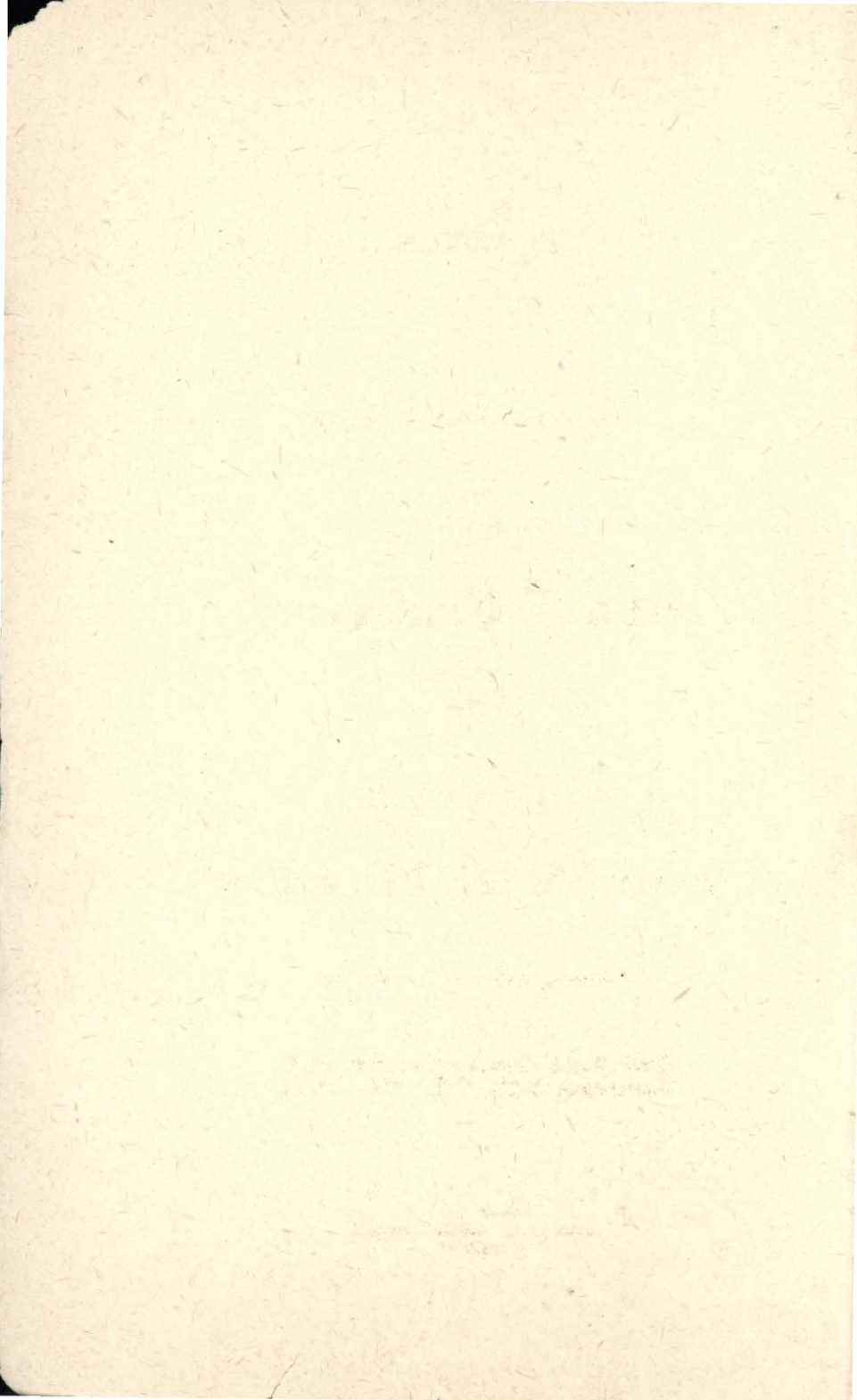

## PROCEEDINGS

Seventeenth Annual Session of the Central Conference of The Original Free Will Baptist of North Carolina convened with the church at Hull Road, Greene County, North Carolina, November 6th, 7th, 8th, 1912. Eld. J. T. Butler who was appointed to preach the introductory attended and preached. Text—Isa. 6:7; And he laid it upon my mouth, and said, Lo, this hath touched thy lips; and thine iniquity is taken away, and thy sin purged.

After one hour recess for dinner conference was organized by electing Eld. J. T. Butler Moderator, Eld. G. C. Vause Asst. Moderator, Eld. J. M. Barfield Recording Clerk and Eld. W. F. Walters Reading Clerk.

The Moderator appointed the following committees:

Temperance:—J. W. Webb, W. E. Clark and J. C. Griffin.

On motion the delegates from the other conferences be invited to a seat in this. Western Conference—E. T. Phillips, W. B. Everett, A. R. Flowers and J. C. Griffin. Eastern—H. Cunningham, M. C. Prescott, J. W. Webb and W. R. Sawyer. On motion the list of ministers be called.

