**PROCEEDINGS OF THE
FIRST OKLAHOMA ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTISTS**

Convened at the Spring Hill Free Will Baptist Church

September 10, 2011

The First Oklahoma Association semi-annual meeting met Saturday, September 10, 2011, at the Spring Hill Church, rural Lexington. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m., by Moderator Ernest Harrison, Jr.

Mrs. Shultz and her daughter led the congregation in singing, "Victory in Jesus". Host pastor Rick Shultz read 1 Peter 4:10, and brought devotional thoughts on "If God Ran a Want Ad". The Shultz Family sang "City of Gold".

The moderator's remarks included statements like "Love one another, Honor one another, and keep things brief".

Names of delegates and state delegates were read from the church letters, with some requests. A motion carried to receive the letters, seat the delegates, and refer the requests to the proper committee or board.

The moderator recognized the welcomed visitors to the meeting.

David McDougal and Ryan Giles were appointed to join Jim Harris, treasurer, on the business committee.

Tom Drake, Ray Sanders, and Frank Young were appointed to serve on the Audit Committee.

From Ray Sanders, minister working with the Crosswalk FWB Church, McLoud came the inquiry about petitioning the First Oklahoma Association to become a member church. This was referred to the Executive Board to meet with interested parties.

Mission Board Chairman Frank Wiley gave an oral report of the work of that board. His remarks included that Zac Archer has resigned from the Piedmont work. Steven Earp is starting a new work as the Grace Church leaves only the Spanish speaking people meeting there. The mission board will help. Phil Scowden is starting a new work in Norman called "Echo Church", and the board helped with some start up funds; that the El Reno has a goal to be self supporting by January, and that Steven Earp, since his work is getting some financial help from the board, resigned his position from the Missions Board. A motion carried to accept the report. A financial report will be forthcoming to the clerk.

Kevin Daniels, Pastor of the Harrah Church, was elected to replace Steven Earp on the Mission Board.

Dan Farmer, Chairman, gave the report of the Credentials Board. A motion carried to adopt the report.

Treasurer, Jim Harris passed out copies of and gave the report of the finances of the association. A motion carried to accept the report.

Rusty Harrison gave a report of the Christian Education Board. He mentioned that Adam Phillips needed to be replaced on this board. A motion carried to receive the report. Bryson Bailey was elected to replace Adam Phillips on this board.

Oral reports were heard from Rusty Harrison on the Literature Center, from Gary Curry on the work of "Bridge Builders for the Cross", and from Thomas Marberry on the Hispanic Works in the area.

Thomas Marberry gave information on the work of Hillsdale Free Will Baptist College.

Larry Inscoe, Candice Bailey, Melba Spears, and Brenda Harrison were elected to be added to the list of delegates to the Oklahoma State Association meeting in October.

The report of the Business Committee was given by Jim Harris. It included two items: Item #1 to recommend to hold any excess funds until later, Item #2, to insert the following in Article III of the constitution, Section 4:

Fees are to be paid by organized churches and by mission churches that are active in the association.

That the moderator, clerk, and treasurer be considered an Executive Committee for the responsibility of awarding scholarships from the Wilford Lee Scholarship fund.

These statements to be inserted before the final statement that reads, "This section may be amended...."

Item #1, was approved.

Item #2, was tabled until the annual meeting because of the required constitutional change.

The meeting recessed for the time of refreshments, then for the time of worship.

Thomas Marberry presided over the service which featured people involved in the Spanish speaking congregations within the association. The body heard information about Hispanic FWB works, reported 80 congregations in Mexico: three works our own district at Ada Harmony Church, First Church Okla. City, and in the Grace Church, OKC. Rayme Sanchez gave information of the work in Cuba, his native country, and John Inscoe gave information on the work in Panama.

John Inscoe lead the congregation in singing, "I Have Decided to Follow Jesus", and "How Great is Our God", sung both in Spanish and English.

Pastor Rayme Sanchez read Romans 1:16-17, and brought a message on "Lessons We Can Learn From the Gospel".

At the end of the worship service the meeting was adjourned.

