PROCEEDINGS OF THE ASSOCIATION MEETING SKYRIDGE FREE WILL BAPTIST CHURCH NOBLE, OKLAHOMA SEPTEMBER 13, 2003

Moderator James Murray called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Delbert Akin led the congregation in singing, "Look and Live," with Waldo Young as pianist.

Shelby Greeson, pastor of Oklahoma City First, brought the devotion. He read Malachi 3:6 and brought thoughts from that verse.

Steve Shaw, pastor of the host church, gave a welcome.

Clerk Waldo Young read letters from the following churches: Capitol Hill, Heartland, Calvary Norman, Crossland Norman, First Moore, First Norman, First OK City, First Yukon, First United Choctaw, Harrah, Kingsview, Newcastle, Northwest OK City, Pleasant Hill Norman, Skyridge Noble, Southwest OK City, Southern Oaks OK City, Spring Hill Lexington, Sunnylane Del City, Trinity OK City, Westgate Shawnee, and Windwood OK City.

In the Heartland letter was a request that the Thanksgiving Praise Service be at the Heartland Church.

A petitionary letter was read from the First Free Will Baptist Church, Seminole. Pastor David McDougal and wife Phyllis were present.

A motion carried to seat the delegates and refer the requests to the proper boards.

A motion carried to refer the petitionary letter to the Executive Board and to the Credentials Board who will examine the ordained.

The deed to one acre of land at the Spring Hill Church was in the name of the Executive Board of the Association since 1944. A motion carried to deed the property back to the church.

In the absence of the treasurer Jim Harris, assistant treasurer Tim Eaton gave the Treasurer's Report. A motion carried to accept the report.

The report of the Executive Board was read by Clerk Waldo Young. It reported that the Executive Board co-signed with the church the renewal of the church loan for the Clear Springs Church, Mustang, saving the church in interest. A motion carried to adopt the report.

Delbert Akin read the report of a committee appointed to work in organizing a district Senior Adult Work. O.A.S.I.S. was adopted as the name of the group. The initials stand for Older Adults Still in Service. At the first meeting just over 40 people were present. A motion carried to adopt the report, and that the committee of Delbert Akin, Earnie Deeds, and Edwin Wade continue their work with the group.

A letter of resignation from Kevin Harper was read resigning from the Christian Education Board. A motion carried to accept the resignation. Dean Stone was elected to the term which expires in 2005.

Whereas Jacob Ricker has moved to Arkansas, out of this district, his position on the Christian Education Board was declared vacant. Derek Bolin was elected to fill this term expiring in 2006.

Dan Farmer gave the report of the Credentials Board. A motion carried to receive the report and consider it item by item. Every item was adopted.

Mike Wade gave the report of the District Missions Board. A financial report is to come later from Frank Wiley.

State Missions Director James Puckett gave a report of the work.

Tim Eaton gave an oral report of the progress of Hillsdale Free Will Baptist College.

The meeting was recessed for a few minutes. The host church provided refreshments.

The morning worship service began with the congregation singing "Blessed Assurance," led by Michael Wade. Mark Vandivort led in prayer. Waldo Young sang, "Ten Thousand Years," as special music.

James Puckett brought the message. He read the Great Commission from Matthew 28:18-20, and brought the message on "Missions."

At the close of the worship service other items of business were transacted.

The report of the Business Committee was given by Mike Wade. It recommended that \$200.00 be given to the account of Caleb Keller from the Pleasant Hill Church as a scholarship to Hillsdale College. It also recommended \$200.00 be given to the O.A.S.I.S. ministry to be used at the committee's discretion. A motion carried to adopt the report.

Delegates to the state association are elected from the district. The district is allowed a number equal to the number of churches in the association, which at this time is twenty-nine. The following people were elected as state delegates: Derek Bolin, Sue Chaffin, Marie Murray, Virginia Akin, Roland Lachance, Carla Krueger, Martha Eaton, JoAnn Young, James Clark, N. L. Pritchard, Pat Pritchard, Melba Spears, Dean Scott, Allen Hunt, Allen Roberson, Jeannene Wade, Jo Drake, Nadine Followwill, and Tommie Sherry, with permission for the clerk to add others if they come in.

Craig Shaw told about the joint Leadership Conference with Hillsdale College and Free Will Baptist Bible College meeting together.

