Proceedings

The Central Conference, being the continuation of the General Conference of Original Free Will Baptists of North Carolina, convened in its 252nd annual session with Elm Grove Free Will Baptist Church of Ayden, North Carolina, on Thursday, November 9, 2000, at 9:30 am.

The Conference opened with the hymn, "Power in the Blood." Opening scripture and prayer were offered by Mr. Alan Joyner, a licensed minister.

The Reverend J.B. Narron, clerk, called the annual session to order. The Reverend Charles Branch, from the host church, extended a cordial welcome to the Conference.

The Reverend Ray Williamson, moderator, gave a challenging address from Colossians 4:2 encouraging the Central Conference churches to pray. The Central Conference churches need to devote themselves to prayer. Things can be changed if God's people would pray. The Reverend Harold Jones led the Conference in prayer for our nations.

The roll of churches was called with 34 churches responding with delegates.

Seven visiting ministers were recognized and welcomed by the moderator: Western Conference: The Reverends Don Venable, Harold Jones, Dennis Sherrod and Bruce Dudley; Eastern Conference: The Reverends Joseph Yates, David Hansley, Mr. Mike Williams, and Mr. Jason Young; Cape Fear: The Reverend Frank Harrison

The Moderator appointed temporary committees as follows: Parliamentarian: Dr. Michael Pelt; Resolutions and Temperance: The Reverends David Langley, Thomas Bowen, and Mr. Darren Davenport; Nominating Committee: The Reverends Brad Williamson, John Robert Harris, and Tony Glass.

The report of the Executive Committee was read by the clerk. By motion, the report was adopted with correction. (see Reports)

The Executive Committee passed out Search Committee packages and stated that the Executive Committee would be willing to help any church in the process of searching a pastor.

The report of the Board of Ordination was read by the Reverend Ronnie Hobgood. By motion, the report was adopted. (see reports)

The Reverend Leon Grubbs gave the report of the Conference Board of Missions. By motion, the report was adopted. (see reports)

By motion, the proposed constitutional changes were laid on the table.

At 10:15 am the Conference business was set aside for the worship service. The service was opened with scripture reading from I Chronicles 16:23-29, and the prayer of invocation was given by the Reverend Joey Williams. The Reverend Ray Williamson led the congregation in the singing of "In the Service of the King" followed by the offering for the Conference and the offertory prayer by the Reverend Walter Reynolds. Special music was presented by Wendy Evans. Dr. Michael Pelt preached the conference sermon. His text came from I Corinthians 10:1-11. The main emphasis and challenge of this message was the need to know our history so that we might understand who we are and move forward in the future. Dr. Pelt's two main points were: (1) Our heritage did not just begin with Paul Palmer, and (2) in the past it has been shown that we are vulnerable to those who would divide is.

The worship service concluded with the singing of "Jesus Calls Us". The Reverend Ray Williamson, moderator, along with the conference extended a welcome to membership in the conference to Reverends Frank Cockrell, David Varnell, Johnny Sullivan, Gene Britt, Kevin Jackson, Barry Williamson, and Todd Sutton.

The service closed in prayer by the Reverend Frankie Baggett.

The business session continues at 11:20 am with remarks from the Reverend David C. Hansley, Convention General Administrator, concerning the work of the Convention. Representing the denominational ministries were as follows: the Reverend Bobby Taylor. Children's Home; the Reverend John Williams, Cragmont Assembly; the Reverend Harold Jones, OFWB International; the Reverend Frank Harrison, Mount Olive College; the Reverend Bruce Dudley, Retirement Homes; Mrs. Mary Dudley, Sunday School Board; the Reverend C.H. Overman, Free Will Baptist Press; and Mr. Mike Williams, Camp Vandemere.

Remarks and greetings were given by the Reverend Leon Grubbs, President of the Convention of Original Free Will Baptists.

The Conference recessed for the noon meal with prayer by the Reverend Phil Wood.

Afternoon Session

The Afternoon Session was called to order at 1:15 pm with the singing of "I Am Resolved".

The Reverend Ray Williamson, moderator, presented certificates to the following ministers in recognition of years of service: The Reverends N. Bruce Barrow-65 years; J.B. Narron-50 years; Dr. Michael Pelt-50 years; and Joseph Lehmann-35 years.

The roll of ministers was called.

The Reverend Tom Miller gave the report of the Obituary Committee. By motion, the report was adopted. (see reports)

The Reverend Carroll Bradbury gave the financial report of the Conference Board of Missions. By motion, the report was adopted.

The Reverend Tony Glass gave the report of the Credentials Committee. By motion, the report was adopted. (see reports)

The Reverend Walter Reynolds gave the Treasurer's Report. By motion, the report was adopted. (see reports)

The Reverend Ray Williamson presented the Reverend Walt Tyndall with a certificate for the hours of CEU's that he had completed.

There was no report from the Continuing Education Committee.

The Reverend Brad Williamson gave the report of the Nominating Committee. By motion, the report was adopted. (see reports)

The floor was opened for other nominations. There were no other nominations.

By motion, the Executive Committee was asked to study the possibilities of establishing a committee to supervise the money for missions and outreach and present recommendations at the next Conference session. The motion was seconded and adopted.

Central Conference Mission Board				

The Central Conference Mission Board, after much prayer and thoughtful consideration, has come to the conclusion that the role of the Conference Missions, as defined in our Constitution, has become obsolete. We, therefore, recommend that the Board of Missions be dissolved, that all moneys and official records be turned over to the Conference, and that necessary amendments be made to the Constitution to reflect the dissolution.

Constitutional amendments are needed as follows:

Article IV. Standing Boards and Committees, second paragraph, first sentence: Delete the phrase, and a board of missions. That sentence then will read, A board of trustees, a board of ordination, and a board of finance, consisting of five members each, shall be elected.

Article X. Duties and Responsibilities: Delete Section 10. It shall be the duty of the board of missions to cooperate with the churches and the conference in furthering the establishment of churches within the bounds of the conference. The missions board shall endeavor through cooperating with the State Board of Missions to raise money, arrange itineraries, and keep the work of missions before our churches.

Report of the Resolution and Temperance Committee

Resolution #1

Whereas, Mount Olive College is a ministry of the Original Free Will Baptist Denomination; and

Whereas, the mission statement of our College is:

"To operate and maintain a private church affiliated college for the education of men and women that offers programs including professional studies, that are rooted in the liberal arts tradition and provided in an environment nurtured by Christian values;"

"To maintain and support academic excellence through higher learning and higher values in a community made up of persons dedicated to the practice and advancement of Christian ideals in all aspects of life;"

"To seek and require higher standards in providing revelent educational programs reflecting an emphasis on the personal growth of each student at places and times that enhance the possible." (College Charter)

And whereas, the Executive Committee in the 88th session of the Convention of Original Free Will Baptist recommend and strongly encouraged the Board of Trustees of Mount Olive College to prayerfully re-examine its position in relation to the mission statement of the college and take necessary action to bring the college back into a true relationship with said mission statement...
