ANNUAL MINUTES
February 8, 1986

The Central Texas District Association of Free Will Baptists met at the United FWB Church, Bryan, Texas on February 8, 1986 for the annual conference.

The meeting was opened with a few vocal selections by the Harvester Quartet from Hillsdale Free Will Baptist College in Moore, Oklahoma.

Bro. Bill Fulcher led in prayer.

Bro. Bill Jones, moderator, called the meeting to order. He read the Preamble and Article VIII of the By-Laws.

Michael Hoggard, a member of the Harvesters, led the congregation in singing "Revive Us Again" accompanied at the piano by Lynette Brown and at the organ by Bonnie Farquar.

Bro. Bobby Ferguson gave a partial report of the Credential Board reporting that nine churches were represented by letter at this time. A mmc to receive his report and seat the delegates.

Bro. Frank Cope, host pastor, extended a hearty welcome to the group present for this meeting.

A mmc to adopt the program with any necessary changes that may arise during the day.

The clerk read the minutes and with no changes stood approved as read. A mmc to accept the treasurer's report as presented.

The moderator appointed Bro. Paul Dean, Bro. Clyde Eldridge and Bro. Wesley Bigelow to serve on the Resolutions Committee. The Obituary Committee was appointed as follows: Judy Smith, Marsha Lightsey and Betty Cope.

Rita McDuffie read the minutes of the General Board Meeting. A mmc to accept and act on each item as respective reports are given. Two items for consideration at this time were:

1. This board recommends that the Coop breakdown remain the same for 1986. Carried.
2. We recommend that the clerk's salary increase to \$250.00 for this year and the assisting clerk's fee remain at \$10.00 per meeting. Carried.

Dr. N.R. Smith reported on Hillsdale College and made several announcements concerning their activities.

Judy Smith, missionary to Japan, was a visitor in our meeting and spoke a few words of greeting and gave her testimony.

The report from our State Executive Secretary was next. Bro. Billy Walker reported that the churches throughout the state gave a record amount during January, 1986. A total of \$22,369.20 was sent through his office that month. The State Office General Fund, however, is still suffering and he asked for prayer concerning this matter. State Meeting dates were changed to June 11-13 and will be held at First Henderson FWB Church in Henderson, Texas. He reported that the Tyler work is doing great.

Bro. Raymond Getz prayed the dismissal prayer for recess.

The worship hour began with a congregational song "When We All Get to Heaven." Fred Marberry led in prayer. The Harvesters sang beautiful arrangements of three songs.

A record offering in the amount of \$101.71 was received by the ushers with Ed Morris praying the offertory prayer.

The moderator introduced the speaker, Bro. Edwin Wade, a man of God and President of Hillsdale FWB College. The Harvesters sang another beautiful song entitled "I Am Coming to the Cross." Bro. Wade read II Timothy 3:13-17 and brought a message on "God's Word is a Worthy Possession." Three important challenges were given as follows:

1. Accept the Word of God as authoritative.
2. Saturate your mind with knowledge of it.
3. Develop an attitude of submission to it.

Bro. Frank Cope gave instructions for the noon meal and Bro. Wes Bigelow asked God's Blessings on the food.

After a delicious lunch and fellowship the afternoon session opened with a song, "Love Lifted Me" led by Bro. Bobby Ferguson. Bro. Dennis Henderson led in prayer.

The Master's Men Report given by Raymond Lee and the Woman's Auxiliary Report by Everyl Getz were received as information.

A partial report of the Nominating Committee was given by Bro. Raymond Getz. A mmc to receive the report with each board member being elected as the respective board reports are given.

A.V. Jennische gave the Student Loan Board Report. A mmc to accept the report. Mr. Jennische was reelected to the Student Loan Board.

Everyl Getz reported for the Christian Education Board. The General Board recommendation was read to have the CTS District Competition the Saturday preceding the May District Meeting this year which will be May 3. A mmc to receive the report and act on the recommendation. A mmc in favor of the recommendation. Wesley Bigelow was elected to fill the unexpired term of one year on the Christian Education Board vacated by Dr. J.D. O'Donnell.

Bro. Raymond Getz reported for the Home Mission Board. He gave a financial report and reported that the Bonami Church has not legally been placed in the District's possession yet due to lack of available time to make the transaction, however the matter will be handled. A mmc to accept the report. Bro. Bill Fulcher was elected to fill the vacancy on the board.

Bro. Paul Morris gave an oral report from the Board of Trustees. A mmc to accept.

Ed Morris gave a report from the Retirement & Insurance Board reading at this time a recommendation from the General Board to increase retirees' benefits to \$65.00 a month. A mmc to accept the report and the recommendation. Mr. Morris was reelected to serve another year on this board.

Danny Davis gave the Camp Board Report. A mmc to accept. Mike Anderson was elected to replace Raymond Getz on this board.

Bro. Paul Dean reported for the Resolutions Committee. A mmc to receive the report and act on it item by item.

1. Be it resolved that we extend a rising vote of thanks to Raymond Lee for his years of service to this district. Carried.
2. We resolve that this district send \$50.00 to Hillsdale and \$50.00 to Judy Smith. A substitute motion was made and carried to increase the gift to \$100.00 for each. The resolution carried as ammended.
3. That Bro. Edwin Wade receive from the district an honorarium of \$50.00. Carried. Upon request of Bro. Wade the body agreed to send the honorarium intended for him to Judy Smith and Ernest Holland--\$25.00 to each.
4. That we extend a rising vote of thanks to the United Church for the hospitality shown us today. Carried.

The Ordaining Council had nothing to report at this time. Bro. Dennis Henderson was re-elected to serve on this board.

Judy Smith gave the Obituary Report. She read a portion of scripture from Titus and called on Bro. Dennis Henderson to pray following a moment of silent prayer.

Under new business a mmc that the District Executive Committee study carefully the project, Target 90, promoted by the National and report back at the May District Meeting concerning our district's involvement in that project.

Bro. Raymond Getz gave the final report of the Nominating Committee. A mmc to accept the final portion of the report and act on it office by office. The following officers were elected for one year:
