

FIRST KANSAS QUARTERLY CONFERENCE
SALINA, KANSAS
JANUARY 15-16, 1982

The First Kansas Quarterly Conference met on January 15-16, 1982 at the First Free Will Baptist Church in Salina, Kansas.

The Friday evening services were opened with the congregation singing the song "Sunlight" led by Dean Long with Barbara Dunbar at the piano.

Brother Dunbar gave a welcome. The following churches were recognized: Garden City, Wichita First Church, Hutchinson and Salina and visitors from Topeka.
