#### BUSINESS COMMITTEE REPORT

Whereas the committee appointed to survey the possibilities of selling the Association campground property has reported the cost of the camp to the association the past year at \$4498.83 or in excess of \$350.00 per day for use as a summer camp (more than \$200.00 per day for outside note payments);

And whereas the estimated cost of completion of the 5 year program for expansion voted in the 1963 session will require several additional thousands of dollars to complete when the present indebtedness is retired;

And whereas the facilities are available at Roman Nose State Park in Western Oklahoma at less that \$50.00 per day (these facilities and other camps operated by the State of Oklahoma are annually available) which will offer more adequate facilities for our summer camp program in the district;

And whereas the appraised value of the property is more than enough to retire the present indebtendess of approximately \$10,000.00;

And whereas the committee has reported two or three groups that are interested in purchasing the property;

THEREFORE, Be it resolved that this body authorize and instruct the executive Board to offer for immediate sale the Campground Property of the Association, and to deposit any excess funds received from sale of said property above the amount necessary to retire the present mortgages in a special account to be held until the Association shall vote upon how to disburse it.

#### CONSTITUTION

PREAMBLE: From long experience we, the members of the Tree Will Baptist, realizing the necessity of a bond of union and fellowship among us as a group of churches, do hereby ordain this constitution for our progress and to perpetuate better Association government.

#### ARTICLE I

NAME: This Association shall be known as the First Oklahoma Association of Free Will Baptists of the State of Oklahoma.

#### ARTICLE II :

MEMBERSHIP: This Association shall be composed of Free Will Baptist Churches which maintain Gospel order and agree with denominational doctrine and practices; and favor the enterprises that have been endorsed by the Association.

#### ARTICLE, III

DELEGATES: Voting members of the Association shall be ministers, deacons, members of all standing boards, officers and sponsors of the League Rally of the Association, Officers of the Womens' Auxiliary Convention of the Association. Officers of the Sunday School Convention of the Association, Church clorks and three bay delegates from each local church in the Association, which shall be seated with proper credentials. There must be a majority of the member churches present for a quorum to be consituted. A written record shall be made of all transactions.

#### NRTICLE IV . -

OFFICERS: The officers of this Association shall be a moderator, assistant moderator, clerk, assistant clerk, and a treasurer, which shall be elected at the annual session.

#### ARTICLE V

NEW CHURCHES: Any regularly organized Free Will -27-

Baptist Church, (Treatise Page 42, 1947) who desired to unite with the First Oklahoma Association may be received by letter and selected delegates.

#### ARTICLE VI

BO RDS: The following standing boards shall be electted in the annual session. Each Board shall consist of five members elected so as to have one member retiring each year.

EXECUTIVE: To this Board is delegated power to act in hahalf of and for the First Oklahoma Association from one meeting to another said association, and shall have the power and authority to elect such officers as might be deemed best for its own government, and to carry out the plans and undertakings of the First Oklahoma Association. The Board shall have to fill vacancies that may occur in its own body.

To this board is further delegates power to collect funds and employ and superintend such work for the field as may seem best, and the means on hand may warrant. They shall have power to convey or mortgage any real estate or associational property. This executive board shall keep a record of all work done, meney raised, meetings held, and make a full and complete report to the next regular meeting of this association and shall further receive, held, manage, use, control, and convey any property entrusted to said Association for any purpose in accordance with the purpose of the denor or denors and in no case divert it from its original object.

The Chairman and Treasurer of said Executive Board shall sign all de ds and bonds, notes, etc. and any other papers by which the Rirst Oklahoma Association is to become legally responsible. It shall be the duty of this Board to meet as often as may be necessary and any member absenting himself, from three successive meetings may be dropped from the board and his successor elected. No member of the Executive Board shall delegate authority to any other member of said Board to east his vote for him in anything. The Executive Board shall have power to call all the Association in conference by notifying each church to assomble ten (10) days prior to the conference and they shall have the authority to change quarterly meetings or ssocia-

tion if the place where said quarterly meeting or association is to meet is not able to care for the meetings, and their decisions shall be final. This must be done in time to notify each church. No meeting of the Executive Board shall be legal unless at least three members are present.

