

Proceedings

Preliminary Gathering

The Central Conference of Original Free Will Baptists gathered for its 267th Annual Session at Black Jack OFWB Church on Thursday, November 5, 2015. Registration took place from 3:30 – 5:00 p.m. The host church provided space for denominational ministries to set up displays and to have ministry representatives available to meet and greet Conference attendees prior to the opening session and in-between sessions. Ministry representatives were also given an opportunity to share information about their ministries in the sunctuary from 4:00 s:00 p.m.

Opening Session

The Opening Session began in the sanctuary at 5:00 p.m. The session opened with the congregation singing "Joyful, Joyful, We Adore Thee."

Mr. Michael Arthur read Psalm 133:1-3 and led in prayer.

The Reverend Barry Williamson, Assistant Clerk, called the 267th Annual Session to order. The Reverend Phillip Boykin, Pastor of Black Jack OFWB Church, extended words of welcome to the Conference.

Visitors were recognized by The Reverend Kelley Smart, Assistant Moderator.

The Conference offering was received.

The Reverend Bryant Hines, Moderator, noted that there would not be a Moderator's Address in order to give more time to the Keynote Speaker. He also noted that there would not be a Memorial Service since no Central Conference Ministers had died in the last year. Reverend Hines also instructed each person present at the Conference to take time to read and review the various reports in the Report Book (Clerk, Treasurer, Board of Ordination, Clurch Growth and Evangelism) before the Evening Session since the reports would not be read aloud. During the Approval of Various Reports later in the Evening Session, the moderator will ask for a motion and a second to approve the reports, but will not call for each report to be read aloud. This will save valuable Conference time. The moderator also noted there would not be a Roll Call of Churches or a Roll Call of Ministers since this information is gleaned through Conference Registration before the Opening Session. This will also save valuable Conference time.

The moderator appointed temporary committees needed to conduct our Conference.

Nominating: The Reverend Mark Hobbs (Chair), The Reverend Josh Hobgood, and The Reverend Roger Haithcock Resolutions: The Reverend Doug Skinner (Chair), The Reverend Doug Tyson and Reverend Glenn Batten Parliamentarian: The Reverend Doctor John Hill

There were no newly licensed or newly ordained ministers present to be recognized.

The Reverend Kelley Smart introduced our Keynote Speaker, The Reverend Doctor John Blackwell, who spoke on the topic of "Equipping the Saints for Lives of Service." Doctor Blackwell is Dean of the Chapel at the University of Mount Olive.

Blessings were offered for the evening meal and the Conference was dismissed to eat and fellowship together for the next hour.

Evening Session

After the evening meal, the Evening Session opened in the sanctuary at 7:00 p.m. with the congregation singing "Send the Light."

Various reports were presented during this session.

The Reverend Tom Malin, Treasurer, reported that the Conference offering totaled \$517.00.

The Reverend Doctor John Hill spoke on behalf of the Minister Care Committee. He explained how this ministry works, how coverage works and the relationship the Conference has with CareNet Counseling East. He then made a motion to expand this ministry to include spouses of ministers and children in the immediate family. The motion was seconded and carried.

The moderator noted again that all the Conference reports are in the Report Book and have been available for review since Registration. He brought attention to the Clerk's Report which consists of the Conference Executive Committee Reports from throughout the year. He noted that a motion to receive the Clerk's Report will also include adopting a recommendation by the Executive Committee for the Conference to make a donation of \$1000 to the OFWB Press. This recommendation is recorded in the October 13, 2015 Minutes of the Executive Committee on page 3 of the Report Book. After explaining this recommendation, a motion was made and seconded to approve the Clerk's Report including the donation to the OFWB Press. Motion was carried.

The moderator called attention to the Treasurer's Report on pages 6-8. Motion was made and seconded to approve the Treasurer's Report and the proposed budget for 2015-16 on page 8. Motion carried.