The 115th annual session of the First Oklahoma Association of Free Will Baptists met March 10, 2012, at the Newcastle Free Will Baptist Church, Newcastle, Oklahoma.

The moderator Ernest Harrison, Jr. called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Pastor Frank Giles brought devotional thoughts from John 7, on "God's Word Declared".

Waldo Young led the congregation in singing "When We All Get to Heaven".

The moderator called attention to some of the by-laws, then the business session began.

Clerk Waldo Young read letters received from the churches of the association naming delegates and reading requests. Then he made a motion to receive the letters, seat the delegates, and refer the requests to the proper board or committee. The motion carried.

The treasurer's report was handed out in printed form and given by Treasurer Jim Harris. A motion carried to approve it.

The Mission Board report was given by Chairman Frank Wiley. A motion carried to adopt the report.

The Christian Education Board report was given by Rusty Harrison. A motion carried to approve it.

Adam Phillips, called to be the new pastor at Ponca City and thus moving from the association, resigned from the CE Board. Justin Stafford was elected to the 5 year term on this board.

A report was heard from Gary Curry on his work in Cuba and Mexico. His organization is the Bridge Builders.

CONSTITUTION

PREAMBLE: from long experience, we, the members of the Free Will Baptist denomination, realizing the necessity of a bond of union and fellowship among us as a group of churches, do hereby ordain this constitution for our progress and to perpetuate better association government.

ARTICLE I

NAME: This Association shall be known as the First Oklahoma District Association of Free Will Baptists of the State of Oklahoma.

ARTICLE II

OBJECT: The purpose of this Association shall be to coordinate and unify the works of the member churches, to devise and execute measures for the extension of the Kingdom of God, and examine for license and ordination prospective ministers and deacons.

ARTICLE III

MEMBERSHIP: SECTION 1 – This Association shall be composed of area Free Will Baptist Churches that adopt the constitution and are accepted by the body.

SECTION 2 – The voting body shall consist of: a) standing delegates composed of officers of the Association, ordained ministers, deacons actively serving on the deacon board of the local church, and ordained ministers and deacons actively serving in district mission works, members of all standing boards, church clerks, full-time associates of churches serving as pastoral assistants and b) no more than three lay delegates selected by each local church who shall be seated upon presentation of proper credentials.

SECTION 3 – Any area church wishing to unite with this Association upon presentation of a petitionary letter and examination by the Executive and Credential Board shall be accepted by a majority vote of this body. Churches coming from other Associations are expected to present a letter of recommendation.

SECTION 4 – Each church of the Association is to send \$250.00 to the annual session of this association. This will be divided in this manner: \$30.00 for the District Association, \$50.00 for the State Association, \$150.00 for the National Association, and \$20.00 for the Wilford Lee Scholarship Fund. This section may be amended by the clerk to reflect any changes in the above figures, as such changes occur, without a vote of the body.

SECTION 5 – To be considered an active member of First Oklahoma District Association, a church must send in their annual dues and annual report to the annual meeting of the association on the second of March. A church that fails to do so would be considered inactive, but state and national dues would still be paid by the association.

After the second consecutive year of inactivity, the district will not pay the national and state dues for the church and will place the church on a non-participating basis.

A church is automatically placed on the roster of active churches in the Association upon receipt of the annual dues.

ARTICLE IV

NEW CHURCHES: Any group of believers desiring to be organized may present a petitionary letter and upon majority vote of the association, the Executive Board shall be instructed to examine for organization. Upon examination by the Executive Board, and a two-thirds majority vote of said board, a group may be organized into a local Free Will Baptist church. This church may then become affiliated with the First Oklahoma District Association by petitionary letter and majority vote of the body.

ARTICLE V

OFFICERS: the officers of this Association shall be a moderator, assistant moderator, clerk, assistant clerk, treasurer, and an assistant treasurer, all of whom shall be elected at the annual session.

Moderator, shall preside in all sessions of the Association and shall have power to appoint special committees.

Assistant Moderator, shall preside in the moderator's absence or at his request.

