# Proceedings Morning Session

The Central Conference of the Original Free Will Baptists, being the continuation of the General Conference, convened in its 247th Annual Session with the First Free Will Baptist Church of Rocky Mount, North Carolina, on Thursday, November 9, 1995, at 9:30 a.m.

The Reverend Joey Williams, clerk, called the annual session to order and presented the Reverend Ray Williams, host pastor, who opened the Conference with a hymn, "Praise to the Lord Almighty." Mr. Todd Sutton read Scripture and led in the opening prayer.

Mr. Donald Rogers, from the host church, extended a cordial welcome to the Conference.

The Reverend Gary Bailey, moderator, gave a brief address encouraging the Conference to "increase its vision."

The roll of churches was called with 23 churches responding with delegates.

Seven visiting ministers were recognized and welcomed by the Moderator. The minsters were: the Reverends Joe Ingram, Aubrey Williamson, Richard Holmes, Ray Wells (from the Western Conference), Rod Jones, Walter Sutton (from the Eastern Conference), and Stephen Prescott (a licensed minister from the Eastern Conference).

The Moderator appointed temporary committees as follows: Parliamentarian--Dr. Michael Pelt; Nominating--the Reverend Ronnie Hobgood (chairman), the Reverend Leon Grubbs, the Reverend J. B. Narron; Resolutions and Temperance--the Reverend Glenn Mills (chairman), the Reverend Leon Harris, the Reverend Philip Wood; Song Leader--the Reverend Ray Williamson; ushers were supplied by the host church.

At 10 a.m., Conference business was set aside for the worship service. The service was opened with Scripture from Psalm 100 and prayer. The Reverend Ray Williamson led the congregation in the singing of "To God Be the Glory," followed by the offering from the Conference and the offertory prayer. Special music was presented by a quartet from the host church. The Reverend Ray Wells, president of the Convention of Original Free Will Baptists, preached the Conference sermon. His text came from Exodus 14. The main emphasis of that message was, "Where do we go from here?" That was the question facing the Children of Israel as they faced the Red Sea with Pharaoh and his army behind them. The Reverend Wells stressed that as Free Will Bapists we must ask ourselves this same question that the Children of Israel asked and we must strive with God's help and guidance to move forward. The worship service concluded with the singing of "Have Thine Own Way, Lord" and prayer.

The report of the Executive Committee was read by the Clerk. By motion it was adopted (see Reports).

The report of the Board of Ordination was read by the Reverend Ronnie Hobgood. By motion it was adopted (see Reports).

The Reverend Gary Bailey, moderator, presented certificates to the following ministers in recognition for years of service: The Reverend N. B. Barrow--60 years, Dr. Michael Pelt--45 years, the Reverend J. B. Narron--45 years, and the Reverend Joseph Lehmann--30 years. The Reverend Gary Bailey, moderator, extended a welcome to membership in the Conference to the Reverend Joey Williams, newly ordained in January; the Reverend Mark Hogan, transferring to the Central Conference; and the Reverend Clifford Harwood, transferring to the Central Conference.

An oral report covering all of the denominational ministries, was given by the Reverend Scott Sowers, executive administrator of the Convention of Original Free Will

Baptists. Following the reports, comments were made by representatives of the denominational ministries as follows: the Reverend C. H. Overman, former Executive Administrator; Dr. Michael Pelt, Mount Olive College; the Reverend Walter Sutton, Retirement Homes; the Reverend Walter Reynolds, Church Finance; Dr. Bobby Taylor, Children's Home; the Reverend Gary Bailey, Cragmont Assembly.

The roll of ministers was called.

The Reverend Walt Tyndall gave the report of the Credentials Committee. By motion the report was adopted (see Reports).

Mrs. Kenya Williams, the Conference historian, gave a report on the historical survey sent out to the churches of the Conference and encouraged each church to update her record in the Historical Collection in the Moye Library at Mount Olive College (see Reports).

The Conference recessed for the noon meal with prayer.

#### Afternoon Session

The afternoon session was called to order with the singing of "Blessed Assurance." The afternoon session was moderated by the Assistant Moderator, the Reverend Stanley Buck.

The Reverend Thomas Bowen gave the report of the Obituary Committee (see Reports).

The Reverend Leon Harris gave the report of the Conference Board of Missions. By motion the report was adopted (see Reports).

The Reverend Ray Williamson gave the Treasurer's Report. By motion the report was adopted (see Reports).

The Moderator called for miscellaneous business. There was no miscellaneous business.

The Reverend Ronnie Hobgood gave the report of the Nominating Committee. By motion the report was adopted (see Reports).

The floor was opened for other nominations. There were no other nominations. By motion the nominations ceased and the nominees were elected by acclamation.

The Reverend Philip Wood gave the report of the Resolutions and Temperance Committee. By motion the report was adopted (see Reports).

A rising voting thanks was given to the host church and to the Conference officers for their work over the past year.

By motion the Conference adjourned.

The Conference was dismissed with prayer by the Reverend Michael Pelt.

#### (April 18, 1995)

The Executive Committee met at Bill's Barbecue in Wilson, NC, April 18, 1995. Present at the meeting were the Reverends Gary M. Bailey, Stanley Buck, Ray Williamson, and Joey Williams.

The meeting was called to order and opened with prayer.

The minutes from the November Executive Committee meeting were read, corrected, and approved.

#### **New Business**

There was a discussion concerning the 247th Session of the Central Conference of Original Free Will Baptists. An invitation to First Free Will Baptist Church of Rocky Mount was given. A motion to accept this invitation was made by the Reverend Stanley Buck, seconded by the Reverend Joey Williams. Thursday, November 9, 1995, was the date set for the Conference. The Executive Committee received the resignation of Chaplain Mark Hobbs as Assistant Clerk due to his transfer to Turkey.

There was a discussion on a replacement for Chaplain Mark Hobbs, assistant clerk. We decided to research the Constitution and Bylaws before a replacement was found.

A motion was made and seconded that we adjourn, and the meeting was closed in prayer.

#### (August 29, 1995)

The Executive Committee met at Bill's Barbecue in Wilson, NC, August 29, 1995. Present at the meeting were the Reverends Gary M. Bailey, Stanley Buck, Ray Williamson, and Joey Williams.

The meeting was called to order and opened with prayer.

The minutes of the April 18, 1995, meeting were read and approved.

There was a discussion concerning a ministers' meeting. A motion was made by the Reverend Jeoy Williams, seconded by the Reverend Stanley Buck, to have this meeting at Ryan's Steak House, on October 23, 1995, and that we ask Lydia van der Plas to come as our speaker.

#### Old Business

We discussed details concerning the 247th Session of the Central Conference of Original Free Will Baptists. A motion was made by the Reverend Ray Williamson, seconded by the Reverend Joey Williams, to invite the Reverend Ray Wells to preach the Conference message.

A motion was made by the Reverend Stanley Buck, seconded by the Reverend Ray Williamson, to appoint Dr. Michael Pelt as the Assistant Clerk to replace Chaplain Mark Hobbs.

#### **New Business**

The Reverend Gary M. Bailey, moderator, informed the Executive Committee of an investigation from two groups of Elm Grove Free Will Baptist Church, seeking help and direction for their church. As a committee, we agreed to meet with them at a date that

would be convenient for each member of the Executive Committee. We agreed that this meeting would allow us to hear the concerns of the members, but that we would send recommendations at a later time.

#### (September 27, 1995)

The Executive Committee met at Ryan's Steak House, in Greenville, NC, September 27, 1995. Present at the meeting were the Reverends Gary M. Bailey, Ray Williamson, and Joey Williams. The meeting was called to order and opened with prayer. We had a brief discussion concerning the path we, as the Executive Committee, would take during our meeting with Elm Grove Free Will Baptist Church. A motion was made by the Reverend Ray Williamson, seconded by the Reverend Joey Williams, to appoint the Reverend David Hines as acting moderator of the church, since at the present time he is serving in the role of interim pastor. We called a recess until we reconvened at Elm Grove Free Will Baptist Church. The meeting reconvened at Elm Grove Free Will Baptist Church, in Ayden, at 7:30 p.m.