The moderator called attention to the Report of the Board of Ordination on pages 4-5. Motion was made and seconded to approve this report. One question was asked to define a "Provisional Certificate of License," This question was answered by the moderator. Motion to adopt the report was carried.

The moderator called attention to the Church Growth and Evangelism Committee Report on page 9. Motion was made and seconded to approve this report. Motion carried.

The Reverend Doctor Franklin Baggett, Chairman of the Central Conference Board of Ordination announced that there would be an Ordination Service Sunday at 3:00 p.m. at Friendship OFWB Church. Ministers and members of the Conference were encouraged to attend.

The moderator opened the floor for New Business. Conference Parliamentarian, The Reverend Doctor John Hill, noted that the Conference Constitution and Bylaws are in need of updating. He made a motion that the Executive Committee appoint a Revisions Committee to update the Constitution and Bylaws. The moderator clarified Reverend Doctor Hill's intention that this revision be completed by the next Session of the Conference. Motion was carried.

The moderator called for the Report of the Nominating Committee which is on page 15 of the Report Book. Reverend Mark Hobbs came forward to note two changes to the report. He noted that for the Trustees, Mrs. Barbara Mills passed away and a replacement is needed. He recommended Mrs. Linda Weathersby and noted her term would go through 2016 to fulfill the term of Mrs. Mills. Also, under Credentials Committee, he noted that the person to join the committee would be Reverend Tony Glass instead of Reverend Josh Hobgood—reason being that Reverend Josh Hobgood is already on the committee. Motion was made and seconded to place these names as amended into nomination. The floor was opened for any additional nominations. Motion was made and seconded that nominations cease and to elect by acclamation. Motion was carried.

The Credentials Committee reported that in attendance were 10 registered visitors, 39 ordained ministers, 3 licensed ministers, and 43 delegates. The Committee noted that it was suspected that some people in attendance did not register and that the estimated total attendance was 135. Motion to approve this report was seconded and carried.

The moderator recognized the Resolutions Committee and Reverend Kelley Smart, who was standing in for Reverend Doug Skinner. The Resolutions Committee submitted the following resolution for consideration: "Be it resolved that the 267th Annual Session of the Central Conference of Original Free Will Baptists give a rising vote of thanks to the Black Jack Original Free Will Baptist Church for extending its hospitality and kindness to the visitors, delegates and ministers of said Conference. Respectfully submitted, Reverends Doug Skinner, Glenn Batten and Doug Tyson." Motion to adopt this resolution was seconded and carried.

The moderator called on The Reverend Barry Williamson to present Certificates of Service to Central Conference ministers for their dedicated service to the Lord. The following ministers were recognized:

The moderator called attention to one misprint in the bulletin containing the Order of Service for the Conference. The 268th Annual Session of the Central Conference of Original Free Will Baptists will meet on Thursday, November 10, 2016 at Rose of Sharon Original Free Will Baptist Church—not on November 3 as was printed.

Worship Celebration

The Worship Celebration began immediately after the Evening Session. The Celebration began with the congregation singing "Revive Us Again."

Wonderful special music was provided by a group from Black Jack OFWB Church.

The Reverend Doctor John Blackwell, spoke on the topic of "Equipping the Saints for Lives of Service: Part 2." After this, Doctor Blackwell led in a Service of Holy Communion.

The Conference was closed in prayer by The Reverend Kelley Smart.

The Board of Ordination will conduct a mandatory workshop for all Licensed Ministers and ministers holding a Provisional Certificate of Ordination at Em Grove Original Free Will Baptist Church Saturday February 27, 2016 at 9 an. All Licensed Ministers and those holding a Provisional Certificate of Ordination must attend at least one workshop before being considered for ordination.