Clerk, shall keep careful records of all business sessions and handle other correspondence as requested.

Assistant Clerk, functions at the discretion of the clerk or in his absence shall do the work of the clerk.

Treasurer, shall receive and record all monies and distribute and make regular financial reports of such. The Association books are to be closed on the 15th of each month.

The terms of the officers shall begin at the close of the annual session.

ARTICLE VI

MEETINGS: This Association shall meet four times yearly, the second Saturday of March, May, September, and Tuesday evening before Thanksgiving in November. Business meetings: September, March. Missions: May. Thanksgiving Service: November. The March meeting will be the Annual Session.

ARTICLE VII

EXECUTIVE BOARD: Section 1 – *Composition:* The Executive Board of this Association shall be five members, elected to terms of 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 years with one term expiring each year, plus the Moderator, Clerk and Treasurer of the Association.

Section 2 – *Duties:* The Executive Board shall have general supervision of the affairs of the Association and none of its acts shall conflict with the action taken by this Association.

Section 3 – *Meetings:* Meetings of the Board can be called by the Moderator who serves as its chairman. The Board shall have the power to collect funds as the means on hand my warrant. It shall as directed by this Association have power to convey or mortgage any real estate or

Associational property. This Executive Board shall keep a record of all work done, monies raised, meetings held, and make a full report to the next regular meeting of this Association and shall further receive, hold, manage, use, control, and convey any property entrusted to said Association for the purpose in accordance with the purpose of the donors, and in no case divert from its original object.

Section 4 - Powers: The Chairman and Clerk of said Executive Board shall sign all deeds and bonds, notes, etc.; and any other papers by which the First Oklahoma District Association is to become legally responsible. It shall be the duty of this Board to meet as often as may be necessary. No member of the Executive Board shall delegate authority to any other member of said board to cast his vote for him in anything. The Executive Board shall have the power to call the Association into conference by notifying each church ten (10) days prior to the conference; and, they shall have the authority to change quarterly meetings or association if the place where said quarterly meetings or association is to meet is not able to care for the meetings; and, their decisions shall be final. This must be done in time to notify each church. No meeting of the Executive Board shall be legal unless at least five members are present.

ARTICLE VIII

BOARDS: The following standing boards shall be elected at the annual session. Each board shall consist of five (5) members, elected as to have one member retiring each year. Vacancies may be filled at any regular meeting.

Credentials Board: It shall be the duty of the Credentials Board to examine the church letters and recommend the seating of such delegates as are properly certified; to examine for license and ordination prospective deacons and ministers at the request of their respective churches and make recommendations to the Association; to examine deacons and ministers coming into this body from other associations and make appropriate recommendations to this body.

Ministers and deacons coming into this body from other associations who have previously held membership in this association in good standing may obtain approved recommendation by this board by signing a letter stating their standards and doctrines have not changed since previous membership and their answers to the ordination application remain the same.

Church Training Service: The Christian Education Board shall plan youth activities of the Association.

Mission Board: The Mission Board shall be empowered to assist any worthy mission work within the bounds of the Association and supervise missionary activities of the Association.

COMMITTEES: **Section 1 - Finance Committee:** A Finance Committee composed of the treasurer and two other members shall be appointed by the moderator. It shall be the duty of this committee to prepare a budget for the calendar year and submit it to the Association at its regular annual meeting. The Finance Committee can from time to time submit supplements to the budget for the current calendar year.

Section 2 - Audit Committee: An audit committee of three members shall be selected by the Association at the regular annual meeting whose duty is shall be to audit the treasurer's account at the close of the calendar year and to report to the annual meeting.

ARTICLE IX

PARLIAMENTARY: The rules contained in the current edition of Robert's rules of Order Newly Revised shall govern the Association in all cases to which they are applicable and in which they are no inconsistent with this constitution and any special rules of order the Association may adopt.

ARTICLE X

AMENDMENTS: This constitution can be amended at any regular meeting of the Association by a two-thirds vote of the body, provided the amendment is presented in writing and laid on the table from the first session until the second session.

