# The 271<sup>st</sup> Annual Session of the Central Conference of Original Free Will Baptists Greenville First OFWB Church November 7, 2019

- The 271<sup>st</sup> Annual Session of the Central Conference of Original Free Will Baptists convened at Greenville First Original Free Will Baptist Church on Thursday, November 7<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m.
- The 271<sup>st</sup> Annual Session was officially called to order by the Rev. Josh Hobgood.

The welcome and invocation were given by Dr. Franklin Baggett, Assistant Moderator.

- The congregation joined in worship by singing "How Great is Our God".
- The Reverend Barry Williamson gave the moderator's address using Matthew 4:18-22 as his scripture reference. He mentioned that as God's people and churches we need to "Carry the Name of Jesus" so that people might come to know the salvation found in that name.
- The Rev. Keith Gardner, Pastor of Greenville First OFWB Church, greeted all in attendance on behalf of the host church.
- The Rev. Josh Hobgood, clerk, offered greetings to visitors and recognized all visitors in attendance. He asked all ministers to stand and state their name and place of service. He then asked all visiting ministers to stand and state their place of service.

The Clerk's report was given by the Rev. Josh Hobgood. By motion the report was adopted.

The Treasurer's report was given by the Rev. Tom Malin. By motion the report was adopted.

The Treasurer then presented the 2019-2020 Central Conference budget. By motion the budget was adopted.

The Board of Ordination report was given by the Rev. Dustin Bannister By motion the report was adopted.

The Rev. John Hill presented a report of information from the Minister Care Committee. This was accepted as information.

Time was given to greet newly licensed and ordained ministers during a break

The Rev. Todd Sutton recognized ministers for their years of service and gave out certificates of Recognition to Rev. Melvin Moore (60), Rev. Charles Branch (50), Rev. Phillip Wood (40), Rev. Jack Weathersby (25), Rev. Charlie Carroll (25), Rev. Tony Glass (20), Rev. Frank Cockrell (20).

The Rev. Kelly Smart presented the Nominating Committee Report. The report was accepted. By motion nominations were ceased and elected by acclamation.

At this time a short break was taken.

The Morning Worship Service began with the Rev. Bill Groce reading scripture and leading in the opening prayer.

The congregation joined in the singing of "Amazing Grace/My Chains are Gone."

The Rev. Tom Malin lead the offertory prayer.

Special Music was provided by the Conference Music Group consisting of the Rev. Josh Hobgood, Rev. Stephen Prescott and Adam Denton.

The Rev. Dr. Franklin Baggett introduced the Keynote speaker, the Rev. Justin Barnett, Pastor of Jackson Heights OFWB Church.

The Rev. Justin Barnett gave the Key Note address, "Why Does Your Church Exist?," from Jonah 4:11.

The Congregation sang the hymn of commitment "Send the Light."

The Rev. Keith Gardner gave the report of the Memorial Committee. The Rev. John Simpson and minister's wife Marie Narron, were recognized.

Conference participants were dismissed to attend one of six workshops that were offered. Each of the workshops centered on the theme of the Conference – "Carry the Name: Encouraging Evangelism in our Local Churches."

Lunch was served in the Fellowship Hall.

A piano recitation was given by Kwan Yi, the music director at Greenville First OFWB Church and Assistant Professor of Piano at East Carolina University.

The final business session was called to order by the Rev. Barry Williamson.

The Resolutions Committee report was given by the Rev. Ronnie Hobgood. By motion it was adopted.

#### **Executive Committee Report**

#### Central Conference Executive Committee Meeting Winterville December 3, 2018

The Central Conference Executive Committee met in Winterville, NC at The Biscuit and The Bean.

Those present were the Reverends Barry Williamson, Tom Malin, Todd Sutton, Bill Groce, and Dr. Frankie Baggett.

The Rev. Barry Williamson moderator gave a devotion from the book of Daniel. He reminded us that God can do great and mighty things as he works through us. We need to remember that it is God working through us. We need to remain humble and give all the praise to God.

We had a lengthy and thorough discussion and evaluation of the recent Annual Central Conference meeting which was held at La Grange FWB in November 2018. A motion was approved to ask the Board of Ordination to be in charge of presenting the Christian Flag to the Family of a deceased Original Free Will Baptist Pastor.

A motion was made to adjourn.

The Board of Ordination will conduct a workshop for all Licensed Ministers and ministers holding a Provisional Certificate of Ordination at the First Free Will Baptist Church of La Grange, Saturday, February 22, 2020 at 9 am. All Licensed Ministers and those holding a Provisional Certificate of Ordination must attend at least one workshop before being considered for ordination.

### Inclusions to this report:

1. The Articles of Faith and Principles of Church Government for Original Free Will Baptists in Section 1: The Local Congregation states the following concerning the church's calling of a pastor: "The church shall call its own pastor, from among the duly Ordained Original Free Will Baptist ministers who are approved by the Conference of which the church is a member." We wish to remind any church in our Conference, when extending a call to a minister to serve as your pastor, to be sure that the minister gets proper clearance from the Conference Board of Ordination before assuming duties as pastor of the church.