Inclusions to this report:

- 1. The Articles of Faith and Principles of Church Government for Original Free Will Baptists in Section 1: The Local Congregation states the following on page 68 concerning the church's calling of a pastor. "The church shall call its own pastor, from among the duly Ordained Original Free Will Baptist ministers who are approved by the Conference of which the church is a member." We wish to remind any church in our Conference, when extending a call to a minister to serve as your pastor, to be sure that the minister gets proper clearance from the Conference Board of Ordination before assuming duties as pastor of the church.
- All candidates for ordination in the Central Conference of Original Free Will Baptists must meet the educational requirements set forth by the Conference of November 8, 2007 and take and pass the Ordination Examination.
- 3. We wish to remind all Central Conference ordained ministers of the following resolution, which was adopted at the conference meeting of November 6, 2008. "All Central Conference Ordained Ministers must physically attend at least one Conference meeting every three years to maintain their Conference Credentials. Exceptions will include those on active full time military daty, full time foreign missionaries and those confined to home or health care facilities."
- 4. In accordance with "The Articles of Faith and Church Government for Original Free Will Baptists (of The English General Baptist Heritage) under "The Rules Of Church Government," (Section 1: The Local Congregation," "Meetings Of the Local Congregation," "The ordinances of the Gospel are administered only by ordained ministers." These ordained ministers must be ministers approved by the Central Conference Board of Ordination.

5. The Central Conference gives a Christian flag to the family of a deceased ordained minister.

6. All Ordained Ministers of the Central Conference must maintain membership in an Original Free Will Baptist Church.

More information for submitting requests for Continuing Education Credit is outlined in the "Procedures" section below.

Purpose

The purpose of the Central Conference Continuing Education Program is to help our ministers with the practice of life-long learning. By continuing their education Central Conference ordained ministers will continue to grow in their spiritual walk with Christ as they grow they will be better equipped to serve the churches of the Central Conference. As the leadership of the churches grow the church itself will grow, therefore the growth and continuing education of the ministers is vital to the growth of the church. It is imperative that the ministers of the Central Conference follow the advice given to Timothy by Paul when he said, "Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth."

Guidelines

Continuing Education Units (CEU's) will be based on educational opportunities. These would include reading a book, attending a seminar or class, or taking a college or seminary course.

Continuing Education Units/Credits

CEU credits will be given according to the following scale:

Books: up to 200 pages-½ CEU; 200-400 pages-1 CEU. Books over 400 pages will be considered on an individual basis.

Seminars: 3-5 hour seminar-½ CEU; 6-10 hour seminar-1 CEU. Seminar over ten hours will be considered on an individual basis. College or Seminary Course: If the class is taken from an accredited institution (Southern Association of Colleges and Schools or Association of Theological Schools in the United States and Canada), one will receive 4 CEUs for each credit hour. Credit hours equal one hour per week in class for sixteen weeks. If you take a 3 credit hour course, you will receive 12 CEU's. If the course is taken from an institution that is not accredited by SACS or ATS, it will be considered on an individual basis.

Areas of Study

Biblical Studies: This includes any area of study from the Bible such as books of the Bible, themes, authors, or historical information from the Bible.

Historical Studies: This includes History of the Christian Church, Free Will Baptist Denomination, or Local Churches.

Theological Studies: This includes areas of studies from the following: Prolegomena, Bibliology, Theology Proper, Christology, Pneumatology, Anelology, Anthropology, Soteriology, Ecclesiology, Eschatology, etc.

Practical Studies: This includes area of studies concerning the working and growth of the local church, pastoral care, counseling, leadership, administration, evangelism, preaching and worship.

Spiritual Formation Studies: This includes area of studies concerning maturity of Christians.

Procedures

To receive continuing education credits, work should be submitted to the Continuing Education Committee. Simply write a 150 word summary and application of the seminar, book read, or college or seminary course completed and attach it to the Continuing Education Report Form. The report form is available at the annual conference or can be requested from a committee member or you can simply create your own report form by including the following. For a seminar, include the title of the seminar, sponsoring organization, presenter's name, and length of seminar. For a book you have read, include the title of the book, author, publisher, and date the book was read. For a college or seminary course, include the name of the course, name of the college or seminary, professor's name, and a copy of the syllabus. The committee will review all work and will send notification to the one who submitted the work and also the Board of Ordination.