ARTICLE XI

DISSOLUTION: Should this Association cease to function, all properties and holdings shall go to the Oklahoma State Association of Free Will Baptists after all creditors are satisfied and indebtedness cleared.

BY-LAWS

1. The moderator or assistant, or in their absence, the oldest minister present shall call the association into conference.
2. Each session shall be opened and closed with prayer.
3. A majority of the churches shall constitute a quorum.
4. Visiting brethren are invited to seat as advisory members without voting privileges.
5. Those who speak, shall rise and address the moderator. Personal reflections shall be avoided in all debates.
6. If any proposition or motion under debate contains two or more points, it shall be divided at the request of any member and a vote taken separately.
7. No one shall speak more than twice on the same subject without leave of the moderator, or more than ten minutes at a time.
8. The moderator shall not allow discussion when not carried on in a Christian spirit.
9. No question from any church shall come under the consideration of the Association unless it has been first discussed in its own church.
10. These by-laws may be amended at any meeting of the Association by a two-thirds vote of the body.

ARTICLES OF FAITH

1. The Scriptures are the Old and New Testaments inspired by the Holy Spirit and are the only infallible rule of faith and practice.
2. There is only one true and living Triune god, the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, three in one personality, one in essence.
3. Man is a fallen creature and cannot save himself.
4. Jesus Christ, by the grace of God, tasted death for every man and all who repent and trust Christ as Savior will be saved.
5. All believers in Christ, who through grace, persevere in holiness to the end of life, have the promise of eternal salvation.
6. It is the duty of every Christian to unite with a visible church where through association with others he may share in the observances of the ordinances and the perpetuation of the gospel. The Lord's day is the first day of the week, commemorating the resurrection of Christ and should be spent in public and private worship and rest from secular activities. Upon this day Christians should bring tithes and offerings into the Lord's house.
7. The Gospel Ordinances: Baptism is the immersion of believers in water by an ordained minister, in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit; The Lord's Supper is a commemoration of the death of Christ and is open to all believers and should be observed at night; feet washing, which teaches humility, follows the Lord's Supper and is the duty and happy prerogative of every believer.
8. There will be the resurrection both of the just and the unjust, everyone in his own order, "they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation." The Lord Jesus, who ascended on high, sits at the right hand of God and will come again to close the gospel dispensation, glorify His saints and judge the world. Then the wicked shall go away into everlasting punishment but the righteous into life eternal.
9. The definition and condition of the backslider: A backslider is a regenerated person who has degenerated to a state of living in unconfessed and unforgiven sin. Such a person is rebellious to the principles of the Kingdom of God and His righteousness, and cannot enter into sinless Heaven in such a backslidden condition. The following scriptures explain: Jeremiah 2:21; Jeremiah 2:32; II Peter 1:9, James 1:13-16; James 5:19-20; Romans 6:12; Matthew 6:24; Hebrews 10:38-39; Hebrews 3:12-14; Ezekiel 18:24; I John 1:9; Revelation 21:27.
- (a) We believe that salvation is a present possession by faith in the Lord Jesus Christ as Savior and that a person's eternal destiny depends on whether he has this possession. This we hold in distinction from those who teach that salvation depends on human works or merits.

- (b) We believe that a saved individual may, in freedom of will, cease to trust Christ for salvation and once again be lost. This we hold in distinction from those who teach that a believer may not again be lost.
- (c) We believe that any regenerated person who has sinner (again, whether he be called "backslider" or "sinner"), must be judged by that evidence to be lost should he so die in his sins. This we hold in distinction from those who suggest the pernicious doctrine that man may live in sin as he pleases and still claim heaven as his eternal home.
- (d) We believe that any regenerated person who has sinned (again, whether he be called "backslider" or "sinner"), and in whose heart a desire arises to repent, may do so and be restored to favor and fellowship with God. This we hold in distinction from those who teach that when a Christian sins he cannot repent and be restored to favor and fellowship with God.

"Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust. And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue, knowledge; and to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness; and to godliness brotherly kindness and to brotherly kindness charity. For if these things be in you and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins. Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall." II Peter 1:4-10
