Minutes of the February 13, 1982 Annual District Conference
Evergreen Free Will Baptist Church, Keith, Texas

The Central Texas District Association of Free Will Baptists met on February 13, 1982 at the Evergreen FWB Church. Bro. Billy Walker was the song leader and Mrs. Lynn Ethel Shaw played the piano. The opening song was "Joy Unspeakable." Bro. A.V. Jennische led in prayer.

After the congregational song "My Savior's Love", Bro. Lee read Psalms 131 and 133 and encouraged us to be in unity. He read the Preamble to the Constitution and Article 8 of the By-Laws.

The Credential Board reported that all sixteen (16) churches were represented by letter with proper dues. The delegates were recognized and seated.

Bro. Herbert Richards, host pastor, expressed a warm and hearty welcome to the people.

A M/S/C to adopt the program with changes to be made if deemed necessary.

The clerk read the minutes of the November meeting. They were approved as read. The treasurer's report was examined and a motion carried to accept it.

The moderator appointed the Resolutions Committee as follows: Bro. Dale Smith, Chairman, Bro. Bobby Ferguson and Bro. Wes Bigelow. Mrs. Ruth Richards, Mrs. Viola Reed and Mrs. Carolyn Yarbrough were appointed to serve on the Obituary Committee with Ruth as chairman.

The clerk read the General Board Report. A M/S/C to receive it and act on it item by item.

1. We recommend that this district go on record as endorsing the resolution passed at the national level in July, 1981 that each Free Will Baptist Church give \$10.00 for dues to the national convention each year. In our case the money shall be sent to the district clerk in February of each year beginning in February, 1983. The clerk shall notify and remind each church in this district each year of this. Carried.

2. We recommend that the Co-op allocation remain the same for 1982. Carried.

3. We recommend that the clerk's salary be increased to \$100.00 and the assistant clerk's to \$25.00 for the year 1982. Carried.

4. We recommend that the projected budget for the district office remain at \$1,200.00 for the year 1982. Carried.

5. We recommend that the General Board be responsible for visiting personally with every pastor and educating him on the advantages of co-operative giving, and offering any and all helps that could be available to help him educate his people

and that the moderator appoint a three (3) person committee to see this through. Carried

The moderator appointed Bro. Johnny Williams, Bro. Dennis Henderson and Bro. Billy Walker to serve on the Co-operative Program Promotion Committee.

The State Executive Secretary, Bro. Allen Moore, gave a report after reading Psalms 34:1-3.

A recess was declared by the moderator.

To open the worship hour Bro. Walker led the congregation in singing "Victory In Jesus." Bro. Kurt Hoch led in prayer and then the hymn "The Solid Rock" was sung. Bro. Charles Denman & Ed Morris received the morning offering. A prayer of thanksgiving was prayed by Bro. Morris. An offering in the amount of \$100.00 was received.

Special music was brought by Ruth Richards, Sharie Surface and Rita McDuffie. They sang "I Bowed on My Knees and Cried Holy."

Bro. Buzz Bird, pastor of Bright Light Free Will Baptist church, was the messenger of God's Word during the hour. He read passages of scripture from I John 3 and John 14 & 15. He pointed out that if we expect our prayers to be answered then we must keep God's commandments. He opened and closed his sermon with prayer. "Near the Cross" was sung as an invitational song.

Bro. Herbert Richards gave instructions for the noon meal and asked God's blessings on the food.

The afternoon session was opened with the song "I Am Thine, O Lord" after which Bro. Sanford Davis led in prayer.

Bro. Buzz Bird gave the Christian Education Board Report. They expressed a desire to offer thirty to forty minute workshops or seminars at 9:00 on quarterly meeting days. A mmc to accept the report.

The Home Mission Board Report by Verlan Pegues was accepted.

The Board of Trustees gave a brief verbal report.

Bro. Wes Bigelow reported for the Camp Board and a motion carried to accept. Verlan Pegues presented a written report of the financial standing of the Camp Board. A mmc to accept it.

A motion was made and carried that each church send \$100.00 to the camp board ear marked for the construction of a cement slab. The board was instructed to spend the ear marked money for the purpose intended.

Mr. A.V. Jennische gave the Student Loan Board Report and a motion carried to accept.

The moderator read a report sent by Bro. Johnny Williams for the Board of Retirement and Insurance. He requested that the churches in our district give their fifth Sunday offerings to the Retirement & Insurance program because of the lack of support for this in the past. A mmc to accept the report.

Rita McDuffie gave an oral report of the District Woman's Auxiliary which was received as information.

Sharie Surface sang a beautiful old song, "It's Bound To Be The Lord" accompanied by Mrs. Florence Rice.

Bro. Billy Walker shared the highlights of the National Leaders Conference with us. He promoted co-operative giving and gave examples of how effective the co-operative program can be.

Bro. Charles Denman reported for the Master's Men and asked for volunteers to help in the national as either an usher or with security. He announced a Master's Men Retreat for March 19-20, at the camp ground. M/S/C to receive the report as information.

The Credential Board gave their final report. A mmc to receive the report and act on it item by item.

1. We recommend that Rev. Keith Phipps be granted a letter of recommendation to the East Texas District. Carried.

2. We recommend that Bro. Kurt Hoch be granted license for another year. Carried.

3. We have received a letter of recommendation from the West Fork District for Rev. Clyde Gillentine. Accepted.

The Resolution Committee had only one resolution and that was that we give the host church a rising vote of thanks for their hospitality and good food. Carried.

The Obituary Committee reported that seven (7) members of our district have departed this world and asked that we have prayer for the families left behind. A mmc to accept the report.

Bro. Herbert Richards read the Nominating Committee's report and a mmc to receive it and act on it office by office. The following officers and board members were elected:

CENTRAL DISTRICT CAMP BOARD

February 13, 1982

TO: Central Texas District

REF: Camp Ground Improvements

The camp board is recommending the following camp ground improvements:

1. That a concrete slab measuring 30ft. X 70ft. be built at a location on the camp grounds to be determined by the camp board.
2. The purpose of such a slab would be three fold. It will serve as a basketball court, a volley ball court and a tennis court. It could also serve for other camp activities.
3. That the labor be provided by the men of the district and the following dates be set aside for construction of the slab.
 - a. Saturday, April 24th, Build the forms and prepare the ground for pouring the concrete.
 - b. Saturday, May 1st, pour the concrete.Auxiliary ladies will be asked to take food for each work day.
4. That the necessary funds be raised by the churches in the district and sent to the District Office (Rita McDuffie) no later than May 1, 1982.
 - a. The estimated cost of materials is \$1,500.00
 - b. The District Woman's Auxiliary is in the process of raising \$500.00 to go toward the slab.
 - c. It is being requested that each church in the district send \$100.00 to this youth camp project.
5. Request is also being made for materials that someone may have in the district and would like to donate them to the camp for the building of the forms. We will need:
 - a. 2 x 4's and 2 x 6's
 - b. 3 rolls of 6in. x 6in. wire mesh (any gauge)

Your consideration and positive action on this recommendation will be greatly appreciated by the youth of our district.
