

----- Minutes of the Quarterly Meeting -----

Eastern Division of the Cumberland Association of Free Will Baptist met in regular session with West Nashville Church on Saturday January 7th at 10:00 o'clock A.M.

- Morning Session -

Meeting called to order by the moderator Rev. E. A. Craft. Opening hymns were "Come Thou Fount", and "How Firm A Foundation."

Opening prayer by Rev. J. H. Oliver. The welcome address was delivered by Rev. G. B. Trotter pastor of West Nashville Church. Officers were elected as follows:

At this time Rev. W. J. Paul led a special prayer for Bro. G. T. Harris who was reported ill. The roll was called and out of eleven churches in this division there were six represented.

On motion Clerk was instructed to prepare form for churches to report to the Quarterly Meeting and have copies made to send to each church in this division. A motion carried that ministers will not be required to make a written report to the Quarterly Meeting. On motion the 11:00 o'clock devotional service was omitted. Rev. W. H. Oliver was appointed by moderator to organize a Ministers' Conference and report to the body at this session. Morning session adjourned for lunch at 12:03 P.M.

-- Afternoon Session --

Opened session by singing, "Some Bright Morning", then a prayer by Rev. G. M. Pruitt. Rev. W. H. Oliver brought a very interesting address on Church Extension Through the Quarterly Meetings.

Rev. W. H. On motion the meeting recessed so that the committee from Columbia Church could meet with the Ordained ministers.

Meeting reopened with hymn "Leaning on the Ever Lasting Arm." On motion each church be assessed \$1.00 (one dollar) per quarter to defray the expenses of the Quarterly Meeting.

The Clerk was instructed to have 100 (one hundred) copies of these minutes printed and send some copies to each church. Brother W. E. Coville made a report on Sunday School work. Sister Polston reported on the Orphanage purchased by the Ladies Auxilary. On motion the Moderator was authorized to select the place for the next setting of the Quarterly Meeting, and notify Churches and ministers of same.

On motion the moderator was instructed to work with the Executive Board in preparing the program of the meetings. On motion the time for opening meetings was set for 9:00 o'clock A. M. and the next meeting will be on the first ~~Sunday~~ *Saturday* in April.

A rising vote of thanks was extended to the West Nashville Church for the hospitality extended to the delegates and Ministers of this Quarterly Meeting.
