Minutes of the May session were read and approved. Letters from the eight churches were read. MSC to adopt the reports and seat the delegates.

Committees named were: Pulpit, Jeanne Cullis, Phyllis Boggs, and Jola Henry.

Business Committee vacancies filled for today by Claude Hampleman and Bob Stone in the absence of John Hiltibild and Howard Flota.

Treasurer's report was given by George Waggoner showing a balance of \$273.17. MSC to receive it.

MSC to take the three items from table concerning Constitutional changes and place them before the body for consideration. After explanation and discussion MSC to adopt all three items. (See May minutes for details)

MSC to empower treasurer to purchase and present

Awards to contest winners for the 1972
Boost the Attendance Campaign. Pleasant View
 is to get a "Large Bible and Stand" with cost
 of about \$75. Oak Valley is to get a "Large framed
 Church Covenant" with approximate cost of \$35⁰⁰.

Moderator declared a recess at about 10:20 A.M.

Business reconvened at 10:40 and Jeanne Culli
 gave a report of plans for the Friday night
 youth activities for future quarters. Jim
 Hayes is to plan the November program at
 Pleasant View.

Budget Committee report: "We the budget Committee
 recommend Rev. John Hiltibidol to be the speaker
 at the Nov. meeting." S/Committee MSC

Business Committee report: "We the Business Committee
 recommend that Constitution and By Laws be changed
 to read 'East Central District Meetings' instead of 'East
 Central Quarterly Meeting' in all places." S/Committee
MSC to table this recommendation.

The moderator appointed Leslie Elliott, Ed Wheder, and
 Raymond Capps on the nominating Committee for
 officers and board or Committee members which will
 be elected in November.

MSC to elect George Capps as moderator.
 MSC to elect George Woggoner as assistant moderator.

Moderator declared business session adjourned.

The fifty sixth session of the E. Central Quarterly Convened at Pleasant View Church. The Friday night services attended by people from Pleasant View and Speaker Bro. Larry Clyatt and family. Bro. Tim Hayes gave a resume of Thanksgiving from the beginning. Testimony meeting was led by Mary Lou Hittlidal. Brother Clyatt spoke a message on Thanksgiving. Refreshments were served in the basement of the church.

Saturday morning the meeting was called to order by the Moderator at 9 o'clock. Bro. George W. Waggoner led the congregation in a short time of meditation then in singing "What a Friend we have in Jesus". Sister Aileen Waggoner played the piano. Bro. Jimmy Hicks led in prayer. Devotions were given by Bro. James Boggs from the 12 Chapter of Hebrews 1-2 verses. Minutes were read and declared accepted. Church letters were read and Bro. J. W. Hittlidal made the motion to accept the letters and to seat the delegates, viz. Bro. Georg Waggoner, Bro. Jimmy Hicks and Bro. Larry Cook was appointed on the Examining Board to take the place of those absent.

Bros Thomas Marlow and Bob Stone were to take the place of the Moderator and Bro. I. I. I. on the Business Committee with Bro. J. W. Hiltbush, Sis. Grace Bruce, Sherry Wheeler and Aileen Waggoner were appointed on the pulpit Committee. Bro. George Waggoner asked for an Auditing Committee to audit the treasurers books. ~~after giving~~ Moderator asked the business Committee to audit the books.

After about three motions to take the motion from the table from the last meeting ~~concerning~~ Changing the name from the East Central Quarterly to the East Central District meeting it was seconded and Carried.

J. W. Hiltbush made the motion to adapt it. Msc.

Bro George W. Waggoner made the motion to Notify the State Board and make a request that the State Board order report forms and send them out to the Clerks. Msc.

The treasurers report was given and accepted with \$363.17 balance. Bro. George Waggoner made a report on the Friday night service. After some discussion ~~some~~ about whether to continue with the Friday night service since very few except the host Church attend. Motion by Bro. Jimmy Hicks that the

Item II We request the District to instruct the examining Board to Review the Minister's Study Course and ~~begin~~ bring Recommendation for Changes. signed Committee. Bro Jimmy Hicks made motion to adapt this item 2. Msc.

The nominating Committees report was given. We the nominating Committee nominate. For Clerk - Ellamae Hiltibidal, for treasurer. George Waggoner, for business Committee Bob Stone, for examining Board Jimmy Hicks, and Mrs Pat shores for youth Committee. signed Ben Raymond Capps & Ben Edward Wheeler. Mrs Raymond Capps made the motion that these be elected. Msc.

After several suggestions and discussions about the Friday night service. Mrs Jackie Capps made the motion that one specific Church is to have the program. She would volunteer the Hoits Addition youth for the program at Salem Church. Msc. Modgatter suggested that Pastors go and take their Young People.

Mary Williard nominated Bro Bob Stone for moderator for the next District Meeting. Mrs. Bro Edward Wheeler made the motion to elect. Bro. Larry Cook was elected as assistant moderator. Mrs.

Bro. George took charge of the worship service and the congregation sang, "Leaning on the Everlasting Arms" while every one was to shake hands with 3-5 people and change seats.

Cong. sang, "Send a Great Revival" after the 1st verse there were testimonies by Georg Capps, Tom Skinner, Everett Lewis, & Mrs Stone. After the second verse Edward Wheeler, & Mrs Vaughn.

after 3 & 4 verses testimony by Buelah Ashby. Cong. sang "To God be the Glory" and there were several other testimonies. The wheelers sang "There is a River". The Bob Stones song "How Great Thou Art". Cong sang,

Zion's Hill, prayer by Bro. Caylor and the Message from 2 Peter 1:1-8:9 by Bro. J. W. Kittredal. He said, "If people had more knowledge of God there would be less sin in the world. That we should show

brotherly kindness. We can accomplish all things through Jesus Christ. and Idleness is the Devil's workshop."
