgotha Road, which is persecution; and The Emmaus Road, which is the road to fellowship.

### ORDAINING COUNCIL

The Council met four times during the year.

In regular session January 23, 1989, we informed Hickory Grove Church that the church was out of order in calling Brother David Locklear as their pastor since he is not an ordained Free Will Baptist minister. However, the Council passed a motion that Brother Locklear continue to pastor the church under the watchcare of Brother Al Markuson. Brother Locklear is to return to this Council after he has been a member of Hickory Grove Church for one year.

Since the Council has thoroughly investigated the charges against Brother Gideon S. Stevens regarding possession of alcoholic beverage and found it to be untrue, WE RECOMMEND: That no action be taken and that he be allowed to retain his credentials. All charges were dropped by the Department of Law Enforcement.

Motion was passed that we grant Brother Charles Norris permission to pastor Steven's Chapel Church under the watchcare of the Smyrna Church pastor, who is Brother T. C. Farmer at this time.

The Council met on October 23, 1989, and the following business was transacted:

1. WE RECOMMEND: That Brother Rudy Owens be received into the Cape Fear Conference from the Western Conference.
2. That the name of Kenneth Peele be removed from the roll of licensed ministers since he is no longer a minister in good standing.
3. That we excuse Brother Cecil Blackman from the 1988 session of the Cape Fear Conference.
4. That the name of Brother Larry Littleton be added to the roll of licensed ministers.
5. That we grant Brother Chris Markuson a letter of transfer to the Western Conference.
6. That we grant Brother Rod Jones a letter of transfer to the Eastern Conference.
7. That we accept the credentials of Alton C. Bennett since he voluntarily surrendered them and that his name be dropped from the roll of ordained ministers.
8. Since Brother Charles Barnard has been on probation for one year, WE RECOMMEND: That his name be added to the list of ordained ministers in good standing.

Motion passed that the clerk write a letter to Danny Braswell to remind him that he is not a Free Will Baptist minister and we request that he turn in his credentials

immediately. If he does not turn them in, a notice will be published in *The Free Will Baptist* paper.
