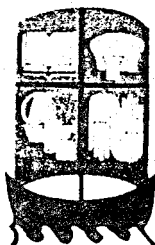

ANNUAL MINUTES  
February 14, 1987

The annual conference of the Central Texas District Association of Free Will Baptists met at the First Bryan FWB Church on February 14, 1987.

The music director was Mike Newman accompanied on the piano by Kemper Combs and the organ by Nancy Matus. Mike led the congregational song "Heaven Came Down" to open the service. Bro. Frank Cope led in prayer.

The moderator read the Preamble of the Constitution and Article VIII of the By-Laws.

The Hillsdale Crusaders Quartet was introduced and they sang "Jesus Is Mine" and "My Child, We're Going Home". Members of the quartet are Craig Shaw, Doug Christian, Todd Campbell and Kemper Combs. Kemper accompanied them at the piano. Bro. Thomas Marberry promoted Hillsdale.

A partial report of the Credential Board was given by Bro. Herbert Richards. Fourteen churches were represented by letter with proper dues at this time. A mmc to receive the report and seat the delegates.

Bro. Dennis Henderson, host Pastor, extended a hearty welcome.

A mmc to adopt the program with any necessary changes throughout the day.

The clerk read the minutes of the November meeting and they were approved as read. The treasurer's report was examined and a mmc to accept it as presented.

The Assistant Moderator appointed the following committees: Resolutions- Bill Fulcher, Chrmn.; Sam Clements and Tanya Dean..Obituary- Linda Clements, Margaret Richards and Ruth Jennische.

The clerk read the General Board Report. A mmc to receive the report and act on it item by item.

1. We recommend that we budget a total of \$3,500 to the Retirement & Insurance general fund for 1987. This will enable us to support one additional recipient. In order to support this budget it would require each church in the district to increase their giving to the general fund by approximately \$2.00 per week. Carried.
2. We recommend that the Coop allocations remain the same. Carried.
3. We recommend that the clerk's appreciation fee be increased from \$250 to \$300 and that the assisting clerk's fee remain at \$10 per meeting. Carried.

The moderator invited Dwain Crosby, a Texas Foreign Missionary appointee to Japan, to speak. He shared with us his convictions and desires concerning this ministry in preparation for Japan.

The meeting was dismissed with prayer by Bro. Herbert Richards for a 15 minute recess.

The worship hour was opened with a congregational song, "Jesus Saves." Bro. Bill Fulcher led in prayer. Another song, "Wonderful Grace of Jesus" was sung.

Bro. Raymond Getz and Boyd Gray were ushers and received an offering in the

amount of \$57.50. Bro. Getz prayed the offertory prayer.

Beverly Newman sang a beautiful song, "There Is A Saviour", as special music.

The speaker for the worship hour was host pastor, Bro. Dennis Henderson, who has been in our district for the past 10 years. He read Mark 10:17-23 as his text and gave reference to several other scripture verses. He spoke of the value system of the world today and illustrated our need for acceptance, significance and security. He reminded us that only Christ can fill our cup and we can't focus on people to do that. He closed his message with prayer.

Bro. Dennis made announcements for the noon meal. Charles Denman asked God's blessings on the food and fellowship.

After a delicious lunch the afternoon session opened with a congregational song. Bob Welker led in prayer. The quartet sang "The Walls Came Tumbling Down" and "Beulah Land." Thomas Marberry announced the Texas Teen Retreat at the Whispering Pines Encampment near Henderson, Texas and encouraged the youth to attend along with their sponsors.

Bro. Frank Cope, chairman of the Nominating Committee, gave a report. A mmc to accept the report. The executive officers were elected at this time as follows:

Parliamentarian--Bro. Eugene Richards  
Board members are to be elected as each board report is given.

Ret. + Ins. Bro. Bobby Ferguson reported on the state work. He stated that the Longview Church is no more in existence and that negotiations are underway to try to reach some kind of settlement to take care of the state's indebtedness to the National Home Mission Board. The state meeting will be on June 17-19 at the Odessa Hilton. Bro. Frank Cope reported on the finances of the state office.

A.V. Jennische and Charles Denman gave the Master's Men Report and announced that their Annual District Master's Men Conference will be at Carlos on March 20-21. Speakers are to be Bill Fulcher, Bill Jones, James Munsey and James Vallance.

Everyl Getz reported for the District Woman's Auxiliary. She announced the Retreat dates in April at Carlos and the State Auxiliary Meeting in Odessa on June 18.

The Student Loan Board Report was given by A.V. Jennische. Bob Welker was elected to serve as a board member until 1990.

The Christian Education Board Report was given by Everyl Getz. She announced that District CTS Competition will be held on May 2, 1987 at the Fellowship Church. Registration will begin at 9:00 A.M. and competition begins at 10:00. She also promoted the Texas Teen Retreat sponsored by the State Board of Christian Education and Hillsdale College on April 3-4. The new Christian Education Board member elected at this time for a six year term was Marsha Lightsey.

Bro. Raymond Getz reported for the District Home Mission Board. A mmc to receive the report and act on the recommendations from the board.

1. We recommend that the District Home Mission Board be authorized to negotiate the potential sale of the Cedars of Lebanon property with the present tenants. Carried.

2. We recommend that a gift Deed of the property of the Bonami Free Will Baptist Church in Kirbyville be accepted by the Central Texas District of Free Will Baptists, if one can be negotiated. Carried.  
The board member elected at this time for a three year term was Bro. Frank Cope.

The report of the Board of Trustees was given by Bro. Paul Morris. He was re-elected to this office.

Ed Morris gave the Retirement & Insurance Report. He succeeded himself in this office for another year.

Danny Davis gave a Camp Board Report. The board recommended the sale of the camp grounds. A mmc to give the board the authority to negotiate the sale or trade of the camp property. Workdays are scheduled for the three Saturdays following the quarterly meeting in May. Camp dates were changed to avoid a conflict with State Meeting dates. Teen camp will be May 31-June 5 with Bro. Wes Bigelow as director. Junior camp will be June 7-12 with Bro. Raymond Getz as director. Danny Davis succeeded himself as a camp board member.

Bro. Bill Fulcher gave the Resolutions Committee Report. A mmc to receive it and act on it item by item.

1. We resolve to give an honorarium of \$150.00 to Bro. Crosby and \$150.00 to Hillsdale College. Carried.
2. We resolve to give \$10.00 per quarter to each of our Texas Foreign Missions. Carried.
3. We resolve to encourage all our churches to call Missions Hot Line on a regular basis. Carried.
4. We resolve that we give a standing vote of thanks to our host church for the good meal and hospitality. Carried.

Bro. Herbert Richards gave the final report from the Credential Board. A mmc to receive the report and act on the recommendation presented.

1. We recommend that Rev. Kenneth Wilson be granted a letter of good standing from the Central Texas District to the Northern Quarterly of the Cumberland Association. Carried.
  2. Lighthouse Free Will Baptist Church requested that Bro. Roger Yates be examined for license. Due to the fact that he was unable to be at the meeting, we will have to postpone any action for the present.
- Bro. Herbert Richards succeeded himself on the board.

Linda Clements gave the Obituary Report. The congregation stood in memory of those who died in 1986. Bro. Bobby Ferguson led in prayer.

Under new business a mmc that the district give \$100.00 to Bro. Bill Fulcher's account.

A request was received from the Pine Prairie Church for the August Convention. A mmc to accept.

Bro. Bobby presented a certificate from the District to Mrs. Ruby Maxwell in appreciation for her faithful service as a Sunday School Secretary for over 45 years at the Evergreen FWB Church.

A mmc to adjourn. Bro. Wes Bigelow dismissed with prayer.

GENERAL BOARD MINUTES  
JANUARY 10, 1987

The moderator called on Bro. Herbert Richards to open the meeting with prayer. The meeting was held at the Fellowship FWB church.

Members present were: Bro. Bobby Ferguson, Rita McDuffie, Charles Denman, A.V. Jennische, Bro. Paul Dean, Bro. Wes Bigelow, Danny Davis, Bro. Eugene Richards, Ed Morris, Bro. Paul Morris, Ken Mayo, Bro. Dennis Henderson, Bro. Frank Cope, Bro. Bill Fulcher and Bro. Herbert Richards. Bro. Bill Jones, host pastor, was a visitor.

The moderator read Mark 11:22 & 23 and stressed the importance of Faith in God.

The Student Loan Board Report was given by A.V. Jennische. He reported that the Board has had little success in the past years collecting the outstanding notes totaling over \$6,000.00. A mmc that the moderator, clerk and Mr. Jennische compose a letter to be sent to those who have outstanding loans in an attempt to clear up this matter.

Bro. Wes Bigelow reported for the Christian Education Board. He announced their plans to have some preliminary competition between competitors in different churches before the actual district competition on May 2, 1987.

The Home Mission Board Report was given by Bro. Bill Fulcher. He reported that Bro. Roger Yates is now pastoring the Lighthouse FWB Church in Temple. There was some discussion concerning the failure of the people who are renting the Cedars of Lebanon Church and parsonage to come up with the rent money for the past few months. No action was taken at this time. Bro. Bobby Ferguson shared with us a very real possibility of the First Houston FWB Church sponsoring a Church Extension Program and organizing a church in West Houston. A mmc that the Home Mission Board, Bro. Mayo and Bro. Ferguson meet and plan such a work and bring their plans back to present to the District at the May Meeting, seeking endorsement of their actions with prayer and financial support.

The Ordaining Council Report was given by Bro. Herbert Richards.

Bro. Paul Morris gave a short oral report from the Board of Trustees.

The Camp Board Report was given by Danny Davis. He reported that their budget is tight and encouraged the pastors present to encourage their people to continue to give financially to maintain the camp. No action had been taken toward the sale of the camp property at this time. They are waiting for the appraiser to look at the land and make an offer. In the meantime, maintenance of the property is our responsibility. The Board is considering a work month instead of a work day to get the property ready for camp again this year.

Ed Morris gave a written report of the Retirement and Insurance Board. A mmc that we receive the report and act on the item for consideration. A mmc to present the following recommendation to the District for action: I recommend that we budget a total of \$3,500 to the general fund for 1987. This will enable us to support one additional recipient. In order to support this budget it would require each church in the district to increase their giving to the general

fund by approximately \$2.00 per week.

A mmc to recommend that the Coop allocations remain the same.

A mmc to recommend that the clerk's appreciation fee be increased from \$250 to \$300 and that the assisting clerk's fee remain at \$10.00 per meeting.

A mmc that the District present Mrs. Ruby Maxwell a certificate of appreciation for her dedication as Evergreen's Sunday School Secretary for over 45 years at the February Meeting.

Bro. Frank Cope dismissed in prayer remembering Amy Robinson, Molly Barker, Archie Mayhew and Edwin Wade.
