#### PROCEEDINGS

The one hundred thirty-sixth session of the Cape Fear Conference of Original Free Will Baptists of North Carolina convened at the First Free Will Baptist Church of Goldsboro, NC, Thursday, November 1, 1990.

The meeting was opened with Peyton Lee leading the congregation in singing "Marching to Zion."

The morning Scripture and prayer were offered by Brother Kenneth Jackson, pastor of Lanwood Chapel, Smithfield, NC.

The Rev. Norman Ard, host pastor, extended the welcome to everyone present. Brother J. N. Bryant responded.

The moderator declared the meeting in session. The Rev. Jeff Scarborough, chairman of the Credentials Committee, explained the registration procedure of the Conference adopted at the one hundred fourteenth session which states: "In all future sessions of the Cape Fear Conference, the Credentials Committee shall be instructed to issue a badge of identification to all duly registered ministers, delegates and visitors, and that no person be allowed to vote who does not properly display said badge. It is understood that visitors shall be granted all rights and privileges except that of voting. The moderator's remarks were taken from 2 Timothy 2:15. He said that we should keep our love aglow through fellowship and working together for greater spiritual oneness among us. We should be united in thoughts and prayers and expectations. This will help our Conference.

Motion was made and carried to have the Constitution and Bylaws in the *Yearbook* only every fourth year.

Motion was made and carried to allow for secretarial services in preparing for the Yearbook.

Motion to adjourn. Benediction by the Rev. Michael Ledbetter.

#### (June, 1990)

Motion was made and carried to recommend and approve the Rev. Frank Harrison to fill the unexpired term of the Rev. Foy Futrelle on the Ordaining Board.

Motion was made and carried for the Cape Fear Conference to purchase a chair to be placed in the Original Free Will Baptist Headquarters.

#### (July 7, 1990)

The Executive Committee met on July 7, 1990, and motion was made and carried for all materials of the Conference to be turned over to Mrs. Dola Dudley and the Rev. Michael Ledbetter be asked to assist her until the Conference. Further recommended to the Conference that the Rev. Michael Ledbetter fulfill the unexpired term of the Rev. Calvin Heath as clerk. These actions were brought about by the resignation of Calvin Heath who is moving to the Central Conference to pastor Black Jack Free Will Baptist Church.

The Committee planned the meeting to be held September 18, 1990.

### (September 18, 1990)

The Executive Committee of the Cape Fear Conference met on September 18, 1990, at the home of the Rev. C. Felton Godwin. All members were present and the moderator opened with prayer.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

The motion was made and carried to recommend the Rev. Don Venable to fill the unexpired term of the member-at-large of the Executive Committee of the Conference. The Rev. Michael Ledbetter is serving as the Conference secretary.

The committee discussed the 136th session of the Cape Fear Conference. The committees and speakers were discussed, nominated and approved.

Motion was made and carried that the Executive Committee meet with the Rev. Earl Johnson and a newly formed group called New Freedom Free Will Baptist Church. They are seeking church status with the Cape Fear Conference. We will meet with them on Wednesday, October 17, 1990. If we, the Cape Fear Executive Committee, agree and organize them into a church, we recommend that they be placed under the watchcare of the Conference for a period of one year.

Motion was made and carried that "any time the Executive Committee of the Conference meets to attend to Conference business that all members receive mileage in the amount of 25 cents per mile. Also, any time the Ordaining Board meets to attend to Cape Fear business other than the regular meetings that they receive the same amount."

Motion was made and carried that all Free Will Baptist ministers who are not attending regularly an Original Free Will Baptist Church report to the Ordaining Board. Motion was made to adjourn. Benediction was by the Rev. Michael Ledbetter.

#### (October 17, 1990)

The Executive Committee met on October 17, 1990, with all members present at the New Freedom Free Will Baptist Church at Clinton, NC.

The Rev. Dewey Boling conducted the service. We opened with singing "Tell Me the Story of Jesus." Prayer requests were taken and the Rev. Michael Ledbetter led in prayer.

An ordination service for deacons was held for W. B. Grady and Ray Fryer. Brother Dewey Boling read the Free Will Baptist Church Covenant.

Each new member of New Freedom Church came forward and signed a charter list for the church.

Each member was encouraged to be a missionary and see the results. The church is to win souls. They were encouraged to always say good things about the church and to lift up Jesus.

Motion was made and carried that the New Freedom Free Will Baptist Church of Clinton, NC, be recognized as a member of the Cape Fear Conference in good standing. They will be under the watchcare of the Conference for the period of one year.

The service was closed with singing "Amazing Grace" and a prayer circle.
