KANSAS FREE WILL BAPTISTS

Free Will Baptist work in the state of Kansas began in the early 1950's and was spearheaded by a small group, most of whom were originally from Arkansas.

Rev. Dave Casteel and Rev. Jack Ledbetter were the preachers for those early services. The first two Kansas churches were organized in Wichita in 1954 -- First Church, in May 1954, under the pastorate of Rev. Dave Casteel; And West Side, in October of 1954, under the pastorate of Rev. Jack Ledbetter.

Free Will Baptists were few in number in Kansas in the early fifties. Out of their desire for fellowship, the churches in the Wichita area began well before the organization of a quarterly association to meet together for "Fifth Sunday Meetings."

The First Kansas Quarterly Association was organized January 27, 1962, at Wellington, Kansas. It included four churches; First, West Side, and Liberty (from Wichita); and the Wellington, Kansas, Free Will Baptist Church. The mission at Ulysses, under the leadership of Home Missionary Robert Sharry, also joined the fellowship and became a member of the Quarterly Association as soon as the church was established.

Rev. Harry Staires and Rev. John West from Oklahoma assisted in the organization of the First Kansas Quarterly Association. The Advisory counsel consisted of Rev. Staires, Rev. West, Rev. Robert Sharry, and Rev. D.T. Eaves, of Olathe.

Rev. Wayne Bookout was elected moderator of the newly organized First Kansas Quarterly Association; Rev. W.T. Turnbouth, Asst.; Christine Leichner, clerk; and Rev. Clyde Campbell, treasurer.

In Eastern Kansas other Free Will Baptist Churches were established in the 1950's and on May 18 - 19, 1962 the following churches met together at the New Hope Church in Kansas City, Kansas to organize the East Kansas Quarterly Meeting. They were:

New Hope, in Kansas City Timberlane, in Olathe Skyline, in Kansas City

Rev. James McAllister was elected as the first moderator and Elmer Russell Asst. Moderator. Paul Ussery was elected Clerk - Treasurer. Those elected to the Executive Committee were: D.T. Eaves, Jack McAll. Treasurer, Jack Stallings, Clarence Howard, and Ernest Bailey.

The Kansas State Association of Free Will Baptists was organized June 16, 1962. Free Will Baptists from across the State met at the First church in Wichita June 15.-16, 1962, and letters were read from First Kansas and East Kansas Associations expressing their desire to organize into a State Association.

Rev. Harry Staires, chairman of the National Home Missions Board, was in charge of the organization. Those serving on the organizational committee were: Rev. Harry Staires, Rev. John West, Rev. Bob Ketchum, Rev. Don Payne, and Rev. Roy Bingham (all from the Oklahoma State Association).

Rev. W. T. Turnbough was elected as State moderator, Rev. James McAllister, assistant; Rev. Wayne Bookout, clerk-treasurer: Rev. Gary Snow, assistant clerk.

The East Kansas Quarterly's constitution was adopted for interim use until a permanent constitution could be written. The Executive Board-comprised of the newly elected State officers plus Rev. Jack Ledbetter and Rev. Robert Sharry--was charged with the responsibility of drawing up the permanent constitution, which was adopted June 14, 1963, at the second annual State Meeting.

In the 1963 session, a motion was adopted to petition the National Association in July for membership as the "Kansas State Association of Free Will Baptists."

Other actions taken in this session included the adoption of "The Arrow" as the State paper under the editorship of Rev. Glenn Staggs, the adoption of the cooperative plan of support for Free Will Baptist Work, and plans for the first State Youth Camp.

The progress of Free Will Baptist work in Kansas can be seen by comparing the membership in those early days with that of today. Church membership totaled 480 in 1963; it was 842 on December 31, 1974.

Thirteen churches make up the Kansas State Association in 1975. The East Kansas Quarterly numbers five churches--Topeka, New Hope, Bethel, Faith, and Emporia. The First Kansas Quarterly numbers eight--West Side, Gospel, and First (in Wichita); Wellington, Mutchinson, Ulysses, Salina, and Milan.
