ANNUAL MINUTES

The Central Texas District Association of Free Will Baptists met for the annual meeting at the Fellowship Free Will Baptist Church on February 12, 1983. The music director for the day, M^{rs} Klunkert, led the congregation in "Onward Christian Soldiers" accompanied on the piano by Mrs. Toni Desern and the organ by Mrs. Joy Jones. Verlan Pegues led in prayer. The congregation then sang "Trust and Obey."

The moderator, Mr. Raymond Lee, called the meeting to order and read Romans 8:28-34.

Bro. Herbert Richards gave a partial report of the Credential Board and a mmc to accept it and seat the delegates.

Bro. Bill Jones, host pastor, extended a hearty welcome.

A mmc to adopt the program giving the moderator the power to change the order of the program as deemed necessary.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read by the clerk. They were approved as read.

The treasurers report was examined and a mmc to accept the report as presented.

The moderator appointed the following two committees:

Resolutions -- Bro. Dale Smith, Bro. Gary Tune and Bro. Mike Mize
Obituary -- Mrs. Everyl Getz, Mrs. Margaret Richards and Mrs. Geneva Walker

Mr. Raymond Lee reported on the state work for our State Executive Secretary, Bro. Allen Moore, who was unable to attend the meeting because of illness.

The clerk read the General Board Report. A mmc to accept the report and act on it item by item.

1. That the mileage rate increase from 12¢ to 14¢ per mile. Carried.
2. That the clerk's salary remain at \$100.00 for the year 1983. Carried.
3. That the assistant or assisting clerk be given \$10.00 each quarter. Carried.
4. That the deed for the Cedars of Lebanon church property be transferred from the Central Texas District to the Cedars of Lebanon Free Will Baptist Church. Carried.
5. That the Coop allocation for 1983 be as follows:
 - 50% State Office
 - 30% Camp
 - 15% Retirement & Insurance
 - 5% District Office ----Carried.
6. That the Christian Education Board send out to the churches a monthly newsletter sharing their calendar of events. Carried.
7. That CTS competitive activities be designated as part of the duties of the District Christian Education Board. Carried.

Mr. A.V. Jennische gave a partial report of the Nominating Committee. A mmc to accept the partial report and elect the board members as each board report is given.

Mr. Verlan Pegues gave a report on Home Missions. A mmc to receive the report. Mr. Verlan Pegues was the nominating committee's choice for re-election to the District Home Mission Board. A mmc that nominations cease and elect him by acclamation.

The moderator declared a recess.

Mr. Ma~~tt~~ Klunkert led the congregation in singing "Look and Live" and "I Am Thine, O Lord." Bro. Wes Bigelow led in prayer. The song "I Must Tell Jesus" was sung.

Bro. Billy Walker called for the offering and prayed the offertory prayer. An offering in the amount of \$111.67 was received.

Special music was by Peggy Henderson and Beverly Newman accompanied by Kathy Childress. They sang a beautiful song entitled "Give Him All the Praise."

Bro. Billy Walker introduced the speaker, Bro. Bill Jones. Bro. Jones asked Dale and Kathy Norrid to sing "The Brush Arbor Meeting" without music to show a contrast between the song service many years ago and our modern day services. He then read Acts 4:13 & 31-33 and spoke on unity in Christ. He closed his message with prayer.

The pastor of the church, Bro. Bill Jones, gave instructions for the noon meal. Bro. Dale Smith dismissed the service with prayer and asked God's blessings on the food.

The afternoon session began with the congregation singing "When We All Get To Heaven."

Bro. Wes Bigelow gave an oral camp board report stating that teen camp will be June 20-24 and junior camp will be June 27-July 1. A mmc to accept the oral report with the understanding of getting a written report to the clerk as soon as possible. The nominating committee submitted Bro. Raymond Getz's name to replace himself on the Camp Board. A mmc to elect him by acclamation.

Mr. Ed Morris reported on the District Retirement and Insurance program and encouraged the people to get behind this important phase of our work and support it financially. A mmc to receive the report. The nominating committee recommended Mr. Ed Morris for the Retirement & Insurance Chairman for the year 1983. A mmc to elect him by acclamation.