PLANNING BOARD: It shall be the duty of this board to review and supervise all future business building programs and other improvement programs on the campground. This does not mean, however, that they are the building committee in said programs. This board shall be charged with the responsibility of keeping the association informed of the needs of the camp. CR 3D ANTI L BOARD: The Credential Board shall examine ministers for license and ordination. They shall, also, eramine deacons sent to the Association by the member churches. This board will furnish report blanks to each minister of the Association appraised to the failure of ministers to make an annual report. CHURCH TRAINING SERVICE: It shall be their duty to plan Church Training Rallies of the Association. This Board shall, also, plan the annual youth encampment, appoint cooks, dormitory sponsors, and teacher's at their conveniences for the encampment at the campground.

MISSION BO RD: The Mission Board will assist any worthy mission work with in the bounds of the First Oklahoma Association. The Annual Missionary Conference of the Association will be planed and supervised by the Mission Board. This mission program of the denomination shall be kept before the First Oklahoma Association and special drives shall be presented by them.

SUND Y SCHOOL BO RD: The Annual Sunday School Convention of the Association will be planned by the Sunday School Board. Sunday School Institutes will be taught by the board upon request by the churches of the Association. A record of courses completed by those enrolled in the institutes will be kept by this board. #### RTICLE VII

QUESTIONS: No questions from any church shall come under the consideration of the Association unless it has been first considered in its church.

#### ARTICLE VIII

PROPERTY ND RE L EST TE: Any church that is a member of the First Oklahoma Association that fails to have pastor for two (2) years becomes the property of said Association; however, that at anytime during this two (2) years it will be the business of the Executive Board to assist such a church in securing a pastor or if need be in finance; of if a condition should arise that would not be the boards duty to take charge of the property.

#### ARTICLE XI

CREDENTI LS: When a church desires that one of its members should be examined for license of ordination, it should be the duty of the council in the examination to find our as nearly as possible if the candidate is qualified.

The candidate is to be examined by a set of questions and unless they are answered scripturally and satisfactorily to the approval of the Board, they will not be licensed or ordained:

#### BY LAWS

- 1. The moderator or assistant moderator, or in their absense, the oldest minister present, shall call the Association into conference.
- 2. Mach session shall be opened and closed with prayer.
- 3. A majority of the churches shall constitute and quorum. A less number may adjourn until such quorum is to start.
- 4. Visiting brethren are invited to scats as advisory members.
- 5. Those who speak, shall arise and address the moderator. Personal reflections shall be avoided in all debates.
- 6. If any proposition or motion under debate contains two or more points, it shall be divided at the request of any member and a vote taken separately.
- 7. Motion made and lost shall not be recored.
- 8. No one shall speak more than twice on the same subject without leave of moderator.
- 9. The moderator shall not allow discussion when not carried on in Christian spirit.
- 10. The ruling of the moderator may be overruled by a two-thirds vote of the members present.
- 11. ny minister opposed to the doctrine of the Free will Baptist as set forth in the Free will Baptist Treaties will not be entitled to a seat in conference.
- 12. No question from any church shall come under the consideration of the association unless it has been first discussed in its own church.
- 13. It each association, arrangements shall be made to insure two or more sermons, or their equivalent devotional exercises each day.
- 14. Then a church has died (had no paster for two year s), the association has the power to take possession of this church of this church property to protect the welfare of the demomination.
- 15. The voting body of the First Okkahoma Association of Free Will Baptists, shall be ordained ministers, ord sined deacons, members of all standing boards, officers and sponsors of the League Rally of the Association. Officers of the Sunday School Convention of the Association, three (3) lay delegates from each local church in the Association, which

shall be seated with proper credentials, and Church Clerks who are members of the association in good standing.

16. These by-laws may be amended at any annual Association by a two-thirds vote of the delegates present.
