Proceedings

The Central Conference, being the continuation of the General Conference of Original Free Will Baptists of North Carolina, convened in its 249th annual session with the King's Cross Roads Free Will Baptist Church of Fountain, North Carolina, on Thursday, November 6, 1997, at 9:30 AM.

The Reverend Ray Williamson led the Conference with a hymn, "Glorify Thy Name." Opening Scripture and prayer was offered by Mr. Tony Glass.

The Reverend Joey Williams, clerk, called the annual session to order.

The Reverend Bruce Jones, from the host church, extended a cordial welcome to the Conference.

The Reverend Gary Bailey, Moderator, gave a challenging address encouraging the churches of the Conference to have a purpose and a vision.

The roll of churches was called with 37 churches responding with delegates.

Ten visiting ministers were recognized and welcomed by the moderator: from the Western Conference—The Reverends Joe Ingram, Harold Jones, John Williams, and Dennis Sherrod. From the Eastern Conference—The Reverends Bruce Dudley, Joseph Yates, David Charles Hansley, L. Grady Tucker, and Stephen Prescott. From the Cape Fear Conference—The Reverends John Robert Harris and Michael Ledbetter.

The moderator appointed temporary committees as follows: Parliamentarian—Dr. Michael Pelt; Nominating—the Reverend Willis Wilson, Chairman, the Reverend Frank Flowers, and the Reverend Stanley Buck; Resolutions and Temperance—the Reverend C. H. Overman, Chairman, the Reverend Earl Glenn, and the Reverend Leon Harris; Song Leader—the Reverend Ray Williamson.

The report of the Executive Committee was read by the clerk. By motion the report and the recommendation concerning appropriation of funds for the Convention was adopted. (see Reports)

At 10:00 AM, Conference Business was set aside for the Worship service. The service was opened with Scripture reading from Psalm 96, and the prayer of invocation was given by the Reverend Stanley Buck. The Reverend Ray Williamson led the congregation in the singing of "The Old Rugged Cross," followed by the offering for the Conference and the offertory prayer by the Reverend Ray Williamson. Special Music was presented by Miss Chasity Heath from the host Church. The Reverend Mark Hogan preached the Conference sermon. His text came from 2 Timothy 4:1-5. The main emphasis of that message was for Christians to "Return to the Word." He stated that there must be a return to an exposition of the Scriptures, and that this return must begin in the pulpit. He challenged/charged each minister to preach the Word. He referred to this

challenge/charge as: (1) A Spiritual or Sacred Charge, (2) A Serious Charge, (3) A Personal Charge, and (4) A Continual Charge. The worship service concluded with the singing of "I Love to Tell the Story" and with prayer by the Reverend Joey Williams.

The report of the Board of Ordination was read by the Reverend Ronnie Hobgood. By motion the report was adopted. (see Reports) The Reverend Gary Bailey, Moderator, extended a welcome to membership in the Conference to the Reverend Wayne Watson.

An oral report covering all of the Denominational Ministries was given by the Reverend Scott Sowers, Executive Administrator of the Convention of Original Free Will Baptists.

The Reverend Glenn Mills gave the report of the Conference Board of Missions. By motion the report was adopted. (see Reports)

The Reverend Walt Tyndall gave the report of the Credentials Committee. By motion the report was adopted. (see Reports)

The Reverend Ray Williamson gave the Treasurer's Report. By motion the report was adopted. (see Reports)

The Conference recessed for the noon meal with a prayer by the Reverend Joey Williams.

Afternoon Session

The afternoon session was called to order with the singing of "Amazing Grace." The Reverend Tom Miller gave the report of the Obituary Committee. (see Reports) The Roll of Ministers was called.

The Reverend Stanley Buck, Assistant Moderator, presented certificates to the following ministers in recognition of years of service: the Reverends Clinton Davis, Gary Bailey and Frank Flowers—25 years, The Reverends Tom Miller and Harry Grubbs—30 years, The Reverend Billy Ray Jordan—35 years, The Reverend C. H. Overman—45 years.

The Reverend Scott Sowers gave the report of the Continuing Education Committee. By motion the report was adopted. (see Reports)

The Reverend Willis Wilson gave the report of the Nominating Committee. By motion the report was adopted. (see Reports) The floor was opened for other nominations. There were no other nominations. By motion the nominations ceased, and the nominees were elected by acclamation.

The Reverend C. H. Overman gave the report of the Resolutions and Temperance Committee. By motion the report was adopted. (see Reports)

The Moderator called for miscellaneous business. Mrs. Leah McGlohon asked to address the Conference in order to encourage the ministers to participate in the Second Union meetings.

By motion the Conference adjourned.

The Conference was dismissed with prayer by the Reverend Michael Pelt.

Reports Executive Committee

November 19, 1996

The Executive Committee of the Central Conference met at the First Free Will Baptist Church, Greenville, on November 19, 1996. Present for the meeting were the Reverends Gary M. Bailey, Stanley Buck, Ray Williamson, Michael Pelt, and Joey Williams. The meeting was called to order and opened with prayer by the Reverend Joey Williams.

The Minutes from the 248th Annual Session of the Central Conference of Original Free Will Baptists were read, corrected, and approved.

By motion, the committee agreed to print the Constitution and Bylaws in the 1997 edition of the Original Free Will Baptist Yearbook.

It was decided by the committee that a Committee on Continuing Education of five members needed to be selected as follows: one from the Executive Committee, one from the Ordaining Council, three at-large. By consensus the Reverend Stanley Buck was asked to serve on the Committee on Continuing Education representing the Executive Committee. By consensus the Reverend Scott Sowers and the Reverend Ron Braxton were asked to serve on the Committee on Continuing Education representing two of the three at-large members. By consensus we the Executive Committee of the Central Conference ask the Ordaining Council of the Central Conference to recommend a representative from the Ordaining Council.

The committee also discussed acquiring the names, addresses, and phone numbers for the licensed ministers. The committee also discussed contacting the Ordaining Council to advise them of ministers and licensed ministers who have been absent.

The meeting was adjourned with prayer.

June 2, 1997

The Executive Committee of the Central Conference met at the First Free Will Baptist Church, Tarboro, on June 2, 1997. Present for the meeting were the Reverends Gary M. Bailey, Stanley Buck, Ray Williamson, and Joey Williamso. The meeting was called to order and opened with prayer by the Reverend Ray Williamson.

The Minutes from the November 19th meeting of the Executive Committee of the Central Conference were read, corrected, and approved.

It was reported that the Ordaining Council had been contacted concerning their representative for the Committee on Continuing Education, however, no recommendation has been received as of this meeting. By consensus, the Executive Committee extended an invitation to the Reverend C. H. Overman, to fill the position of the third at-large member. By consensus, the Executive Committee asked the Reverend Stanley Buck to call this committee together when all the members are named, elect a chairman, and begin the work of this committee as outlined in our minutes.

By motion, the committee agreed to accept the invitation extended by King's Cross Roads Free Will Baptist Church to host the 249th Annual Session of the Central Conference of the Original Free Will Baptists.

By motion, the committee agreed to invite the Reverend Mark Hogan to be the speaker of the 249th Annual Session of the Central Conference of the Original Free Will Baptists.

By motion, the committee agreed to sponsor a seminar for all Central Conference ministers,

and invite the Reverend Scott Sowers, Executive Administrator, to speak. The meeting is to be held at Strickland Dail restaurant in Farmville, with the date to be determined.

The meeting was adjourned with prayer.

September 4, 1997

The meeting was called to order by the Moderator, the Reverend Gary Bailey. Those present were: the Reverends Gary Bailey, Stanley Buck, Ray Williamson, and Michael Pelt. The Prayer of Invocation was given by Michael Pelt.

A report of a meeting of the Continuing Education Committee, held at Strickland Dail Restaurant on August 21, was submitted by Stanley Buck, a member of that committee. After some discussion of the report, the Executive Committee expressed approval of the actions of the Continuing Education Committee and then recommended that they prepare a form to be used by ministers for reporting any reading, study, or attendance at seminars, etc. for which they wished to receive units of credit (CEU's).

Dr. Michael Pelt submitted copies of an announcement by the Historical Commission of the Convention of Original Free Will Baptists of a Heritage Tour to be held on Sunday, November 2, 1997. He asked that copies of this announcement be included in the letter sent out to the churches by the clerk prior to the annual meeting of the Central Conference. His request was approved by the committee.