On motion Eld. J. T. Butler write a sketch of the life of Eld. Mc N. Ange, deceased and that it appear in the minutes of this conference.

On motion the letter from Eld. Sowers be read to this body.

On motion the name of Eld. Sowers be dropped from our list of ministers and that his license and credentials be demanded.

On motion T. H. Barhill, J. T. Butler and W. J. Braxton be a committee to see Eld.....Boyd and ascertain if the charges against him are true and that the committee have the power to restore him if reports are found false.

On motion conference close until tomorrow (Thursday) at 9:30 a. m.

#### THURSDAY MORNING SESSION.

Conference met according to adjournment. A thirty minute prayer service was conducted by Bro. W. R. Sawyer.

The minutes of yesterday were read and accepted.

On motion the list of churches be called and statistics recorded. (See statistical table.)

On motion L. L. Smith, J. P. Woodward and A. T. Dawson be a committee to confer with the committees of the Western and Eastern Conferences in regards to a church hymnal.

On motion the report of the examining committee be received and that the name of J. C. Moyer be enrolled on the list of ministers.

On motion conference call off one hour for dinner.

#### AFTERNOON SESSION.

On motion the church at Piney Grove, Northampton County be dropped from the minutes;

On motion the letter from Bro. W. F. Hart, Treasurer of this conference, offering his resignation be read.

On motion we accept his resignation on account of his health failing and elect W. J. Braxton as his successor.

On motion conference adjourn untill tomorrow morning 9:30 o'clock.

FRIDAY MORNING SESSION.

Conference met at 9:30 a. m. Prayer by W. R. Sawyer.

The proceedings of yesterday were read and approved.

On motion the finance committee retire, settle with the treasurers and they make their reports.

On motion the denomination build a Free Will Baptist Orphanage and that a committee be appointed to confer with the Eastern and Western Conferences in regard to the same. Committee T. H. Barnhill, W. F. Walters, A. T. Dawson, W. L. Clark and J. T. Butler.

On motion we invite Prof. A. R. Flowers to deliver an address to this conference.

The following delegates were appointed to the other conferences: Western; J. T. Butler, Eastern; W. F. Walters, Cape Fear; T. H. Barnhill, South Carolina; G. C. Vause.

On motion we represent in the other conferences by letter.

The petitions for the next conference were taken up and resulted in a decision to convene with Maliehi's Chapel, Tyrrell County.

G. C. Vause was selected to preach the introductory and T. H. Barnhill his alternate.

On motion we have 1500 minutes printed and that the clerk prepare the manuscript for the press and distribute the minutes to the churches.

On motion we allow the clerk \$12 for his service and authorize him to draw on the treasurer to pay for printing and distributing the minutes.

On motion the list of churches be called to ascertain what the delegates will pledge for the Seminary at Ayden to be paid at the next conference.

**MISSION COMMITTEE REPORT.**

We your committee on missions recommend that the churches increase the amounts sent to the conference and especially for education as we think our school at Ayden, N. C. is accomplishing a greater mission work than we can hope for at any other point.

**EDUCATIONAL COMMITTEE REPORT.**

We your committee on education submit the following:

1st. We recommend that every man called to the ministry be required to take advantage of a literary education as far as opportunity permit.

2nd. We recommend that the pledge system for raising money for the Seminary be continued as we are in debt and the success of the denomination depends largely upon this institution.

3rd. We ask the Board of Directors together with all the ministers to keep the financial aid to the school continually before the people and churches of the denomination.

4th. We ask every pastor to take up a special collection once a month at each of his churches for the benefit of the school.

ON SABBATH SCHOOLS.—We respectfully recommend the following.

1st. That the churches in this conference organize

into districts and have mass meetings as often as once a year.

2nd We encourage the study of vocal music as a source of inspiration for Sabbath School work.

3rd. That we use our own literature published at Ayden, N. C.

4th. That we use special efforts to organize Sabbath Schools in every place possible.

Committee.

**ON TEMPERANCE.**—We, your committee on temperance beg leave to submit the following:

1st. We insist that total abstinence be required of all our members in the use of all alcoholic drinks as a beverage, that all who are known to tipple be under the censure of their church.

2. That we as a people forever stand by prohibition and that we help to enforce the law by aiding in the arrest and conviction of those guilty of violating prohibitory laws when milder measures cease to avail.

3. That we highly approve the measures being taken to stop the importation of liquors from wet into dry territory, and that we use all our influence upon the Congress of the United States in bringing about national prohibition, and in protecting sections already under prohibitory law.

4. That we look upon people who claim that prohibition is a failure as enemies to the righteous cause of temperance, either through ignorance or for an evil intent.

5 That we ask Christian people everywhere, both in town and in country sections to form law and order leagues for the suppression of vice in every form.
