Proceedings

The One Hundred Forty-first Session of the Cape Fear Conference of the Original Free Will Baptists convened at Robert's Grove Free Will Baptist Church, Dunn, NC, November 2, 1995.

The session was called to order by the Moderator, the Reverend Dewey C. Boling. The congregation sang "I Am Thine, O Lord," led by Peyton Lee. Scripture and prayer were offered by the Reverend Wayne Hargrove, pastor of St. Mary's Grove Free Will Baptist Church. He encouraged us to "faint not," from Luke 18:1. When we faint, we: 1) lose control, 2) lose heart, and 3) lose our prayers. We were welcomed by the host pastor, the Reverend Fred Baker. The response was given by the Reverend Jeff Scarborough.

The rules of the Credentials Committee were explained by the Reverend Tony Parrish as were adopted by the One Hundred and Fourteenth Session, which state, "In all future sessions of the Cape Fear Conference, the Credentials Committee shall be instructed to issue a badge of identification to all duly registered ministers, delegates, and visitors, and that no person be allowed to vote who does not properly display said badge. It is understood that all visitors shall be granted all rights and privileges except that of voting. It shall be the duty of the Credentials Committee to explain the registration at the opening of the Cape Fear Conference."

The roll of the officers, ministers, standing boards, and churches was called. The Moderator recognized the visitors and welcomed them to the session.

The following temporary committees were appointed to serve during the session with the first person named to serve as chairman:

Credentials Committee: Chris Markuson, Ronnie Hayes, and Tony Parrish

Temperance/Resolutions Committee: Fred Baker, Frank Harrrison, and John Robert Harris

Nominating Committee: Al Markuson, Wayne Hargrove, and Ed Gonzalez Obituary Committee: Dean Kennedy, Henry Armstrong, and C. M. Coats

The Moderator, the Reverend Dewey Boling, gave his remarks. He said he has served the Cape Fear Conference for over 40 years. He has enjoyed serving many of our churches. He commented on the fact that Jesus spent all night in prayer and should we not do the same. He further stated that until our churches get right with God, our churches will not grow. He encouraged us to return to the ways that work in growing the church for the Lord. If we have fellowship with the Master, then we can have fellowship with one another. We were asked to stand for a moment of silent prayer and then we were led in prayer for our churches.

Executive Administrator--The Reverend Scott Sowers (The Reverend Sowers gave an overall look at the denominational ministries.) The Reverend Michael Ledbetter welcomed the Reverend Sowers to his new position on behalf of the Cape Fear Conference.

Before the break, and with the session ahead of schedule, the following reports were given: Woman's Auxiliary, Cape Fear Minister's Program, Ordaining Board, and the Board of Education (see Reports for all).

The Reverend Burkette Raper was recognized and he gave testimony that he was celebrating 49 years in the ministry. He started his ministry in the Cape Fear Conference before going to Mount Olive College for his ministry.

Morning worship began at 10:45 with singing praises to our Lord and Savior with "Victory in Jesus." Peyton Lee led in the chorus "Jesus Loves Me." The congregation continued in praise with "I Love to Tell the Story." After the offering, we were blessed with the special singing by Mrs. Trish Pope. She cang "Love Crucified a Rose."

Morning message was brought by the Reverend Phillip Boykin of Lee's Chapel Free Will Baptist Church. He read from the sacred Scriptures Luke 17:5-10. The Apostles asked the Lord to "Increase our faith." The title of the message was "DO IT!" The main points were: (1) They did not have lack of faith. They had faith! It only takes faith the size of a mustard seed to do great things. Are we really asking God to increase our faith or are we asking Him to make things easier? (2) Their actions showed their faith. It is our job to work out our faith. Some churches have "paralysis of analysis." They are frozen, immobile Christians waiting for God to push them to do something. We need to simply do our job--that is what is exepected! We are here to make a difference. The message is the same--the response makes the difference. The morning worship was closed with an altar prayer by all ministers.

The Reverend Fred Baker gave instructions for the noon meal and Gary Martin offered a prayer of thanks.

Afternoon Session

The afternoon session began with singing "Tis So Sweet to Trust in Jesus." The Reverend Charlie Carroll, pastor of Wooten's Chapel Free Will Baptist Church, brought the devotions and prayer.

The following reports were given: Cape Fear Sunday School--Al Markuson; Executive Committee--Michael Ledbetter (see Reports).

The reports of the temporary committees were as follows: Temperance/Resolutions, Obituary, Credentials, and Nominating (see Reports for all).

The Reverend Billy Nowell asked for the 142nd Session to be held at the Pleasant Grove Free Will Baptist Church in Dunn, NC. By motion, this met with the approval of the Conference.

Treasurer's Report (see Reports).

The floor was handed over to the newly elected moderator, the Reverend Billy Nowell. A motion was made and carried to give the outgoing officers a rising vote of thanks.

A motion was made and carried to leave all unfinished business to the newly elected Executive Committee. Motion was made to adjourn and we closed with prayer.

Executive Committee (November 3, 1994)

With the absence of Moderator Dewey Boling, Assistant Moderator Bolly Nowell called a meeting after the 140th Session of the Cape Fear Conference to approve the Minutes for printing in the *Yearbook*. A motion was made and carried to proceed in printing the Minutes of the 140th Session in the 1995 *Yearbook*.

(September 5, 1995)

The Executive Committee of the Cape Fear Conference met Tuesday, September 5, 1995, at the Lee's Chapel Free Will Baptist Church to plan the 141st Session of the Cape Fear Conference. Members present were: Phillip Boykin, Al Markuson, and Michael Ledbetter. In the absence of Dewey Boling and Billy Nowell, the committee proceeded to plan the 141st Session. Names for the committees were suggested and speakers were discussed. There was some discussion about the availability of funds to the Conference. It was suggested that in a future meeting finances could be discussed to suggest ways of increasing the funds available to the Conference. With no other business, we adjourned with prayer.
