- Any church and/or pastor receiving financial aid participate in all State and Quarterly activities.
- Give accountability of work that is being done.
- Keep records of all visits that are made.
- 4. Give monthly report to whatever department you are receiving funds from.
- 5. If unable to abide by these guidelines financial aid would be nullified and all funds paid back to the department from which received.

Also at this meeting we examined Bro. Jerry Murphree's letter of recommendation from Hilltop Free Will Baptist Church in Fuquay Varina, North Carolina, and his questionnaire for ordination by said church.
