# **The 272 Annual Session of the Central Conference of OFWB**

## **Thursday, November 10, 2022**

The 272<sup>nd</sup> Annual Session of the Central Conference of Original Free Will Baptists convened at Ormondsville Original Free Will Baptist Church on Thursday, November 10<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 am.

The 272<sup>nd</sup> Annual Session was officially called to order by the Reverend Dale Belvin.

The welcome and invocation by the Reverend Barry Williamson, Moderator

The congregation joined in worship by singing "Redeemed" and "Come Thou Fount".

The Reverend Barry Williamson gave the moderator's address using Psalm 100 as his text.

The Reverend Don Ribeiro, Pastor of Ormondsville OFWB Church, greeted all in attendance on behalf of the host church.

The Reverend Dale Belvin, clerk, as the following groups of individuals to stand and introduce themselves by stating their name and place of service:

The Reverend Dale Belvin, Clerk, conducted the first reading of proposed constitutional changes:

### **Proposed Change #1**

Article 3.2e under the subheading "Member Congregation"

Statement "i" under Article 3.2e currently reads: The Member Congregation shall...

"send an annual church report indicating statistical and financial data demonstrating the congregation's health and benevolent work in their community, as well as to the denomination's ministries."

Proposed Change: The Member Congregation shall... "send an annual church report."

## **Proposed Change #2**

Article 4.4 under the subheading "Term of Service"

In Article 4.4b, it reads:

"Each office has a term limit of 4 years (2 two-year terms) except that of the Treasurer, who is granted a maximum of 10 years (5 two-year terms) before becoming ineligible to serve on the Executive Committee."

Proposed Change:

"Each office has a term limit of 4 years (2 two-year terms) except that of the Treasurer, who is granted a maximum of 10 years (5 two-year terms) before becoming ineligible to serve on the Executive Committee in the same position."

## **Proposed Change #3**

Article 7.6 under the subheading "Free Will Baptist Press and Church Finance Association Representative."

Article 7.6 currently reads:

### **7.6 – Free Will Baptist Press and Church Finance Association Representative(s)**

- a) A representative shall be elected to represent the Conference's membership in the Free Will Baptist Press; the term of the office shall be two years.
- b) A representative shall be elected to represent the Conference's membership in the Church Finance Association, the term of the office shall be two years.
- c) Representatives are expected to attend the meetings of these ministries to represent the Central Conference's share of those ministries.

Proposed Change:

### **7.6 –Church Finance Association Representative(s)**

- a) A representative shall be elected to represent the Conference's membership in the Church Finance Association, the term of the office shall be two years.
- b) The representatives are expected to attend the meetings of this ministry to represent the Central Conference's share of this ministry.

The Reverend Phillip Boykin motioned to lay the proposed changes on the table. The motion was seconded and adopted.

The Clerk's report was given by the Reverend Dale Belvin. The Reverend John Hill motioned to forgo the reading of the minutes of the Central Conference Executive Committee since they are in written form and to approve the minutes as presented. The motion was seconded and adopted.

The Treasurer's Report was given by the Reverend Tom Malin. By motion the report was adopted.

The Treasurer then presented the 2022-2023 Central Conference budget. By motion the budget was adopted.

The Board of Ordination report was given by the Reverend Dr. Dustin Bannister. By motion the report was adopted.

The Reverend John Hill presented a report for information from the Minister Care Committee. This report was received as information.

There was no old business to be addressed by the conference.

The Reverend Phillip Boykin presented the Nominating Committee Report. The report was accepted. Motion made to close nominations and elect those nominated to office. The motion was seconded and adopted.

The Reverend Tom Malin, treasurer, lead the offertory prayer.

The congregation joined in worship by singing "How Great Thou Art" while the offering was received.

The Reverend Barry Williamson recognized those ministers who had recently been ordained or licensed within the Central Conference and extended the right hand of fellowship.

At this time, a short break was taken.

The Morning Worship Service began with the Reverend Michael Bryan reading scripture and leading in the opening prayer. The congregation joined in singing “The Church’s One Foundation” and “Jesus Paid It All”

The Reverend Dr. Frankie Baggett introduced the Keynote speaker, the Reverend Harold Jones, Director of Original Free Will Baptist, International.

A Special Music selection was provided by Dale Belvin, Adam Denton, and Jonathan Whitford.

A Special Music selection was provided by Ormondsville OFWB Church.

The Reverend Harold Jones gave the Keynote address focusing on the theme of Praying for Laborers for the Harvest using Matthew 9:38 for the text.

The congregation joined in response to the message by singing “It Is Well”.

The Reverend Christ Haddock gave the Memorial Committee report. The following were recognized during this time: the Reverend Jonas Letchworth, the Reverend Dr. Thomas Maynard Parrish, the Reverend Melvin Thomas Moore.

At this time, a short break was taken.

The final business session was called to order by the Reverend Dr. Frankie Baggett.

The Reverend Dale Belvin conducted the second reading of the proposed constitutional changes. A motion was made to take the constitutional changes off the table. The motion was seconded and passed.

The Central Conference Executive Committee that the Central Conference accept the constitutional changes as presented to the conference. These three changes are to be voted on together. The motion was seconded and adopted.

The report of the Credentials Committee was given by the Reverend Kelley Smart and adopted by motion.

The Resolutions Committee report was given by the Reverend Dr. David Hines.

1. Whereas the Central Conference Executive Committee has served our churches well and shown exceptional leadership during unprecedented challenges related to the COVID-19 pandemic; be it therefore resolved that the 272<sup>nd</sup> Annual Session of the Central Conference of Original Free Will Baptists give our Executive Committee a rising vote of thanks for their dedicated service.

That resolution was adopted by motion.

2. Be it therefore resolved that we give a rising vote of thanks to the pastor and members of Ormondsville Original Free Will Baptist Church for their generosity and hospitality in hosting the 272<sup>nd</sup> Annual Session of the Central Conference of Original Free Will Baptists.

The Reverend Dr. Frankie Baggett opened the floor for any other business to be brought before the Central Conference. There was none at this time.

Reports were given from Denominational and Ancillary ministries:

- Retirement Homes—The Reverend Keith Phillips, a member of the Retirement Homes board, gave the report as the Reverend Ronnie Taylor, the ministry director, was going through treatment for cancer.
- Convention of Original Free Will Baptists—the Reverend Dr. David Hines, President of the Convention of Original Free Will Baptists
- Free Will Baptist Children's Home—the Reverend Gavin Williams, Director of Church Ministries for FWB Children's Home
- Free Will Baptist Press—the Reverend John Hill, CEO
- Church Finance and Minister's Program—Dan Taylor, Director of the Minister's Program gave both reports.
- Christian Education Ministry—Gail Heath
- Church Planting and Renewal—the Reverend Dr. Frankie Baggett
  - In this report we were given an update on a ministry effort to serve the students at East Carolina University. This ministry effort is one that the Central Conference has voted to support with people and monetary resources.
- Convention Services Office—the Reverend Gary Bailey, Director of Convention Services

The Reverend John Hill made a motion that the Central Conference authorize the Central Conference Executive Committee to make whatever decisions that need to be made to make the Original Free Will Baptist Ministry at East Carolina University possible. Motion was seconded and adopted.

A motion was adopted to adjourn.

**Central Conference Executive Committee Meeting  
The Pointe at Stoney Creek OFWB Church, Goldsboro  
May 26th, 2022—1:00 PM**

The Executive Committee of the Central Conference met at Stoney Creek OFWB Church.

Those present were the Reverends Barry Williamson, Frankie Baggett, Dale Belvin, and Carlton Oakley.

Reverend Barry Williamson opened the meeting with prayer.

This was our first official meeting of the Central Conference Executive Committee with new members, and Reverend Williamson welcomed the new members.

No Treasurer's report was given at this time due to the Reverend Malin undergoing stem cell transplant treatments.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

There was a brief review of the combined meeting of the Central Conference Executive Committee and the Central Conference Examining Board in which Detective Daniel Hines presented the outcomes of the court case involving Pine Grove OFWB Church, Pitt County.

Online data collection and access were discussed. The Executive Committee currently has all of its files held in Dropbox. Over time it has grown very disorganized and is hard to navigate. A decision was made to open a new drive on Google. Reverend Belvin will set up Google Drive for the Executive Committee and distribute log-in information to Executive Committee members.

A motion was made that we remove Piney Grove Church, Pitt County from the roll of Central Conference Churches (because they have ceased to exist). The motion was seconded and passed.

The Executive Committee received updated information in regard to the court decision relating to Piney Grove Church, Pitt County. Two letters from Mrs. Margaret Sullivan were shared with the Executive Committee, in which some requests were made for possible ways to memorialize the church.

It was also discussed that the court granted restitution of 123,956.10. The court has listed The Convention of Original Free Will Baptists as the recipient. The understanding is that those funds are to be forwarded to the Central Conference upon receipt. Reverend Baggett is going to check with Reverend Mark Hobbs, the past President of the Convention of OFWB, and the Dr. David Hines, the current President of the Convention of OFWB, in regard to procuring the funds that the court awarded in relation to this Piney Grove Church case.

Discussion was had in regard to the allocation of the funds from Piney Grove Church. There were multiple ideas discussed:

- The Executive committee is in favor of setting up a \$10,000.00 endowed scholarship fund at the University of Mount Olive for a Central Conference student.
- These funds could be used to fund a possible Campus Ministry work at East Carolina University
- These funds could be used to help Church Planting and Renewal in its efforts to plant new churches.

There was a discussion about assembling a historical document to be shared with our churches and church leaders to address what occurred in the Piney Grove Church that led to its difficult situation. It is to contain some summary information as well as some lessons learned. This is to be written by Reverend Mark Hobbs.

A discussion was had about the 2022 Conference.

- It was recommended that we use the planning of the November 2021 Conference as a starting point for this year's Conference since it had to be canceled.
- The date for the next Conference Meeting is November 10th, 2022.



- The location of the next Conference Meeting is Ormondsville OFWB Church with Elm Grove OFWB Church as a secondary location. Reverend Williamson will check with these churches.
- The recommended theme is: Praying for Laborers for the Harvest, Matthew 9:38
- Conference Speaker: Reverend Harold Jones–Reverend Baggett will check with him.
- The date to mail letters announcing the Conference Meeting as well as registration is the end of September or first of October.
- It was also noted that a Nominating Committee needs to be appointed.

Discussion was had about Campus Ministry Work at East Carolina University. Work had begun in early 2020 but COVID caused this to go on hold. The next step is an information meeting, to be held in late August or early September; the date would be set at the next Executive Committee Meeting. The Executive Committee discussed establishing a board with membership representing Central Conference and Church Planting and Renewal.

Next meeting date: August 4th, 2022; 8:30 am at Stoney Creek OFWB Church

The meeting was adjourned, and Reverend Baggett dismissed us in prayer.

**Central Conference Executive Committee Meeting  
The Pointe at Stoney Creek OFWB Church, Goldsboro  
August 4th, 2022–8:30 AM**

The Executive Committee of the Central Conference met at Stoney Creek OFWB Church.

Those present were the Reverends Barry Williamson, Frankie Baggett, Dale Belvin, and Carlton Oakley.

Reverend Barry Williamson opened the meeting with prayer.

The Treasurer's report was presented by Reverend Williamson as Reverend Malin was still in isolation after undergoing stem cell transplant and Rev Bryan was unable to attend the meeting.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

A follow-up discussion was had about the Piney Grove Church settlement money.

- Reverend Gary Bailey, Director of Convention Services said that settlement funds can be transferred from the Convention of Original Free Will Baptists to the Central Conference when needed.
- The Executive Committee continued prior discussion on establishing an endowed scholarship at the University of Mount Olive.

Reverend Baggett made a motion that we use \$10,000.00 from the Piney Grove Church settlement to establish an endowed scholarship at the University of Mount Olive for a full-time student that is a member of a Central Conference church. The motion passed.

Reverend Williamson will contact the appropriate people at the university to start the process of establishing a scholarship.

The Executive Committee discussed plans for the next meeting of the Central Conference of Original Free Will Baptists.

- Conference Speaker—Reverend Harold Jones has been confirmed.
- Location—Ormondsville OFWB Church
- Theme—"Praying for Laborers for the Harvest"; *"So pray to the Lord who is in charge of the harvest; ask him to send more workers into the fields."* Matthew 9:38, NLT
- Registration letters need to be mailed out. We will also include proposed changes to the Central Conference Constitution. These letters will be mailed out to each ordained minister, church minister, licensed minister, and church clerk within the Central Conference. Reverend Belvin will make sure that this is done completed by the end of September.
- A decision was made to have each Central Conference minister in attendance present to stand and introduce themselves along with stating which church or ministry they served.
- Denominational ministry presentations—We are asking each director to limit their remarks to three minutes. We are hoping to allow each ministry to set up a display for attendees to pick up information. Reverend Belvin will make sure that ministry directors are notified.
- Reverend Belvin will make sure that nametags are available for every pre-registered individual. We will also be working with Reverend Crandall Fountain of the Eastern Conference to continue to provide photo IDs for our ministers.
- Reverend Williamson will coordinate with Reverend Belvin about the musical needs for the Conference. Reverend Belvin will assemble those needed for music at the conference meeting.
- Reverend Williamson will appoint a Parliamentarian, Resolutions Committee, and Nominating Committee.
- Reverend Baggett will prepare a document to share with the Nominating Committee with dates and years of service of all the positions that need to be filled at this year's conference meeting.
- Reverend Oakley will communicate with the Credentials Committee and Memorial Committee in regards to their tasks this year.

The Executive Committee set a date of November 21st at 7:00 pm for an information meeting about plans for a campus ministry at East Carolina University. Reverend Baggett will communicate with First OFWB in Greenville as we would like for the event to be held there.

Next meeting date: September 22nd, 2022; 8:30 am at Ormondsville OFWB Church

The meeting was adjourned and Reverend Belvin dismissed us in prayer.

A discussion was had on the status of the funds from Piney Grove Church. The OFWB Convention office is currently holding the first payment of the funds and will be forwarding those funds to the Central Conference soon. Reverend Haithcock is going to check with Reverends Barry Williamson and Frankie Baggett about the process to this point. The remaining portions of the judgment were due by December 31st, 2022. Reverend Haithcock is going to check on the remaining portions of this judgment.

We would also like to work with those who are currently filling some of those pulpits to become duly ordained ministers of our conference.

A discussion was had on transitioning the registration for the Central Conference from paper registration to digital registration. Reverend Belvin will begin the process of this transition to be ready for the 2023 meeting of the Central Conference.

A motion was made that we pay a \$500.00 honorarium to Reverend Harold Jones for delivering the sermon at the last Central Conference Meeting. The motion was approved.

Next meeting of the Central Conference Executive Committee–May 1st, 9:00 am at LaGrange First OFWB Church.

The meeting was adjourned and Reverend Haithcock dismissed with prayer.