The meeting was adjourned.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

The First Oklahoma district received an income in the first half of 2003 of \$248,983.53 from our cooperating churches. This was down slightly from that received in the first half of last year. To date the District has paid \$11,000 toward its ten year pledge of \$50,000 for the Barber Conference Center on the Hillsdale campus.

ANNUAL DUES HAVE BEEN RECEIVED FROM: Blackwell, Capitol Hill, Choctaw, Clear Springs, Crossland, Grace, Harrah, Lexington, Moore First, Newcastle, Norman First, Northwest OKC, Oak Hills, OKC First,

Pleasant Hill, Skyridge, Southern Oaks, Southwest, Spencer Road, Spring Hill, Sunnylane, Tecumseh, Trinity, Westgate, Windwood, and Yukon. This gives a total of 26 churches with dues up to date, three active churches that have not sent dues, plus one inactive church that has not reported.

SUPPORTING THE WORK OF CHRIST (summary attached):

- 1. The District received over \$69,500 into the Cooperative Plan.
- 2. Hillsdale Free Will Baptist College received designated funds over \$74,400.
- 3. Missions received approximately \$119,500 being distributed to:

Since the Clear Springs Church of Mustang was sponsored by the First Oklahoma Association of Free Will Baptists, the association had signed for their first loan. That five year loan expired in May of 2003.

After the moderator contacted the chairman of the Missions Board, and polled by telephone members of the Executive Board, the moderator and clerk of the association as legal representatives of the executive Board and the First Oklahoma Association of Free Will Baptists, signed as cosigners with the church, the loan for re-financing the note for the church. The approximate amount of the note is \$160,000.00. Fortunately they got 4.25% interest on the loan.

- 4. We recommend that three Wilford Lee scholarships of \$200.00 each be granted. The recipients are Caleb Keller and Ben Sharry from the Pleasant Hill Church and Lindsey Croslin of the Sunnylane Church.

(Amended from the floor to grant six scholarships of \$200.00 each).

5. The discretionary funds at this present time are being directed toward our 10 year pledge to the Hillsdale Chapel of \$50,000.00.

CONSTITUTION

PREAMBLE: From long experience, we, the members of the Free Will Baptist denomination, realizing the necessity of a bond of union and fellowship among us as a group of churches, do hereby ordain this constitution for our progress and to perpetuate better association government.

ARTICLE I

NAME: This Association shall be known as the First Oklahoma District Association of Free Will Baptists of the State of Oklahoma.

ARTICLE II

OBJECT: The purpose of this Association shall be to coordinate and unify the works of the member churches, to devise and execute measures for the extension of the Kingdom of God, and examine for license and ordination prospective ministers and deacons.

ARTICLE III

MEMBERSHIP: Section 1—This Association shall be composed of area Free Will Baptist Churches that adopt the constitution and are accepted by the body.

Section 2—The voting body shall consist of: a) standing delegates composed of officers of the Association, ordained ministers, deacons actively serving on the deacon board of the local church, and ordained ministers and deacons actively serving in district mission works members of all standing boards, church clerks, full-time associates of churches serving as pastoral assistants and b) no more than three lay delegates selected by each local church who shall be seated upon presentation of proper credentials.

Section 3—Any area church wishing to unite with this Association upon presentation of a petitionary letter and examination by the Executive and Credential Board shall be accepted by a majority vote of this body. Churches coming from other Associations are expected to present a letter of recommendation.

Section 4—Each of the Association is to send \$175.00 to the annual session of this association. This will be divided in this manner: \$25.00 for the District Association, \$30.00 for the State Association, \$100.00 for the National Association, and \$20.00 for the Wilford Lee Scholarship Fund. This section may be amended by the clerk to reflect any changes in the above figures, as such changes occur, without a vote of the body.

Section 5—To be considered an active member of First Oklahoma District Association, a church must send in their annual dues and annual report to the annual meeting of the association on the second Saturday in March. A church that fails to do so would be considered inactive, but state and national dues would still be paid by the association.

After the second consecutive year of inactivity, the district will not

pay the national and state dues for the church and will place the church on a non-participating basis.

A church is automatically placed on the roster of active churches in the association upon receipt of the annual dues and the annual report.

ARTICLE IV

NEW CHURCHES: Any group of believers desiring to be organized, may present a petitionary letter and upon majority vote of the association, the Executive Board shall be instructed to examine for organization. Upon examination by the Executive Board, and a two-thirds majority vote of said board, a group may be organized into a local Free Will Baptist church. This church may then become affiliated with the First Oklahoma District Association by petitionary letter and majority vote of the body.