Mr. A.V. Jennische gave the Student Loan Board report. A mmc to accept the report as given. Another motion was also made and carried to re-elect Mr. Jennische to serve on the Student Loan Board.

Mr. Estal Lewis, representing the Board of Trustees, gave an oral report. Mr. James Ray Trant was re-elected on the Board of Trustees to serve until 1989.

The Master's Men Report was given by Mr. Fred Dollar and received as information.

Judy Smith reported on the Woman's Auxiliary work and her report was received as information.

Bro. Dale Smith gave the Christian Education Board Report and encouraged the churches to send in events and activities of the local church to him to be included in the Christian Education Board Newsletter. A mmc to accept his report. The nominating committee recommended Bro. Mike Mize for the vacancy on the Christian Education Board and he was elected.

Bro. Dale Smith gave the Resolutions Committee Report and a mmc to receive it and act on it item by item.

1. Whereas, there is not a definitive statement detailing the place the wife of a deceased minister or deacon holds in the Association; Be it resolved that a wife of either a deceased pastor or deacon who is a member of a church in the district shall retain her position as a standing delegate at each Associational Meeting. Be it resolved as well that this statement be placed as Article fifteen (15) in the Associational By-Laws. A mmc to table until the May meeting.
2. Whereas, presently all monies received for Home Missions is sent along for state projects, be it resolved that 50% of all undesignated money given to Home Missions be retained within the district. Resolution carried.
3. Whereas, efforts outside of the Christian faith are attempting to deride and destroy our Christian liberties guaranteed by the Constitution of the United States and presently being championed by atheistic influences: Be it resolved that the pastors and willing members of each congregation in the district draft a letter encouraging Rev. Jerry Falwell to continue his efforts in representing our scriptural concerns. Carried.
4. Be it resolved that we give the host church a rising vote of thanks for the delicious meal and warm hospitality. Carried.

A prayer request was made for the Eastside and Pine Prairie churches who are seeking pastors.

The Obituary Report was given by Everyl Getz. She asked that we stand in memory of those who have gone on and called on Bro. Everett Hellard to lead in prayer.

Bro. Herbert Richards had little to report on the Blue Lake Church building project to get the building moved to the camp grounds and repaired and requested prayer that this work may be accomplished soon.

The body voted to go to Conroe for the meeting in August.

Bro. Raymond Lee wished all the ladies a Happy Valentine's Day.

A standing vote of thanks was given to the Billy Walker family for their contributions to our district for the past six years or so.

Bro. Lee informed the congregation of the check for \$1,000.00 that the Cedars of Lebanon Church presented to the district in appreciation of the district's help in getting their church where it is today. A suggestion

was made that the clerk send a letter of appreciation to Bro. Bill Zamora and his church for the gift.

A mmc that the Camp Board decide upon a name for the youth camp so that a sign may be erected.

Bro. Billy Walker requested prayer for himself and his family as they go to their new work at the Grand Prairie Free Will Baptist Church.

The Credential Board gave a final report. A mmc to receive it and act on it item by item.

1. That a letter of recommendation be sent for Rev. Gary Riley to Missouri. Carried.
2. That Bro. Dan Harmon of the First Houston FWB Church be licensed to preach for one (1) year. Carried.
3. That a letter of recommendation for Rev. Billy Walker be granted to the West Fork District. Carried.
4. That a letter of recommendation be granted for Rev. Buzz Bird to the Linneus FWB Church in Holton, Maine. Carried.
5. That we accept the return of Steve Kelly's license as he left the denomination. Carried.
6. That we recommend to the North West Brazos Association because of Mike Kirk's failure to complete the proper questionnaire and his failure to appear before the Ordaining Council, we can only recommend him as a character reference, and that we suggest the North West Brazos Ordaining Council examine him for ordination. Carried.
7. That the Faith Free Will Baptist Church be accepted into the full fellowship of the Central Texas District. Carried.

Bro. Dennis Henderson was elected to replace Mr. Charles Denman on the Ordaining Council.

A mmc to accept the balance of the Nominating Committee's Report and complete the election of officers. The following officers were elected to serve for one year:
