**Proceedings of the 74th Annual Session  
of the  
Cumberland District Women Active For Christ Convention**

One hundred-six women from 23 local auxiliaries met August 27, 1994, for the 74th annual Cumberland District Women Active for Christ Convention at Good Springs Free Will Baptist Church, Pleasant View, Tennessee. The convention theme was "The Bible: Light on the Way," with Psalm 119:105 as the scripture text.

President Carolyn Lane opened the meeting and introduced Beverly Parks from the Good Springs Auxiliary, who led the congregational singing for the day's activities. Opening songs included "This is the Day" and "I Want to be a Worker." Susan Winchester accompanied on the piano and Gayle England on the organ.

Good Springs auxiliary president Linda Ellis welcomed the attendees to the church and meeting. Anne Worthington's response included Lamentations 3:22-23. She then led in prayer.

Windy Hunter blessed hearts with her special, "The Mission." The offering was received, after which the Hunter Sisters Trio sang "Let the Lower Lights Be Burning."

Carolyn Lane introduced Rhoda Creech, missionary to Cote d'Ivoire, who spoke using the theme "The Bible: Light on the Way." She reminded us that if Cote d'Ivoire had Light Free Will Baptist missionaries would not be there. Free Will Baptists are there to show them the Light.

Two other missionary wives, Linda Snow and Judy Bailey, brought greetings from the field of Japan. Linda briefly shared hers and Nathan's work in the school there and of their plans to return after completing required mission courses. Judy shared some of the needs on the field.

The business session began with the president appointing the following committees:

Anne Worthington gave the TWAC (Tennessee Women Active for Christ) report. She reported a total of 64 registered for the 48th annual convention, November 9, 1993 at Grace Free Will Baptist Church, Memphis, Tennessee. Missionaries to Panama Stan and Brenda Bunch developed the theme, "Throw Out the Life-Line," with the scripture taken from Luke 10b. Delegates endorsed the plan of work, adopting the state project of \$2,500 for the West Knoxville Mission building fund.

Anne encouraged all to attend the September 21-23, 1995 TWAC retreat at the River Terrace Hotel, Gatlinburg, and the 49th annual TWAC convention, November 15th at Oak Ridge.

Dr. Mary Wisehart gave the following WNAC (Women Nationally Active for Christ) report: Magazine. Your state gets 1077 subscriptions of Co-Laborer. Due to increases in postage, the price of the magazine will increase in 1996.

Local Auxiliaries and Membership. Your state had 47 groups with 921 members according to the 1994 report and no Actionette groups. The reports show Tennessee losing 592 members. Most of this loss is due to the increase in dues.

Finances. Tennessee has always been great at supporting the national work. In 1993 you gave \$11,241.08 to the national office. Of that amount, \$7,001.39 came in through the Co-Laborer Offering, \$3,625.60 was Emphasis Month Offerings, \$400 went to the Endowment Fund, and \$214.09 went for the furniture. Tennessee gave a total of \$39,453.66 through WNAC in 1993.

New Developments. We are looking forward to a new manual and a 1996 yearbook. I hope to have them ready by the 1995 convention. We are also looking for a new logo to go with our name. Feel free to send in a suggestion or a sketch.

Convention 1995. We're looking forward to the National Convention in Charlotte, North Carolina, July 17-18. Your state may have 15 delegates, plus the president and field worker. Each local group may send one delegate with a \$5 fee.

Retreats. We're looking forward to our eighth National Retreat at Ridgecrest Conference Center in North Carolina September 15-17, 1994 and an exciting new retreat west of the Mississippi, October 20-22, 1995 at Glorieta, New Mexico.

The morning session recessed with prayer at 11:15 for lunch and committee meetings.

The convention reconvened at 12:30 with Bev Parks leading the congregation in singing "Trust and Obey." Jill Kettelman then gave an inspiring reading entitled "Slave Ship Captain Changes His Course."

Nellie Cunningham led a very meaningful memorial service in memory of deceased auxiliary members Pearl Seay, Sarah Carney and Evelyn Hersey. She led in prayer.

District Recording Secretary Barbara Nicholson gave the credentials report. A motion was made, seconded and carried (MSC) to receive the report and seat the delegates (see reports).

Barbara also gave the following secretary's report: CDWAC has 28 auxiliaries, with a total of 342 members paying dues. The report showed a decrease of 68 members and the loss of two auxiliaries. MSC to accept the report.

Vice President Jill Kettelman gave the registration committee report. MSC to receive report (see reports).

Anne Worthington gave the resolutions committee report. MSC to receive the report and to vote item by item. All motions carried (see reports).

The scrapbook committee reported. MSC to receive the report (see reports).

CDWA Treasurer June Wilkinson gave the treasurer's and finance committee's reports. She reported that 348 members representing 28 auxiliaries had paid dues. MSC to accept both reports (see reports). June then read her letter of resignation stating personal reasons.

The floor was then opened for new business. Carolyn Lane reported that since the Executive Committee has the power to replace officers during a term of office, Anne Worthington will replace Barbara Nicholson as district secretary, and Barbara Nicholson will replace June Wilkinson as district treasurer. The floor was then opened for nominations for someone to serve as Mission Action Chairman. Since there were no nominations, the Executive Committee will look for someone to fill the position.

In further new business the following nominating committee was nominated from the floor: Elizabeth Hodges, Cleo Purcell and Maxine Wagner.

A motion was made, seconded and carried to have the Executive Committee look into the feasibility of setting an earlier starting time for the convention, with the intention of finishing at the noon hour or shortly thereafter.

President Carolyn Lane raised the question of whether to continue the scrapbook competition. She encouraged each auxiliary to get involved, reminding us of the blessing the scrapbooks will bring in the future.

In final business the following were appointed as delegates to the TWAC in Oak Ridge, November 15th: Maxine Wagner, Deborah St. Lawrence, Temisia Brown, Delois Loveless, Marge Workman and Laura Beem.

In closing, Rhoda Creech expressed appreciation for the gift to hers and Paul's account, her personal gift and the promise of monthly support for the next year.

Dr. Wisehart also expressed gratitude for the continued support from the Cumberland District.

There being no further business, Barbara Nicholson dismissed the meeting with prayer.