ARTICLE V

OFFICERS: The officers of this Association shall be a moderator, assistant moderator, clerk, assistant clerk, treasurer, and an assistant treasurer, all of whom shall be elected at the annual session.

Moderator, shall preside at all sessions of the Association and shall have power to appoint special committees.

Assistant Moderator, shall preside in the moderator's absence or at his request.

Clerk, shall keep careful records of all business sessions and handle other correspondence as directed.

Assistant Clerk, functions at the discretion of the clerk or in his absence shall do the work of the clerk.

Treasurer, shall receive, and record all monies and distribute and make regular financial reports of such. The Association books are to be closed on the 15th of each month.

The terms of the officers shall begin at the close of the annual session.

ARTICLE VI

MEETINGS: This Association shall meet four times yearly, the second Saturday of March, May, September, and the Tuesday evening before Thanksgiving in November. Business meetings: September, March. Missions: May. Thanksgiving Service: November. The March meeting will be the Annual Session.

ARTICLE VII

EXECUTIVE BOARD: Section 1—Composition: The Executive Board of this Association shall be five members, elected to terms of 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 years with one term expiring each year, plus the Moderator, Clerk and Treasurer of the Association.

Section 2—Duties: The Executive Board shall have general supervision of the affairs of the Association between sessions. The Board shall

be subject to the recommendations of the Association and none of its acts shall conflict with the action taken by this Association.

Section 3—Meetings: Meetings of the Board can be called by the Moderator who serves as its chairman. The Board shall have the power to collect funds as the means on hand my warrant. It shall as directed by this association have power to convey or mortgage any real estate or Associational property. This Executive Board shall keep a record of all work done, monies raised, meetings held, and make a full report to the next regular meeting of this Association and shall further receive, hold, manage, use, control, and convey any property entrusted to said Association for the purpose in accordance with the purpose of the donors, and in no case divert from its original object.

Section 4—Powers: The Chairman and Clerk of said Executive Board shall sign all deeds and bonds, notes, etc.; and any other papers by which the First Oklahoma District Association is to become legally responsible. It shall be the duty of this Board to meet as often as may be necessary. No member of the Executive Board shall delegate authority to any other member of said Board to cast his vote for him in anything. The Executive Board shall have the power to call the Association into conference by notifying each church ten (10) days prior to the conference; and, they shall have the authority to change quarterly meetings or association if the place where said quarterly meetings or association is to meet is not able to care for the meetings; and, their decisions shall be final. This must be done in time to notify each church. No meeting of the Executive Board shall be legal unless at least five members are present.

ARTICLE VIII

BOARDS: The following standing boards shall be elected at the annual session. Each board shall consist of five (5) members, elected as to have one member retiring each year. Vacancies may be filled at any regular meeting.

Credentials Board: It shall be the duty of the Credentials Board to examine the church letters and recommend the seating of such delegates as are properly certified; to examine for license and ordination prospective deacons and ministers at the request of their respective churches and make recommendations to the Association; to examine deacons and ministers coming into this body from other associations

and make appropriate recommendations to this body.

Church Training Service: The Church Training Service Board shall plan Church Training Rallies and youth activities of the Association. This Board shall also plan the annual Youth Encampment with the authority to appoint and employ necessary personnel. This Board shall provide the churches of the district updated information regarding trends and materials in Christian education, to sponsor training sessions for the district, to assist individual churches in their training programs, and to seek ways to evaluate and enhance the educational ministries of the various churches of the district.

Mission Board: The Mission Board shall be empowered to assist any worthy mission work within the bounds of the Association and supervise missionary activities of the Association.

COMMITTEES: Section 1—Finance Committee: A finance committee composed of the treasurer and two other members shall be appointed by the moderator. It shall be the duty of this committee to prepare a budget for the calendar year and submit it to the Association at its regular annual meeting. The Finance Committee can from time to time submit supplements to the budget for the current calendar year.

Section 2—Audit Committee: An audit committee of three members shall be selected by the Association at the regular annual meeting whose duty is shall be to audit the treasurer's account at the close of the calendar year and to report to the annual meeting.

ARTICLE IX

PARLIAMENTARY: The rules contained in the current edition of Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised shall govern the Association in all cases to which they are applicable and in which they are not inconsistent with this constitution and any special rules of order the Association may adopt.