Ray Williamson called attention to the need for the Conference to provide assistance to the Convention in carrying out its mission on behalf of the churches in view of the fact that funds provided for Convention support have not been sufficient to meet the needs of the Convention office. He then gave a brief report on the resources belonging to the Conference and expressed the view that these resources were given to the Conference to be used for worthy purposes. After discussion of these matters the committee agreed by common consent to recommend to the Conference that we contribute \$5,000 to the Convention and that we designate \$1,000 of this amount to be used for the office of Executive Administrator and \$4,000 for the development of printed materials in the form of information packets or brochures which can be presented to new church members and to visitors in our local churches in order to better inform them about the Free Will Baptist Church and their local congregation. Furthermore, this \$4,000 will be delivered to the Convention as soon as the materials are available for distribution.

Copies of the program of the 249th Annual Session of the Central Conference to be held at King's Cross Roads Church were given to members of the Executive Committee as information.

The meeting was adjourned by the moderator and the prayer of benediction was offered by Stanley Buck.

November 6, 1997

The Executive Committee of the Central Conference met at the King's Cross Roads Free Will Baptist Church, Fountain, prior to the 249th Annual Session of the Conference. Present for the meeting were the Reverends Gary M. Bailey, Stanley Buck, Ray Williamson, Michael Pelt, and Joey Williams. The meeting was called to order and opened with prayer, By motion, the program of the 249th Annual Session of the Central Conference was approved as printed.

By motion, the minutes of the Executive Committee were read, corrected, and approved.

August 21, 1997

The Continuing Education Committee of the Central Conference met on August 21, 1997, at Strickland Dail Restaurant, Farmville, North Carolina. Members present were: the Reverends Harry Grubbs, C. H. Overman, Scott Sowers, and Stanley Buck. The Reverend C. H. Overman led in prayer.

The Reverend Scott Sowers was elected to serve as chairman. The Reverend Ron Braxton was elected to serve as recording secretary.

The committee discussed the number of hours needed to constitute CEU's. The attendance of a one-day seminar will provide one unit. The reading of a book pertaining to ministry such as Bible Doctrine, Practical Preaching, Visitation Ministry, and Church History will provide one unit of credit. The minister can receive credit for five books on an annual basis.

Seminars less than a day will require eight hours combined to receive one unit of credit.

The fiscal year will begin July 1 and conclude June 30. The minister is required to send credit information to the committee by October 1.

A book list will not be recommended by the committee. We offer the following suggestions for reading in the areas that pertain to Theology, Ministry, Biblical Studies, Church History, Evangelism, Church Growth, Church Administration, and Youth Ministry.

Studies in language, such as Spanish, for the purpose of ministry would receive credit. Courses on counseling would provide credit. Any work that would be practical for ministry would provide credit. Courses in the field of communication, public speaking and improving writing skills for ministry purposes would offer credit.

Suggestions for seminars were as follows: Billy Graham School of Evangelism, FWB Seminars and Workshops, Evangelism Explosion, and John Maxwell Evangelism Conference. There are many other seminars that would be beneficial in education for our pastors.

The committee will meet on October 14, six o'clock, at Strickland Dail Restaurant.

November 4, 1997

The Continuing Education Committee of the Central Conference met on November 4, 1997, at FWB Headquarters in Ayden, North Carolina. Members present were: The Reverends Harry Grubbs, C. H. Overman, Scott Sowers, and Stanley Buck. The Reverend C. H. Overman led in prayer.

INASMUCH AS, the Convention of Original Free Will Baptists adopted the vision statement as prepared by Project Solutions Task Force Committee, which states: "In an effort to fulfill the mission of the Original Free Will Baptist Church for the next five church years (1997–98 through 2001–02) we will focus on challenging Original Free Will Baptists to commit to the true meaning of church membership as reflected in our Church Covenant; to practice evangelism as mandated by the Scriptures and our love and compassion for people; and challenge Original Free Will Baptists to increase the number of persons doing ministry as mandated by the words and deeds of the servant, Jesus Christ."

BE IT RESOLVED, that we commit ourselves, as ministers and delegates, to the fulfillment of this vision statement.
