### BY - LAWS FOR QUARTERLY CONFERENCE

- ARTICLE 1: This conference shall be called to order by the standing clerk if present; or in his absence, by the person having seniority of membership.
- ARTICLE 2. This conference shall be opened and closed with prayer.
- ARTICLE 3. Ten standing members shall be required for a quorum to transact any business of the body.
- ARTICLE 4: Any person wishing to speak shall first address the moderator; and then wait until recognized by the moderator.
- ARTICLE 5: No person may speak for longer than five minutes nor more than twice on any one subject without permission from the conference.
- ARTICLE 6: All business shall be done in the spirit of meekness. Otherwise it may be called to order by the moderator.
- ARTICLE 7: All business suggested by churches should be in writing.
- ARTICLE 8: This conference shall convene at nine o'clock a.m.
- ARTICLE 9: All committees doing business for this conference shall be appointed by this body.
- ARTICLE 10: This conference may sit with open doors except when otherwise provided by the body.
- ARTICLE 11: This conference may correspond with and other religious body as it deems advisable.

- ARTICLE 12: Any motion shall be properly seconded before being voted on; and carried by more than half the votes being cast.
- ARTICLE 13: These By-Laws may be amended or changed at any regular conference, provided the proposed change be presented to the body three months prior to passage.
- ARRTICLE 14: This conference shall elect officers annually, at the last quarterly meeting before the regular annual association.

ARTICLE 15: Standing delegates shall be, licensed and/or ordained ministers, ordained deacons, and their respective companions, provided that the companions are members in good standing of the Freewill Baptist Church, church clerks, quarterly meeting clerks and their respective assistants; quarterly meeting treasure and registrar.