ARTICLE X

AMENDMENTS: This constitution can be amended at any regular meeting of the Association by a two-thirds vote of the body, provided the amendment is presented in writing and laid on the table from the first session until the second session.

ARTICLE XI

DISSOLUTION: Should this Association cease to function, all properties and holdings shall go to the Oklahoma State Association of Free Will Baptists after all creditors are satisfied and indebtedness cleared.

BY-LAWS

- 1. The moderator or assistant, or in their absence, the oldest minister present shall call the association into conference.
- 2. Each session shall be opened and closed with prayer.
- 3. A majority of the churches shall constitute a quorum.
- 4. Visiting brethren are invited to seat as advisory members without voting privileges.
- 5. Those who speak, shall rise and address the moderator. Personal reflections shall be avoided in all debates.
- 6. If any proposition or motion under debate contains two or more points, it shall be divided at the request of any member and a vote taken separately.

- 7. No one shall speak more than twice on the same subject without leave of the moderator, or more than ten minutes at a time.
- 8. The moderator shall not allow discussion when not carried on in a Christian spirit.
- 9. No question from any church shall come under the consideration of the association unless it has been first discussed in its own church.
- 10. These by-laws may be amended at any meeting of the association by a two-thirds vote of the body.

ARTICLES OF FAITH

- 1. The Scriptures are the Old and the New Testaments, inspired by the Holy Spirit and are the only infallible rule of faith and practice.
- 2. There is only one true and living Triune God, the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, three in one personality, one in essence.
- 3. Man is a fallen creature and cannot save himself.
- 4. Jesus Christ, by the grace of God, tasted death for every man and all who repent and trust Christ as Savior will be saved.
- 5. All believers in Christ, who through grace, persevere in holiness to the end of life, have the promise of eternal salvation.
- 6. It is the duty of every Christian to unite with a visible church where through association with others he may share in the observances of the ordinances and the perpetuation of the gospel. The Lord's day is the first day of the week, commemorating the resurrection of Christ and should be spent in public and private worship and rest from secular activities. Upon this day Christians should bring their tithes and offerings into the Lord's house.
- 7. The Gospel Ordinances: Baptism is the immersion of believers in water by an ordained minister, in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit; the Lord's Supper is a commemoration of the

- death of Christ and is open to all believers and should be observed at night; feet washing, which teaches humility, follows the Lord's Supper and is the duty and happy prerogative of every believer.
- 8. There will be the resurrection both of the just and the unjust, every one in his own order, "they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation." The Lord Jesus, who ascended on high, sits at the right hand of God and will come again to close the gospel dispensation, glorify His saints and judge the world. Then the wicked shall go away into everlasting punishment but the righteous into life eternal.
- 9. The definition and condition of the backslider:
 - A backslider is a regenerated person who has degenerated to a state of living in unconfessed an unforgiven sin. Such a person is rebellious to the principles of the Kingdom of God and His righteousness, and cannot enter into sinless Heaven in such a backslidden condition. The following scriptures explain: Jeremiah 2:21; Jeremiah 2:32; II Peter 1:9; James 1:13-16; James 5:19-20; Romans 6:12; Matthew 6:24; Hebrews 10:38-39; Hebrews 3:12-14; Ezekial 18:24; I John 1:9; Revelation 21:27.
 - (a) We believe that salvation is a present possession by faith in the Lord Jesus Christ as Savior and that a person's eternal destiny depends on whether he has this possession. This we hold in distinction from those who teach that salvation depends on human works or merit.
 - (b) We believe that a saved individual may, in freedom of will, cease to trust Christ for salvation and once again be lost. This we hold in distinction from those who teach that a believer may not again be lost.
 - (c) We believe that any regenerated person who has sinned (again, whether he be called "backslider" or "sinner"), must be judged by that evidence to be lost should he so die in his sins. This we hold in distinction from those who suggest the pernicious doctrine that man may live in sin as he pleases and still claim heaven as his eternal home.
 - (d) We believe that any regenerated person who has sinned (again, whether he be called "backslider" or "sinner"), and in whose heart a desire arises to repent, may do so and be restored to favor and fellowship with God. This we hold in distinction from those who teach that when a Christian sins he cannot repent and be restored to favor and fellowship with God.

[&]quot;Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that

by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust. And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; and to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness; and to godliness brotherly kindness and to brotherly kindness charity. For if these things be in you and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins. Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall." II Peter 1:4-10.