- 2. All candidates for ordination in the Central Conference of Original Free Will Baptists must meet the educational requirements set forth by the Conference of November 8, 2007 and take and pass the Ordination Examination.
- 3. We wish to remind all Central Conference ordained ministers they are required to attend the annual session of the Conference each year. Requests for excusal shall be submitted in writing to the Clerk of the Conference before the Conference, or within thirty days after the Conference for those with unanticipated causes for absence. Ministers who fail to attend the annual Conference physically for three consecutive years shall be subject to lose their credentials.

- 4. In accordance with "The Articles of Faith and Church Government for Original Free Will Baptists (of The English General Baptist Heritage) under 'The Rules Of Church Government,' 'Section 1: The Local Congregation,' 'Meetings Of the Local Congregation:' 'The ordinances of the Gospel are administered only by ordained ministers.'" These ordained ministers must be ministers approved by the Central Conference Board of Ordination.
- 5. Upon requests, the Central Conference gives a Christian flag to the family of a deceased ordained minister who is a member of the Conference.
- 6. All Ordained Ministers of the Central Conference must maintain membership in an Original Free Will Baptist Church.
- 7. The Central Conference of Original Free Will Baptists prohibits Central Conference ordained ministers, and any ordained minister from any other Conference serving within the Central Conference, from officiating same gender marriages. Ordained ministers who violate this rule will be subject to the disciplinary actions issued by the Board of Ordination and the minister may lose ordination credentials.
- 8. Licensed Ministers from any conference are not allowed to be interim pastors in the Central Conference. Licensed Ministers cannot supply speak more than four Sundays in a calendar year in the same congregation, and two of those Sundays must have ninety days separating them.
- 9. The Board of Ordination stands ready to help people called to the Gospel Ministry.

#### **Continuing Education Committee Report**

Many ministers are pursuing additional educational opportunities on a regular basis. Perhaps you have attended a seminar or read a book or completed a college or seminary course. We applaud you in this endeavor. We also want to reward you and give you credit for your diligence in continuing your education and training. To receive credit from the Central Conference, simply complete a Continuing Education Report Form and write a 150 word summary about the seminar, book read, or course completed and send it to one of the Continuing Education committee members. More information for submitting requests for Continuing Education Credit is outlined in the "Procedures" section below.

#### Purpose

The purpose of the Central Conference Continuing Education Program is to help our ministers with the practice of life-long learning. By continuing their education Central Conference ordained ministers will continue to grow in their spiritual walk with Christ as they grow they will be better equipped to serve the churches of the Central Conference. As the leadership of the churches grow the church itself will grow, therefore the growth and continuing education of the ministers is vital to the growth of the church. It is imperative that the ministers of the Central Conference follow the advice given to Timothy by Paul when he said, "Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth."

#### Guidelines

Continuing Education Units (CEU's) will be based on educational opportunities. These would include reading a book, attending a seminar or class, or taking a college or seminary course.

#### **Continuing Education Units/Credits**

CEU credits will be given according to the following scale:

Books: up to 200 pages-½ CEU; 200-400 pages-1 CEU. Books over 400 pages will be considered on an individual basis.

Seminars: 3-5 hour seminar-½ CEU; 6-10 hour seminar-1 CEU. Seminar over ten hours will be considered on an individual basis.

College or Seminary Course: If the class is taken from an accredited institution (Southern Association of Colleges and Schools or Association of Theological Schools in the United States and Canada), one will receive 4 CEUs for each credit hour. Credit hours equal one hour per week in class for sixteen weeks. If you take a 3 credit hour course, you will receive 12 CEU's. If the course is taken from an institution that is not accredited by SACS or ATS, it will be considered on an individual basis.

#### **Areas of Study**

Biblical Studies: This includes any area of study from the Bible such as books of the Bible, themes, authors, or historical information from the Bible.

Historical Studies: This includes History of the Christian Church, Free Will Baptist Denomination, or Local Churches. Theological Studies: This includes areas of studies from the following: Prolegomena, Bibliology, Theology Proper, Christology, Pneumatology, Anelology, Anthropology, Soteriology, Ecclesiology, Eschatology, etc.

Practical Studies: This includes area of studies concerning the working and growth of the local church, pastoral care, counseling, leadership, administration, evangelism, preaching and worship.

Spiritual Formation Studies: This includes area of studies concerning maturity of Christians.

#### Procedures

To receive continuing education credits, work should be submitted to the Continuing Education Committee. Simply write a 150 word summary and application of the seminar, book read, or college or seminary course completed and attach it to the Continuing Education Report Form. The report form is available at the annual conference or can be requested from a committee member or you can simply create your own report form by including the following. For a seminar, include the title of the seminar, sponsoring organization, presenter's name, and length of seminar. For a book you have read, include the title of the book, author, publisher, and date the book was read. For a college or seminary course, include the name of the course, name of the college or seminary, professor's name, and a copy of the syllabus. The committee will review all work and will send notification to the one who submitted the work and also the Board of Ordination.
