#### BY - LAWS FOR QUARTERLY CONFERENCE

- ARTICLE 1 This conference shall be called to order by the standing clerk if present; or in his absence, by the person having seniority of membership.
- ARTICLE 2 This conference shall be opened and closed with prayer.
- ARTICLE 3 Ten standing members shall be required for, a quorum to transact any business for the body.
- ARTICLE 4 Any person wishing to speak shall first address the moderator; and then wait until recognized by the moderator.
- ARTICLE 5 No person may speak for longer than five minutes nor more than twice on any one subject without permission from the conference.
- ARTICLE 6 All business shall be done in the spirit of meekness. Otherwise it may be called to order by the moderator.
- ARTICLE 7 All business suggested by churches should be in writing.
- ARTICLE 8 This conference shall convene at nine o'clock a.m.
- ARTICLE 9 All committees doing business for this conference shall be appointed by this body.
- ARTICLE 10 This conference may sit with open doors except when otherwise provided by the body.
- ARTICLE 11 This conference may correspond with any other religious body as it deems advisable.
- ARTICLE 12 Any motion shall be properly seconded before being voted on; and carried by more than half the votes cast.
- ARTICLE 13 These By-Laws may be amended or changed at any regular conference, as the body see necessary.
- ARTICLE 14 This conference shall elect its officers annually, at the last quarterly meeting before the regular annual association.
