Proceedings
Morning Session

The Central Conference of the Original Free Will Baptists, being the continuation of the General Conference, convened in its 246th Annual Session with the First Free Will Baptist Church of Tarboro, North Carolina, on Thursday, November 10, 1994, at 9:30 a.m.

The Conference opened with a hymn, *We're Marching to Zion*, led by the Reverend Harry A. Jones, Jr. Mr. Joey Williams read Scripture and led in the opening prayer.

The Reverend Philip Wood, clerk, called the Annual Session to order and presented the moderator, the Reverend Leon Grubbs, who presided over the session.

Mrs. Joyce Hathaway, from the host church, extended a cordial welcome to the Conference.

The moderator gave a brief address to the Conference.

The roll of churches was called, with 27 churches responding with delegates.

Twelve visiting ministers were recognized and welcomed by the moderator. The ministers were: Bruce Dudley, David C. Hansley, Harry Jones, Sr., Donald Fader, and Walter Sutton—from the Eastern Conference; Arnold Price, Joseph Ingram, Ray Wells, Aubrey Williamson, Harold Jones, and Chuck Owens—from the Western Conference. The interim pastor of Bethany Free Will Baptist Church, the Reverend Mark Hogan, was in attendance.

The moderator appointed temporary committees as follows:

Ushers-Supplied by the host church

The report of the Executive Committee was read by the clerk. By motion, it was adopted (see reports).

The report of the Board of Ordination was read by the Reverend Ronnie Hobgood. By motion, it was adopted (see reports).

The Reverend Leon Grubbs, moderator, presented certificates to the following ministers in recognition of their years of service as ordained clergy: Charles Branch for 25 years, Willis Wilson for 40 years, and Walter Reynolds for 45 years. Following the presentation, the moderator invited the Conference to come and congratulate these ministers.

The Conference extended the right hand of fellowship to the Reverend Jack Weathersby, ordained in February, and to the Reverend Archie Brock, transferring to the Central from the Western.

Conference business was set aside fo rthe Worship service. The service was opened in prayer by the Reverend Bruce Jones. The Reverend Harry A. Jones, Jr. led the congregation in the singing of *Holy, Holy, Holy*, followed by the offering for the conference and offeratory prayer by Mr. James Beach. Special music was presented by Mrs. Rhonda Wells and Mrs. Becky Pollard, both from the First Free Will Baptist Church of Tarboro. The Reverend Gary Bailey preached the Conference sermon. His text came from 1 Kings 17:1-16. The main emphasis of the message was a reminder to Free Will Baptists that we,

like Elijah, may take advantage of the unlimited resources that God provides for us, or we can choose to rely on our own, limited strength, and "use up our little bit and die." God was able to use Elijah to save a widow woman, her son, and bring revival to Israel. God can use Free Will Baptists to rescue souls and bring revival to the land, God will provide if we are committed to the task He has called us to. The challenge was given to the laity as well as the clergy. The worship service concluded with the singing of "Jesus Calls Us" and with prayer by the Reverend Stanley Buck.

Oral reports were given by representatives from the Convention and the following denominational ministries: the Reverend C. H. Overman, Executive Administrator of the Convention; the Reverend Ray Wells, President of the Convention; Mrs. Rebecca Davenport, Emeritus member of the Children's Home Board; the Reverend Walter Reynolds, Church Finance; the Reverend Harry Grubbs, Cragmont Assembly; the Reverend Harold Jones, Foreign Missions; Miss Tracy McCoy, Free Will Baptist Press; the Reverend David C. Hansley, Home Missions; the Reverend Donld Fader, Minister's Program; Mrs. Jean Ackiss, Mount Olive College; and the Reverend Walter Sutton, Retirement Homes.

The Conference recessed for the noon meal and was led in prayer by the Reverend Norwood Futrell.

Afternoon Session

The afternoon session was called to order with the singing of When We All Get To Heaven.

The Reverend Thomas Bowen gave the report of the Obituary Committee (see reports).

The roll of Ministers was called.

The Reverend Leon Harris gave the report of the Conference Board of Missions. By motion, the report was adopted (see reports).

The Reverend Walt Tyndall gave the report of the Credentials Committee. By motion, the report was adopted (see reports).

Miss Leah McGlohon, the Conference Historian, gave a report of the historical survey sent out to all the churches of the conference (see reports).

The Reverend Stanley Buck gave the treasurer's report. By motion, the report was adopted.

The moderator called for miscellaneous business. By motion, the Conference will give a thousand dollars towards the purchase of office equipment for the Convention Headquarters. By motion, the Reverend Gary Bailey will submit the Conference sermon to the *Free Will Baptist* for publication.

The Reverend Ronnie Hobgood gave the report of the Nominating Committee. By motion, the report was adopted (see reports).

The floor was opened for other nominations. There were no other nominations. By motion, the nominations ceased, and the nominees were elected by acclamation.

The Reverend Glenn Mills gave the report of the Resolutions and Temperance Committee. By motion, the report was adopted (see reports).

A rising vote of thanks was given to the host church, and to the Conference officers for their work over the past year.

By motion, the Conference adjourned.

The Conference was dismissed with prayer by the Reverend Leon Grubbs.