The Reverend Gary M. Bailey began the meeting by reading selected sections from The Articles of Faith and Principles of Church Government for the the Original Free Will Baptists (of the English General Baptist Heritage).

The Executive Committee set down guidelines we would follow:

- 1) Limit remarks to 5 minutes.
- 2) Please try to avoid stating the same events numerous times;
- 3) That the Executive Committee was on a fact-finding mission;
- 4) That anyone desiring the floor must be first recognized by the Chair, then state his or her name for the record.

At this time the floor was opened to all those desiring to speak. Several members expressed their views.

The Moderator made a few closing comments. He stated that the Executive Committee would be meeting together to help find a solution and that it would be several weeks before the church would hear from the Executive Committee. He further stated that the Executive Committee would be in prayer for the church and the meeting was closed in prayer.

#### (October 5, 1995)

The Executive Committee met at the First Free Will Baptist Church in Greenville, October 5, 1995, in regards to the meeting the Committee had with Elm Grove Free Will Baptist Church. Present at the meeting were the Reverends Gary M. Bailey, Stanley Buck, Ray Williamson, and Joey Williams. The meeting was called to order and opened with prayer. The purpose of this meeting was to try to find some solutions to the problems facing Elm Grove Free Will Baptist Church. The Committee began by having an open discussion concerning the meeting we had with Elm Grove Free Will Baptist Church. The Committee compiled a list of recommendations. The meeting was closed with a word of prayer.

#### (October 18, 1995)

The Executive Committee met at Stoney Creek Free Will Baptist Church, Goldsboro, NC, October 18, 1995.

Present at the meeting was the Reverends Gary M. Bailey, Michael Pelt, David Hines, and Joey Williams.

The meeting was called to order and opened with prayer by the Reverend Gary M. Bailey.

The purpose of this meeting was to try to finalize the recommendations to be presented to Elm Grove Free Will Baptist Church.

After some discussion, the Committee agreed on four recommendations as follows:

- 1) We recommend that Gary Evans and Dick Evans not act as deacons until fully ordained.
- 2) We recommend that the current Board of Deacons be informed that they are not a board of directors but a recommending body to the congregation. Decisions of the Deacon Board are to be approved by the Church in conference before actions are taken.
- 3) We recommended a training course to be set up on "The Work of the Office of Deacon and Other Church Officers and Their Relationship to the Congregation." This training course will be offered to all members of Elm Grove Free Will Baptist Church and will be taught by Dr. David Hines.
- 4) We recommended that all the work of the Pulpit Committee cease until further recommendations from the Executive Committee of the Central Conference.

The meeting was closed with prayer.

#### (November 9, 1995)

The Executive Committee of the Central Conference met at the First Free Will Baptist Church, Rocky Mount, prior to the 247th Annual Session of the Conference. Present for the meeting were the Reverends Gary M. Bailey, Stanley Buck, Ray Williamson, Michael Pelt, and Joey Williams. The meeting was called to order and opened with prayer. By motion the program of the 247th Annual Session of the Central Conference was approved as printed.

The meeting was adjourned with prayer.

#### Central Conference Missions

The Central Conference Mission Board expresses thanks to all of you for your prayers and financial support this past year. A very special "thank you" is again extended to the ladies, who through the Auxiliary Convention, have continued a most generous support of Central Conference Missions. We also want to express our deep appreciation to the churches who sent gifts monthly.

The goals of the Central Conference Missions Board, as assigned by the Conference, are as follows:

- 1. "An Original Free Will Baptist Church in every town
- Stand ready to assist any church in our conference that might need our help; and
- 3. Be prepared to launch out in the establishment of another mission or supporting a prospective group which feels led to organize."

Our financial report reveals deposits in our checking account of \$848.94 and expenditures of \$1,986.22. All monies spent this year reflect our continued support of Hillside

Mission. We also have "The Central Conference Mission Board Endowment Fund" with Church Finance Association. The interest from these savings have enabled us over the past couple of years to purchase a central air conditioning unit for Hillside, to remodel inside, as well as, repair the roof, the large front window and paint the outside.

Your Mission Board has taken initial steps to locate a promising site for a new work, however, our primary emphasis continues to be helping Hillside Mission reach church status as soon as possible. 
